St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 11 St. Norbert College (13-1, 9-0) at Beloit College (5-8, 3-5) Wednesday, January 22, 2014 - 5:30 p.m. Flood Arena (2,250) - Beloit, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 11 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, looks to extend its 11-game winning streak Wednesday at Beloit. The first-place Green Knights currently hold a three-game lead on the rest of the Midwest Conference.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Beloit 38-23 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights have won 11 of the last 14 meetings in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Beloit 68-48 on Jan. 8 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Green Knights were led by 15 points from Kam Cerroni, while Andrew Schwoerer added 14 points, Austin Elliott 13 points and Brandon Gries 12 points. James Lazarcik had 14 points and eight rebounds for Beloit.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 133-55 in his eighth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 184-86.

Beloit coach Brian Vraney (Wisconsin, 1998) is 52-99 in his seventh season in Beloit.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 13-1 overall and 9-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, ranked No. 11 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, stretched their winning streak to 11 games with a 76-53 win Saturday at Illinois College.

Senior guard Kam Cerroni leads the Green Knights in scoring at 16.3 points per game, and is shooting 53.0 percent (53-for-100) from beyond the three-point arc. Senior guard Brandon Gries is netting 16.2 points per game. Junior forward Andrew Schwoerer is averaging 15.1 points per game with a team-high 5.5 rebounds per game. Junior guard Austin Elliott is averaging 10.5 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 82.6 points per game, and is shooting 53.0 percent from the floor, 43.7 percent on 3-pointers and 80.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 66.1 points per game while shooting 42.3 percent from the floor, 37.8 percent on 3-pointers

About the Buccaneers:

Beloit enters the game 5-8 overall and 3-5 in the Midwest Conference. The Buccaneers have been idle since last Tuesday, when they lost at Carroll 67-54.

Senior center James Lazarcik leads the Green Knights in scoring at 18.4 points per game with 8.8 rebounds per game, and is shooting a Division III-best 70.4 percent from the floor. Sophomore guard Steve McAfee is averaging 17.1 points per game, while senior forward Tyler Butke is netting 9.1 points per

Beloit is scoring an average of 69.8 points per game, and is shooting 46.4 percent from the floor, 27.6 percent on 3-pointers and 68.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 76.1 points per game while shooting 47.8 percent from the floor, 31.2 percent on 3-pointers and 72.5 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first eight seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title three times in the last four seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games three times in the last four years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2013 marked just the fifth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010. St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011.

St. Norbert's 79-25 record from 2010 to 2013 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 122-37. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

Gries is the Word:

St. Norbert senior guard Brandon Gries, who is averaging 16.2 points per game this season, became the 26th player in school history to reach the 1,000-point mark for his career on Jan. 4 against Lawrence. Gries became only the eighth St. Norbert cager to reach that mark playing the majority of his career in the Midwest Conference.

Gries, who has made 390 career free throws, needs 28 made free throws to become the St. Norbert career leader in made free throws. Jack Gebler owns the St. Norbert record with 417 from 1966-70.

Gries currently has 1,059 career points to sit in 20th place all-time at St. Norbert in career scoring.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert has won 41 of its last 45 January games. The Green Knights are 50-10 overall in January under Gary Grzesk.

* - St. Norbert is averaging 82.6 points per game. The Green Knights have not averaged 80 points per game in a season since the 1975-76 squad netted 84.0 points per game.

* - St. Norbert is third in Division III in field-goal percentage at 53.0 percent. The Green Knights trail Carroll (55.7) and UW-Stevens Point (54.1).

* - St. Norbert is third nationally in three-point field-goal percentage at 43.7 percent. Husson leads at 44.6 percent, followed by Rhodes 43.7 percent.

St. Norbert Men's Basketball Winning Streaks

St. Norbert's current 11-game winning streak is just the sixth of at least that length for the Green Knights since the conclusion of World War II. All six have come since St. Norbert left independent status and joined the Midwest Conference for basketball in 1983. Four have come during Gary Grzesk's eight-year tenure as head coach.
