St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 14 St. Norbert College (15-1, 11-0) vs. Ripon College (11-5, 8-3) Tuesday, January 27, 2015 - 7:30 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert and Ripon tangle in a battle of teams both residing in the top three of the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights lead Monmouth by two games and Ripon by three games with seven games remaining.

The Series:

Ripon holds a 60-53 series lead over St. Norbert in a spirited rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have narrowed the gap by winning 16 of the last 18 meetings over the last eight seasons.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Ripon 80-68 on Dec. 3, 2014 at Storzer Center in Ripon. The Green Knights led 44-22 at halftime and 53-22 early in the second half before the Red Hawks climbed back to within six points late. Austin Elliott led St. Norbert with 23 points, while Andrew Schwoerer registered 18 points and 12 rebounds. Ty Sabin pumped in 27 points for the Red Hawks, while Kyle Loughrin added 19 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 160-57 in his ninth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 211-88.

Ripon coach Ryan Kane (St. Norbert, 1999) is 39-25 in his third season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 15-1 overall and 11-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights picked up a key road win Saturday at Monmouth, topping the second-place Scots 76-62. St. Norbert has won its last 35 games against Midwest Conference opponents.

forward Senior Andrew Schwoerer tops the Green Knights with 16.9 points and 7.7 rebounds per game. Schwoerer is 24 points shy of becoming the first St. Norbert player in 25 years to reach 1,300 career points. Senior guard Austin Elliott is averaging 14.6 points and 4.4 rebounds per game, and nearly posted a triple-double in the win over Monmouth with 16 points, 10 assists and nine rebounds. Senior center Steven Hofacker is averaging 10.0 points and 5.6 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 79.1 points per game, and is shooting a Division III-best 54.6 percent from the floor, 42.9 percent on 3-pointers and 75.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 62.3 points per game while shooting 39.3 percent from the floor, 33.0 percent on 3-pointers and 68.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game at 11-5 overall and 8-3 in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks have been idle since last Wednesday, when they gained a 72-63 win over Lawrence in Ripon.

Sophomore guard Ty Sabin, Division III's second-leading scorer, tops the Red Hawks averaging 28.4 points per game, and has 925 points in his career. Senior guard Kyle Loughrin is averaging 16.6 points per game. Junior forward Justin Leistikow is netting 6.4 points and a team-high 7.2 rebounds per game. Freshman forward Nathan Runde comes off the bench to score 5.7 points per game.

Ripon is scoring an average of 79.0 points per game, and is shooting 48.6 percent from the floor, 39.2 percent on 3-pointers and 73.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 76.6 points per game while shooting 47.6 percent from the floor, 35.4 percent on 3-pointers and 63.5 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first eight-plus seasons,

head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title four times in the last five seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games four times in the last five years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 is a school record. The Green Knights won 23 games in 2010, and also won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 81-23 record from 2011 to 2014 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 149-39. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 5 ranking the weeks of Feb. 17, Feb. 24 and March 3, 2014.

Schwoerer Stuff:

St. Norbert senior forward Andrew Schwoerer is a pre-season All-America selection this season by both D3hoops.com and DIII News.

Schwoerer reached the career 1,000-point mark last season, only the third St. Norbert player since 1975 to do so as a junior.

Schwoerer has 1,276 career points to place 11th on the St. Norbert career scoring list. He trails Jerry Lamers (1,281 points from 1955-59) by six points for 10th place. Schwoerer would be the first St. Norbert player in 25 years to crack the top 10 in career scoring.

Jump Shot:

* - As of Jan. 26, St. Norbert leads Division III in field-goal percentage at 54.6 percent. The Green Knights are also second in scoring margin at plus-16.8 points per game and second in rebound margin at plus-11.8 rebounds per game.
