St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview NCAA DIVISION III TOURNAMENT - MIDWEST REGIONAL Fri., March 7 - No. 5 St. Norbert (24-1) vs. Ohio Wesleyan (20-7) - 5:30 p.m. Sat., March 8 - vs. No. 6 Illinois Wesleyan (23-4) or Webster (20-7) - 7 p.m. Shirk Center (2,680) - Bloomington, Illinois

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert makes its fourth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in five years when it travels to the heart of Illinois to participate in a Midwest Regional at Illinois Wesleyan. The Green Knights face at-large qualifier Ohio Wesleyan in the first round.

The Series:

- St. Norbert has never faced Ohio Wesleyan or Webster in men's basketball.
- St. Norbert holds a 1-0 series lead on Illinois Wesleyan. The Green Knights and Titans met for the only time during the 1941-42 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 144-55 in his eighth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 195-86.

Ohio Wesleyan coach Mike DeWitt (Ohio Wesleyan, 1987) is 238-167 in his 15th season in Delaware. Including two seasons at Hiram and three at Centre, DeWitt is 288-242 in 20 seasons of collegiate coaching.

Illinois Wesleyan coach Ron Rose (Illinois Wesleyan, 1988) is 152-72 in his eighth season in Bloomington.

Webster coach Chris Bunch (Lincoln Memorial, 1988) is 187-125 in his 12th season in St. Louis.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its sixth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its fourth in five seasons, and is 2-5 all-time in the tournament. Two of St. Norbert's previous five appearances ended at the hands of the eventual national champion - UW-Whitewater in 1984 and UW-Stevens Point in 2010. The Green Knights lost to Wheaton in the first round of last year's NCAA Tournament by a 59-58 score.

Ohio Wesleyan is making its fifth NCAA Division III Tournament - MORE -

appearance and its third straight. The Battling Bishops, who won the 1988 national title, is 8-3 all-time in the tournament. Ohio Wesleyan advanced to the second round last season where it lost 84-81 to Cabrini College.

Illinois Wesleyan is making its 23rd NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its fifth straight. The Titans, who won the 1997 national title, advanced to the Sweet 16 last season before losing to North Central 83-73. Illinois Wesleyan is 49-22 all-time in the tournament.

Webster is making its fourth NCAA Tournament appearance. The Gorloks are 0-3 all-time in the tournament.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Tournament at 24-1 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 5 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, extended their school record winning streak to 22 with a 99-86 win over Grinnell in the Midwest Conference Tournament championship game this past Saturday.

Senior guard Kam Cerroni leads the Green Knights in scoring at 16.3 points per game, and leads Division III in three-point field-goal percentage at 54.7 percent. Senior guard Brandon Gries is averaging 16.2 points and 5.2 rebounds per game. Junior forward Andrew Schwoerer is averaging 16.2 points and a teamhigh 6.3 rebounds per game. Junior guard Austin Elliott is averaging 10.6 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 83.0 points per game, and is

shooting 53.2 percent from the floor (second in Division III), 44.3 percent on 3-pointers (first in Division III) and 78.6 percent at the free-throw line (fifth in Division III). Opponents are scoring an average of 65.8 points per game while shooting 42.1 percent from the floor, 37.5 percent on 3-pointers and 66.1 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Battling Bishops:

Ohio Wesleyan enters the NCAA Tournament 20-7 overall. The Battling Bishops finished North Coast Athletic Conference action 13-5 to finish in a tie for second place. Ohio Wesleyan lost in the semifinals of the NCAC Tournament 78-67 to Wooster this past Friday.

Senior center Reuel Rogers leads Ohio Wesleyan at 13.2 points and 8.2 rebounds per game, and is ninth in Division III at 3.04 blocked shots per game. Sophomore center Claude Gray averages 12.8 points and 4.8 rebounds per game. Senior guard Taylor Rieger averages 12.7 points per game, while senior forward Drew White averages 10.9 points and 7.0 rebounds per game.

Ohio Wesleyan is scoring an average of 74.0 points per game, and is shooting 44.5 percent from the floor, 34.9 percent on 3-pointers and 62.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 67.4 points per game while shooting 40.9 percent from the floor, 34.4 percent on 3-pointers and 70.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Titans:

Illinois Wesleyan enters the

St. Norbert Men's Basketball Winning Streaks

St. Norbert's current 22-game winning streak is a school record and is just the sixth of at least 11 games for the Green Knights since the conclusion of World War II. St. Norbert's winning streak is currently the longest in Division III. As of March 3 in all divisions, only Wichita State's 31-game winning streak and Stephen F. Austin's skein of 24 straight wins are longer.

NCAA Tournament 23-4 overall and ranked No. 6 in the D3hoops.com Top 25. The Titans won the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin regular-season championship at 12-2. Illinois Wesleyan dropped the CCIW Tournament title game this past Saturday to Wheaton 87-66.

