St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 14 St. Norbert College (16-1, 12-0) vs. Carroll Univ. (8-9, 5-7) Saturday, January 31, 2015 - 5 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert faces Carroll for the second time in 11 days when the Green Knights host the Pioneers Saturday. The Green Knights can clinch a spot in the Midwest Conference Tournament with a win and losses by Lake Forest and Grinnell.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 46-45 lead on Carroll in a series dating back to the 1933-34 season. The Green Knights have won the last 11 of the last 13 meetings, and have also won eight straight games in the series at Schuldes Sports Center.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Carroll 67-61 on Jan. 21, 2015 at Van Male Fieldhouse in Waukesha. The Green Knights pulled away from a 55-55 tie with a 12-6 run over the last four minutes. Austin Elliott was the only St. Norbert player to score in double figures at 25 points. Brian Nagy led Carroll with 21 points, while Kyle Keranen added 17 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 161-57 in his ninth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 212-88.

Carroll coach Paul Combs (Ripon, 1993) is 23-18 in his second season in Waukesha. Including stops at Lakeland, UW-Platteville and Wayne State (Neb.), Combs is 239-178 in 16 years of collegiate coaching.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 16-1 overall and 12-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights pushed their lead in the Midwest Conference to three games with an 85-65 win over Ripon on Tuesday at - MORE -

Schuldes Sports Center. St. Norbert has won its last 36 games against Midwest Conference opponents.

Senior forward Andrew Schwoerer tops the Green Knights with 17.3 points and 7.9 rebounds per game. Schwoerer is one point short of becoming the first St. Norbert player in 25 years to reach 1,300 career points. Senior guard Austin Elliott is averaging 14.9 points and 4.4 rebounds per game. Senior center Steven Hofacker is averaging 9.9 points and 5.5 rebounds per game, while junior forward Bryan Dalton is registering 8.2 points and 5.1 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 79.5 points per game, and is shooting a Division III-best 54.9 percent from the floor, 43.7 percent on 3-pointers and 75.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 62.5 points per game while shooting 39.1 percent from the floor, 33.3 percent on 3-pointers and 67.1 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the game 8-9 overall and 5-7 in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers have lost six of their last seven games, including a 54-51 loss at Beloit this past Tuesday.

The Pioneers' top two scorers, sophomore guard Kyle Keranen and junior forward Brian Nagy, both sat out the Beloit game. Keranen is averaging 14.6 points per game, while Nagy is totaling 13.3 points, 6.9 rebounds and 5.1 assists per game. Freshman forward Marcus Johnson is averaging 9.7 points and 4.2 rebounds per game, while sophomore forward Austin Fritz is averaging 8.0 points per game.

Carroll is scoring an average of 65.2 points per game, and is shooting 46.6 percent from the floor, 32.1 percent on 3-pointers and 74.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 66.9 points per game while shooting 47.2 percent from the floor, 38.2 percent on 3-pointers and

66.6 percent at the free-throw line.

Building a Winner:

In his first eight-plus seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title four times in the last five seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games four times in the last five years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 is a school record. The Green Knights won 23 games in 2010, and also won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 81-23 record from 2011 to 2014 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 150-39. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 5 ranking the weeks of Feb. 17, Feb. 24 and March 3, 2014.

Schwoerer Stuff:

St. Norbert senior forward Andrew Schwoerer is a pre-season All-America selection this season by both D3hoops.com and DIII News.

Schwoerer reached the career 1,000-point mark last season, only the third St. Norbert player since 1975 to do so as a junior.

Schwoerer has 1,299 career points to place 10th on the St. Norbert career scoring list. Schwoerer is the first St. Norbert player in 25 years to crack the top 10 in career scoring. Lee Schroeder is in ninth place with 1,308 points from 1986-90.

Jump Shot:

* - As of Jan. 26, St. Norbert leads Division III in field-goal percentage at 54.6 percent. The Green Knights are also second in scoring margin at plus-16.8 points per game and second in rebound margin at plus-11.8 rebounds per game.
