## St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview NICOLET NATIONAL BANK HOLIDAY TOURNAMENT

#### **Tournament Overview:**

St. Norbert hosts the Seventh Annual Nicolet National Bank Holiday Tournament at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights are looking for their second consecutive and fourth overall tournament title. Admission to the tournament is free.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert has never faced Alma or Buena Vista in men's basketball.

St. Norbert leads Viterbo 2-0 in an all-time series. The Green Knights won in La Crosse 67-55 on Jan. 29, 1982 and then claimed a 98-69 win on Jan. 14, 1983 in De Pere.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 126-55 in his eighth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 177-86.

Alma coach Sam Hargraves (Calvin, 1998) is 19-40 in his third season in Alma.

Buena Vista coach Brian Van Haaften (Northwestern-Iowa, 1988) is 344-134 in his 18th season in Storm Lake.

Viterbo coach Wayne Wagner (Viterbo, 1992) is 204-256 in his 15th season in La Crosse.

#### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked 14th in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the game 6-1 overall. The Green Knights picked up another key Midwest Conference win in their last outing, a 76-69 win over Carroll on Dec. 18.

Senior guard Brandon Gries leads the Green Knights with 19.6 points and 6.7 rebounds per game. Senior guard Kam Cerroni is averaging 16.0 points per game and is shooting 51.0 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Junior forward Andrew Schwoerer is averaging 14.8 points per game while shooting 64.7 percent from the floor.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 82.1 points per game, and is shooting 50.7 percent from the floor, 38.3 percent on 3-pointers and 80.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 72.0 points per game while shooting 41.3 percent from the floor, 35.2 percent on 3-pointers and 72.6 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **About the Scots:**

Alma enters the tournament with a 1-8 overall record. The Scots, whose lone win came in a 75-64 win over Finlandia on Dec. 8, last played on Dec. 16 when they lost 97-69 at UW-Whitewater.

Senior forward Isiah Law leads the Scots at 13.8 points and 4.7 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Scott Nikodemski is averaging 11.3 points per game, while senior guard Brandon Krause is averaging 9.4 points per game.

Alma is scoring an average of 72.1 points per game, and is shooting 45.2 percent from the floor, 30.5 percent on 3-pointers and 66.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 85.1 points per game while shooting 48.1 percent from the floor, 39.5 percent on 3-pointers and 71.6 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **About the Beavers:**

Buena Vista enters the tournament with a 4-4 overall record. The Beavers have been idle since Dec. 14, when they dropped a 95-68 decision at UW-Superior.

Junior guard Cole Darrow leads the Beavers in scoring at 19.9 points per game. Junior center Greg Sibenaller averaging 11.2 points per game. Junior center Nick Wuebker averages 9.2 points and 7.0 rebounds per game while shooting 63.3 percent from the floor.

Buena Vista is scoring an average of 88.5 points per game, and is shooting 50.5 percent from the floor, 37.1 percent on 3-pointers and 68.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 79.5 points per game while shooting 44.9 percent from the floor, 41.1 percent on 3-pointers and 68.5 percent at the free-throw line.

#### About the V-Hawks:

Viterbo enters the tournament at 8-7 overall. The V-Hawks, a NAIA member, are 2-1 this season against Division III competition with wins over St. Mary's (Minn.) and Luther while losing to UW-La Crosse. Viterbo last played in a 79-67 win over Goshen on Dec. 23.

Senior forward Cole Lewis leads the V-Hawks in scoring at 15.1 points per game while shooting 60.5 percent from the floor. Freshman forward David Shepard is netting 11.5 points per game, while junior guard Alex Diciaula is averaging 10.0 points per game.

Viterbo is scoring an average of 69.3 points per game, and is shoot-

ing 47.7 percent from the floor, 37.7 percent on 3-pointers and 63.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 69.7 points per game while shooting 47.9 percent from the floor, 38.4 percent on 3-pointers and 70.8 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **Building a Winner:**

In his first seven seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title three times in the last four seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games three times in the last four years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 20 wins in 2013 marked just the fifth time in school history it won at least that many in a season. The Green Knights won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002) and a school-record 23 games in 2010. St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011.

St. Norbert's 79-25 record from 2010 to 2013 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 115-37. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 6 ranking the week of Dec. 6, 2010.

#### Gries is the Word:

St. Norbert senior guard Brandon Gries, who is averaging 19.6 points per game this season, enters the Cornell game with 969 points. He needs 31 points to become the 26th player in St. Norbert history to score 1,000 points. Gries would also be only the eighth St. Norbert cager to reach that mark playing the majority of his career in the Midwest Conference.

Gries, who has made 367 career free throws, needs 51 made free throws to become the St. Norbert career leader in made free throws. Jack Gebler owns the St. Norbert record with 417 from 1966-70.

As of Dec. 16, Gries was fourth among active Division III players in career free throws made at 353.

Gries was 14-for-14 from the charity stripe in a 76-69 win over Carroll on Dec. 18. Gries became the fifth player in St. Norbert history to be perfect with at least 14 attempts. Jake Dietz was the last to do so, going 14-for-14 against Grinnell on Jan. 17, 2009.