Senior forward Andrew Ziemnik paces the Titans at 12.8 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. Senior forward Victor Davis averages 11.4 points and 6.4 rebounds per game. Junior guard Jordan Nelson nets 10.7 points per game, while junior guard Dylan Overstreet scores an average of 10.2 points per game.

Illinois Wesleyan is scoring an average of 83.4 points per game, and is shooting 50.5 percent from the floor, 42.9 percent on 3-pointers (second in Division III) and 70.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 68.2 points per game while shooting 41.4 percent from the floor, 31.5 percent on 3-pointers and 68.9 percent at the free-throw line.

Webster enters the NCAA Tournament at 20-7 overall. The Gorloks finished play in the St. Louis Intercollegiate Athletic Conference at 15-3 and topped Spalding 55-51 in the SLIAC Tournament championship game.

Junior guard Ahmad Smith leads the Gorloks in scoring at 16.5 points per game. Sophomore center Kevin Miller scores 14.7 points per game while grabbing a team-high 8.4 rebounds per game. Freshman guard Hunter Ward is averaging 10.0 points per game.

Webster is scoring an average of 75.0 points per game, and is shooting 49.6 percent from the floor, 32.3 percent on 3-pointers and 66.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 64.9 points per game while shooting 39.8 percent from the floor, 34.1 percent on 3-pointers and 72.7 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first eight seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title four times in the last five seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games four times in the last five years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 24 wins in 2014 marks just the sixth time in school history it

won at least that many in a season, and is a school record.

The Green Knights won 23 games in 2010, and also won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 80-22 record from 2011 to 2014 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 133-37. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 5 ranking the weeks of Feb. 17, Feb. 24 and March 3, 2014.

Gries is the Word:

St. Norbert senior guard Brandon Gries, who is averaging 16.2 points per game this season, became the 26th player in school history to reach the 1,000-point mark for his career on Jan. 4 against Lawrence.

Gries, the 2014 Midwest Conference Player of the Year and a three-time first-team All-MWC selection, currently has 1,221 career points to sit in 15th place all-time at St. Norbert in career scoring. Gary Herold is 14th with 1,222 points from 1956-58. Romie Kosnar is 13th with 1,234 points from 1947-51, while Nathan Hoffmann is 12th with 1,238 points from 1999 to

2002. Dick Rankin sits in 11th place with 1,239 points from 1961 to 1965.

Gries, who has made 438 career free throws, broke a 44-year-old St. Norbert record with six free throws against Ripon on Feb. 19. Jack Gebler previously held the St. Norbert record with 417 from 1966-70.

Cerroni Chat:

St. Norbert senior guard Kam Cerroni holds the NCAA Division III lead in three-point field goal percentage at 54.7 percent. Cerroni has made 65 of his last 113 3s in his last 15 games for a 57.5 percentage.

Cerroni, whose 93 made three-point field goals this season is a St. Norbert single-season record, has made seven 3-pointers in a game four times this season. Prior to this year, that had only been done seven times previously in St. Norbert history. Cerroni is third in Division III with 3.88 made 3-pointers per game. He is also sixth nationally in free-throw percentage at 91.3 percent.

Cerroni's St. Norbert-record streak of 45 consecutive made free throws came

to an end in the first half of the Grinnell game on Feb. 15.

Schwoerer Stuff:

St. Norbert junior forward Andrew Schwoerer remains among the NCAA Division III leaders in field-goal percentage. Schwoerer enters the NCAA Tournament third nationally with a field-goal percentage of 67.3 percent.

Schwoerer, who scores 22 points against Carroll last Friday and 21 points against Grinnell on Friday, has made 149 of 221 field-goal attempts this season.

Schwoerer, a 58.5 percent career shooter from the floor, has 986 career points. Should Schwoerer reach 1,000 point this season, he'd be only the third St. Norbert player since 1975 to reach that plateau as a junior. Joe Emmerich (1,811 points from 1980-84) and Lee Schroeder (1,308 points from 1986-90) are the only two Green Knights to do it in the last 40 seasons.


Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert has its most experi-

enced team ever, with three seniors having playing in 100 career games only the second, third and fourth players in school history to do so. Andy Fox (101 games), Brandon Gries (100) and Garrett Thorn (100) reached those marks this past weekend. Paul Appleton, who played from 2010-13, is the St. Norbert career leader with 104.

- * St. Norbert is averaging 83.0 points per game, second in the Midwest Conference to Grinnell's 116.8 points per game. The Green Knights have not averaged 80 points per game in a season since the 1975-76 squad netted 84.0 points per game.
- * St. Norbert's rebounding margin is second in Division III at a robust plus-9.9 rebounds per game. The Green Knights are third nationally in scoring margin at plus-17.3 points per game.
- * St. Norbert is 35-1 in its last 36 games against Midwest Conference opponents, which dates back to December 2012. The only loss during that stretch was a 104-99 overtime loss at Grinnell on Feb. 9, 2013.
