### St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 5 St. Norbert College (20-1, 16-0) at Ripon College (14-7, 11-5) Wednesday, February 19, 2014 - 5:30 p.m. Storzer Center (2,500) - Ripon, Wisconsin

#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 5 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, travels to face archrival Ripon on Wednesday. The Green Knights would set a Midwest Conference record for conference wins in a season with a win over the Red Hawks.

#### Broadcast:

#### The Series:

Ripon holds a 60-51 series lead over St. Norbert in a spirited rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have narrowed the gap by winning 14 of the last 16 meetings over the last seven seasons.

#### Last Meeting:

St. Norbert trimmed Ripon 102-62 on Jan. 14 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Red Hawks opened the game with a 3-pointer, but St. Norbert then went on a 39-4 run to take command. The Green Knights, who shot 65.6 percent from the floor, were led by Kam Cerroni's 22 points. Andrew Schwoerer added 20 points. Ty Sabin led the Red Hawks with 17 points, while Kyle Loughrin added 15 points.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 140-55 in his eighth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 191-86.

Ripon coach Ryan Kane (St. Norbert, 1999) is 27-18 in his second season in Ripon.

#### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 20-1 overall and 16-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, ranked No. 5 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, won for the 18th consecutive game with a 113-88 win over Grinnell this past Saturday at Schuldes Sports Center.

Senior guard Kam Cerroni leads the Green Knights in scoring at 17.4

points per game, and leads Division III in three-point field-goal percentage at 57.4 percent. Senior guard Brandon Gries is averaging 15.5 points per game with 4.9 rebounds per game. Junior forward Andrew Schwoerer is netting 15.4 points per game with a team-high 6.2 rebounds per game while shooting 66.9 percent from the field. Junior guard Austin Elliott is averaging 10.2 points per game off the bench.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 82.6 points per game, and is shooting 52.6 percent from the floor, 44.4 percent on 3-pointers and 78.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 65.0 points per game while shooting 42.0 percent from the floor, 37.1 percent on 3-pointers and 66.0 percent at the free-throw line.

#### About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game 14-7 overall and 11-5 in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks have won their last three games, including a 95-84 win at Illinois College this past Saturday.

Freshman guard Ty Sabin leads the Red Hawks in scoring at 18.3 points per game, and is shooting 50.5 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Junior guard Kyle Loughrin is netting 17.2 points per game. Sophomore guard Ty Ketz is averaging 14.2 points per game, while senior forward Brad Brooks is averaging 8.8 points and 7.0 rebounds per game.

Ripon is scoring an average of 81.7 points per game, and is shooting 50.4 percent from the floor, 41.2 percent on 3-pointers and 79.8 per-

cent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 76.2 points per game while shooting 50.4 percent from the floor, 35.3 percent on 3-pointers and 72.1 percent at the free-throw line.

#### Building a Winner:

In his first eight seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title three times in the last four seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games four times in the last five years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2014 marks just the sixth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010. St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 79-25 record from 2010 to 2013 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 129-37. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 5 ranking the week of Feb. 17, 2014.

#### Gries is the Word:

St. Norbert senior guard Brandon Gries, who is averaging 15.5 points per game this season, became the 26th player in school history to reach the 1,000-point mark for his

## St. Norbert Men's Basketball Winning Streaks

St. Norbert's current 18-game winning streak is a school record and is just the sixth of at least 11 games for the Green Knights since the conclusion of World War II. All have come since St. Norbert left independent status and joined the Midwest Conference for basketball in 1983. Four have come during Gary Grzesk's eight-year tenure as head coach.

career on Jan. 4 against Lawrence.

Gries, who has made 414 career free throws, needs four made free throws to become the St. Norbert career leader in made free throws. Jack Gebler owns the St. Norbert record with 417 from 1966-70.

Gries currently has 1,142 career points to sit in 16th place all-time at St. Norbert in career scoring. Former teammate David Wipperfurth is in 15th place with 1,146 career points from 2008-11.

#### Cerroni Chat:

St. Norbert senior guard Kam Cerroni holds the NCAA Division III lead in three-point field goal percentage at 57.4 percent. Cerroni has made 53 of his last 84 3s in his last 12 games for a 63.1 percentage.

Cerroni, whose 81 made three-point field goals this season is a St. Norbert single-season record, has made seven 3-pointers in a game four times this season. Prior to this year, that had only been done seven times previously in St. Norbert history. Cerroni is third in

Division III with 4.06 made 3-pointers per game. He is also 47th nationally in field-goal percentage at 57.5 percent.

Cerroni's St. Norbert-record streak of 45 consecutive made free throws came to an end in the first half of the Grinnell game on Feb. 15.

#### Schwoerer Stuff:

St. Norbert junior forward Andrew Schwoeerer remains among the NCAA Division III leaders in field-goal percentage. Schwoeerer is third nationally with a field-goal percentage of 66.9 percent.

Schwoeerer went 11-for-13 from the floor against Grinnell this past Saturday to move up to places from fifth nationally last week. Schwoeerer, a 57.6 percent career shooter from the floor, has 907 career points.

#### Century Comments:

St. Norbert went over the 100-point mark for the fifth time this season in this past Saturday's 113-88 win over Grinnell at Schuldes Sports Center.

The Green Knights haven't passed

the century mark five times in one season since the 1975-76 campaign.

St. Norbert scored at least 100 points a school-record eight times during the 1964-65 season.

St. Norbert is averaging 82.6 points per game, second in the Midwest Conference to Grinnell's 118.2 points per game. The Green Knights have not averaged 80 points per game in a season since the 1975-76 squad netted 84.0 points per game.

#### Jump Shots:

\* - St. Norbert's rebounding margin moved to No. 1 in Division III at a robust plus-10.1 rebounds per game. The Green Knights outrebounded Grinnell by 15 on Saturday and were plus-17 against Carroll on Feb. 11.

\* - St. Norbert is 31-1 in its last 32 games against Midwest Conference opponents, which dates back to December 2012. The only loss during that stretch was a 104-99 overtime loss at Grinnell on Feb. 9, 2013. The Green Knights' average margin of victory in MWC games this season is 18.6 points.
