St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 6 St. Norbert College (18-1, 14-0) at Carroll Univ. (13-7, 10-5) Tuesday, February 11, 2014 - 5:30 p.m. Van Male Fieldhouse (2,000) - Waukesha, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 6 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, looks to clinch home-court advantage for the Midwest Conference Tournament with a win at Carroll. The Green Knights enter the game having matched a school record with a 16-game winning streak.

The Series:

Carroll leads St. Norbert 45-43 in a series dating back to the 1933-34 season. The Green Knights have won the last eight of the last 10 meetings.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert ground its way to a 76-69 win over Carroll on Dec. 18 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Green Knights had balanced scoring, with Brandon Gries and Andrew Schwoerer leading the way with 18 points apiece. Kyle Keranen led the Pioneers with 22 points off the bench, while Alec Molter had 15 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 138-55 in his eighth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 189-86.

Carroll coach Paul Combs (Ripon, 1993) is 13-7 in his first season in Waukesha. Including stops at Lakeland, UW-Platteville and Wayne State (Neb.), Combs is 229-167 in 15 years of collegiate coaching.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 18-1 overall and 14-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, ranked No. 6 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, earned their 16th consecutive victory with a 79-69 road win at Lawrence last Wednesday.

Senior guard Kam Cerroni paces the Green Knights in scoring at 17.4 points per game, and leads Division III in three-point field-goal percentage at 57.8 percent. Senior guard Brandon Gries is averaging 15.6 points per game. Junior forward Andrew Schwoerer is netting 15.3 points per game with a team-high 6.0 rebounds per game. Junior guard Austin Elliott is averaging 10.4 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 81.8 points per game, and is shooting 52.3 percent from the floor (third nationally), 45.3 percent on 3-pointers (NCAA Division III leader) and 79.0 percent at the free-throw line (fourth nationally). Opponents are scoring an average of 63.9 points per game

while shooting 41.9 percent from the floor, 37.9 percent on 3-pointers and 65.5 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the game 13-7 overall and 10-5 in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers have won four straight and nine of their last 11 games following a 61-49 home win over Cornell on Saturday.

Senior forward Andrew Nottling tops the Pioneers in scoring at 14.7 points per game, and is shooting 63.6 percent from the floor. Senior center Alec Molter is averaging 13.1 points per game and is shooting 62.3 percent from the floor while averaging 71. rebounds per game. Senior guard Kevin Hurd is scoring 12.6 points per game, while freshman guard Kyle Keranen is scoring 9.1 points per game.

Carroll is scoring an average of 69.8 points per game, and is shooting 54.3 percent from the floor (NCAA Division III leader), 41.7 percent on 3-pointers and 67.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 65.8 points per game while shooting 43.5 percent from the floor, 39.6 percent on 3-pointers and 70.5 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first eight seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title three times in the last four seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games three times in the last four years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2013 marked just the fifth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a

school-record 23 games in 2010. St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011.

St. Norbert's 79-25 record from 2010 to 2013 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 127-37. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010, which it matched this week.

Gries is the Word:

St. Norbert senior guard Brandon Gries, who is averaging 15.6 points per game this season, became the 26th player in school history to reach the 1,000-point mark for his career on Jan. 4 against Lawrence.

Gries, who has made 405 career free throws, needs 13 made free throws to become the St. Norbert career leader in made free throws. Jack Gebler owns the St. Norbert record with 417 from 1966-70.

Gries currently has 1,113 career points to sit in 16th place all-time at St. Norbert in career scoring.

Cerroni Chat:

St. Norbert senior guard Kam Cerroni holds the NCAA Division III lead in three-point field goal percentage at 57.8 percent. Cerroni has made 46 of his last 71 3s in his last nine games for a 64.8 percentage.

Cerroni has made seven 3-pointers in a game four times this season. Prior to this year, that had only been done seven times previously in St. Norbert history.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert junior forward Andrew Schwoerer is third nationally in field-goal percentage at 67.8 percent.

* - St. Norbert is averaging 81.8 points per game, which is 35th in Division III. The Green Knights have not averaged 80 points per game in a season since the 1975-76 squad netted 84.0 points per game.

St. Norbert Men's Basketball Winning Streaks

St. Norbert's current 16-game winning streak ties a school record and is just the sixth of at least 11 games for the Green Knights since the conclusion of World War II. All have come since St. Norbert left independent status and joined the Midwest Conference for basketball in 1983. Four have come during Gary Grzesk's eight-year tenure as head coach.
