St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 24 St. Norbert College (0-0) at North Park Univ. (0-0) Saturday, November 16, 2013 - 7 p.m.

North Park Gymnasium (1,500) - Chicago, Illinois

Game Overview:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 24 in the pre-season D3hoops.com Top 25, opens the new season with a road game at College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin foe North Park.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads North Park 2-1 in an all-time series begun in 1966-67. The only meeting in the series in Chicago resulted in a 74-59 St. Norbert win on Nov. 27, 2004.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped North Park 70-55 on Nov. 26, 2005 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. Nathan Zepnick led St. Norbert with 13 points, while Brett Mathisen led the Vikings with 14 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 120-54 in his eighth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 171-85.

North Park coach Tom Slyder (Anderson, 1988) is 6-19 in his second season in Chicago. Slyder was 103-85 in seven seasons at Anderson to give him an overall record of 109-104.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the new season ranked No. 24 in the pre-season D3hoops.com Top 25. The Green Knights return all five starters from last season's team that finished 20-6 overall and won the Midwest Conference title at 15-3. St. Norbert lost a heartbreaker to Wheaton in the first round of the NCAA Division III Tournament 59-58.

Senior guard Brandon Gries led the Green Knights in scoring last season, averaging 14.5 points per game. Gries, who needs 168 points to reach 1,000 - MORE -

for his career, set school records last season with free throws made (156) and attempted (190). Junior forward Andrew Schwoerer averaged 13.3 points per game last season while shooting 56.2 percent from the floor. Sophomore forward Izaiah Anderson netted 7.1 points per game last season and led the Green Knights in rebounding at 6.1 caroms per game.

St. Norbert scored an average of 71.0 points per game last season, and shot 46.4 percent from the floor, 36.2 percent on 3-pointers and 75.0 percent at the free-throw line - good for 18th nationally. Opponents scored an average of 60.5 points per game while shooting 40.5 percent from the floor, 33.1 percent on 3-pointers and 72.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Vikings:

North Park enters the 2013-14 season after finishing 6-19 last season. The Vikings finished eighth in the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin with a 1-13 ledger. North Park played Valparaiso in an exhibition game this past Sunday, falling to the Crusaders 113-50.

The Vikings return one player from last season who started at least 10 games in sophomore guard Ryan Hyrn. Hyrn, who scored nine points against Valparaiso, averaged 9.3 points per game while shooting 43.6 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Freshman guard Juwan Henry came off the bench to score 18 points against Valparaiso, while senior guard Aaron Weaver - who averaged 14.9 points per game last season in making nine starts a year ago - netted 13 points.

North Park averaged 65.4 points per game while shooting 40.4 percent from the floor, 30.9 percent on 3-pointers and 67.5 percent on free throws. Opponents scored 78.4 points per game while shooting 49.2 percent from the floor, 35.9 percent on 3-pointers and 70.4 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first seven seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St.

Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title three times in the last four seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games three times in the last four years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2013 marked just the fifth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010. St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011.

St. Norbert's 77-25 record from 2009 to 2012 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 109-36. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

Dialing Up Defense:

St. Norbert allowed a Midwest Conference-best 60.5 points per game last season. The Green Knights' mark was good for 23rd nationally out of 407 teams in last season's Division III statistical rankings.

St. Norbert allowed 43 points to Ripon in its 72-43 win over the Red Hawks on Jan. 9. It was the fewest amount of points the Green Knights have allowed in a Midwest Conference game since a 62-42 win over Monmouth on Feb. 4, 2011.

In Gary Grzesk's 174-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 28 times, going 28-0 in those games.

Jump Shots:

- * St. Norbert's last road win at a CCIW opponent was a 63-61 win over Elmhurst on Nov. 21, 2009. St. Norbert has dropped games at Augustana and Wheaton since.
- * The Green Knights finished 13th nationally last season in assistto-turnover ratio at a plus-1.37 per game.
