St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 19 St. Norbert College (12-1, 8-0) vs. Knox College (4-9, 2-6) Saturday, January 17, 2015 - 3 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert entertains Knox as the Green Knights attempt to remain unbeaten in Midwest Conference action. The Green Knights have won 32 consecutive games against Midwest Conference opposition.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Knox 29-10 in a series dating back to the 1985-86 season. The Green Knights have won 10 straight games in the series since the Prairie Fire swept the season series in the 2007-08 season.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Knox 87-51 on Feb. 1, 2014 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Green Knights led 36-18 at halftime. Andrew Schwoerer collected 26 points and 12 rebounds to lead St. Norbert, while Tyler Pauley added 12 points and Austin Elliott 10. David Jones had a team-high 12 points for the Prairie Fire, which shot 31.0 percent from the floor.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 157-57 in his ninth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 208-88.

Knox coach Kevin Walden (Knox, 2001) is 6-53 in his third season in Galesburg.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 19 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the game 12-1 overall and 8-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights shot over 65 percent from the floor for the second-consecutive game in topping Beloit 73-53 on Tuesday at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. St. Norbert has won its last 32 games against Midwest Conference opponents.

Senior forward Andrew Schwoerer leads the Green Knights with averages of 17.4 points and 8.3 rebounds per game, and is also shooting 63.2 - MORE - 2014-2015 Results

percent from the field. Senior guard Austin Elliott is averaging 14.2 points per game, while senior center Steven Hofacker is registering 10.9 points and 6.0 rebounds per game while shooting 60.2 percent from the floor.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 79.2 points per game, and is shooting a Division III-best 55.1 percent from the floor, 42.9 percent on 3-pointers and 74.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 63.8 points per game while shooting 39.6 percent from the floor, 33.9 percent on 3-pointers and 69.9 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Prairie Fire:

Knox enters the game with a 4-9 overall record and a 2-6 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Prairie Fire, which is 1-4 on the road this season, dropped a 111-91 decision at home Wednesday to Grinnell. Knox's last win came in a 73-60 triumph over Cornell on Jan. 7.

Sophomore guard Robert Suntken leads the Prairie Fire in scoring at 13.8 points per game. Freshman forward Orlando Brown is averaging 10.2 points per game, while freshman forward Caylab Herrera comes off the bench to net 9.2 points per game. Senior guard Mitch Murphy averages 9.1 points per game. Sophomore forward Mike Martin averages 8.2 points and a team-high 6.8 rebounds per game.

Knox is scoring an average of 71.6 points per game, and is shooting 46.3 percent from the floor, 35.2 percent on 3-pointers and 64.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 80.5 points per game while shooting 46.1 percent from the floor, 34.6 percent on 3-pointers and 68.3 percent at the free-throw line.

Sharp Shooters:

St. Norbert shot 65.9 percent from the floor in Tuesday's 73-53 win over Beloit. It marked the second straight game St. Norbert shot over 65 percent from the field. The Green Knights shot 65.1 percent on Jan. 7 in an 81-72 win over Lawrence.

The shooting effort against Beloit

tied for the third-best field-goal percentage in a game against a non-Grinnell opponent in school history. The school record for field-goal percentage in a non-Grinnell game is 69.7 percent, going 30-for-43 from the floor in a 81-63 win over UW-Milwaukee on Dec. 14, 1985.

St. Norbert leads Division III in field-goal percentage at 55.1 percent.

Building a Winner:

In his first eight-plus seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title four times in the last five seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games four times in the last five years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 is a school record. The Green Knights won 23 games in 2010, and also won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 81-23 record from 2011 to 2014 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 146-39. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 5 ranking the weeks of Feb. 17, Feb. 24 and March 3, 2014.

Schwoerer Stuff:

St. Norbert senior forward Andrew Schwoerer is a pre-season All-America selection this season by both D3hoops.com and DIII News.

Schwoerer reached the career 1,000-point mark last season, only the third St. Norbert player since 1975 to do so as a junior.

Schwoerer has 1,231 career points to place 15th on the St. Norbert career scoring list. Romie Kosnar is 14th with 1,234 points from 1947-51. Nathan Hoffmann is 13th with 1,238 points from 1999-2002, while Richard Rankin is 12th with 1,239 points from 1961-65.
