St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview MIDWEST CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT Fri., Feb. 27 - No. 3 St. Norbert (22-1) vs. Ripon (15-8) - 8 p.m. Sat., Feb. 28 - Championship vs. Monmouth (16-7) or Grinnell (14-9) - 6 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert, making its Midwest Conference-best eighth consecutive conference tournament appearance, hosts Monmouth, Grinnell and Ripon this weekend. The Green Knights, who have won five out of the last six MWC titles, are vying for their fifth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in six years. The MWC Tournament champion receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The Series:

Ripon holds a 60-54 series lead over St. Norbert in a spirited rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have narrowed the gap by winning 17 of the last 19 meetings over the last eight seasons. St. Norbert has won 11 straight games in the series at home.

St. Norbert leads Monmouth 26-11 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights are 16-2 all-time in the series at Schuldes Sports Center.

St. Norbert leads Grinnell 27-16 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights are 18-4 all-time at home in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 167-57 in his ninth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 218-88.

Ripon coach Ryan Kane (St. Norbert, 1999) is 42-28 in his third season in Ripon

Monmouth coach Todd Skrivseth (Coe, 1996) is 36-56 in his fourth season in Monmouth.

Grinnell coach David Arseneault (Colby, 1976) is 343-256 in his 26th season in Grinnell.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 3 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the tournament 22-1 overall. The Green Knights ran their winning streak to 13 games with a 58-48 win over Cornell this past Saturday to finish Midwest Conference play 18-0.

Senior forward Andrew Schwoerer leads the Green Knights with 16.7 points and 7.2 rebounds per game. Senior guard Austin Elliott is averaging 14.1 points per game. Senior center Steven Hofacker is averaging 10.0

points and 5.7 rebounds per game. Freshman guard D.J. DeValk and junior forward Bryan Dalton are both averaging 7.7 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 78.5 points per game, and is shooting an NCAA all divisions-best 54.8 percent from the floor, 42.8 percent on 3-pointers and 73.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 59.8 points per game while shooting 38.8 percent from the floor, 32.4 percent on 3-pointers and 68.2 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the tournament 15-8 overall. The Red Hawks, who tipped Knox 70-69 this past Saturday, finished 12-6 in the Midwest Conference.

Sophomore guard Ty Sabin is averaging a lusty 28.4 points per game, and is the second-leading scorer in Division III. Senior guard Kyle Loughrin is averaging 17.5 points per game. Junior forward Justin Leistikow is averaging 6.0 points and a team-high 6.9 rebounds per game.

Ripon is scoring an average of 77.9 points per game, and is shooting 49.0 percent from the floor, 39.5 percent on 3-pointers and 72.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 76.7 points per game while shooting 47.7 percent from the floor, 35.5 percent on 3-pointers and 66.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth enters the tournament 16-7 overall after finishing second in the Midwest Conference at 13-5. The Scots defeated Lawrence 73-59 this past Saturday.

Junior forward Andrew Mathison leads the Scots with 14.9 points and 7.4 rebounds per game. Freshman guard Will Jones is averaging 14.5 points and 6.3 rebounds per game. Junior guard Jon Calhoun is averaging 9.0 points per game, while freshman guard Riley Blea is netting 6.3 points per game.

Monmouth is scoring an average of 73.7 points per game, and is shooting 46.5 percent from the floor, 33.1 percent on 3-pointers and 67.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 70.7 points per game while shooting 45.2 percent from the floor, 38.3 percent on 3-pointers and 67.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Grinnell enters the tournament at 14-9 overall and went 12-6 in the

Midwest Conference. The Pioneers defeated Illinois College 125-107 this past Saturday.

Senior guard Jack Taylor leads Division III in scoring at 29.2 points per game. Senior guard Luke Yaeger is averaging 23.0 points per game, while sophomore guard Julian Marx is netting 12.1 points per game. Freshman guard Braedon Bayer is averaging 10.8 points per game.

Grinnell is scoring a Division III-best 116.5 points per game, and is shooting 42.8 percent from the floor, 37.7 percent on 3-pointers and 76.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 106.5 points per game while shooting 59.7 percent from the floor, 32.8 percent on 3-pointers and 66.1 percent at the free-throw line.

Streak Skinny:

St. Norbert became the first Midwest Conference men's basket-ball team to post consecutive unbeaten league seasons in 64 years after finishing 18-0 for the second-straight year.

The Green Knights, who have won a record 42 consecutive games against MWC opponents, were the first team to go two years without a league loss since Beloit in 1950 and 1951.

St. Norbert's current streak began with a 57-52 win over Ripon on Feb. 12, 2013 in De Pere.

St. Norbert is 53-1 in its last 54 games against MWC foes. Grinnell was the last MWC team to beat the Green Knights, posting a 104-99 overtime win on Feb. 9, 2013 in Grinnell, Iowa.

Building a Winner:

In his first eight-plus seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title five times in the last six seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games five times in the last six years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 is a school record. The Green Knights won 23 games in 2010, 22 games in 2015 and also won 21 games three times (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's current 83-18 record from 2012 to 2015 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 156-39. St.

Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 16-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.

Schwoerer Stuff:

St. Norbert senior forward Andrew Schwoerer is a pre-season All-America selection this season by both D3hoops.com and DIII News.

Schwoerer, who was named a CoSIDA Academic All-District selection on Feb. 5, reached the career 1,000-point mark last season, only the third St. Norbert player since 1975 to do so as a junior.

Schwoerer has 1,390 career points to place seventh on the St. Norbert career

scoring list. Schwoerer is the first St. Norbert player in 25 years to crack the top 10 in career scoring. John Sattler is sixth on the list with 1,407 points from 1970-74.

Jump Shots:

*-St. Norbert is currently second in Division III in three-point field-goal percentage (42.8 percent) and rebounding margin (plus-11.3 per game).

* - Śt. Norbert's Midwest Conference title this season is its sixth since 2002. In those 14 years, the Green Knights' six outright MWC titles are the most in the league. Lawrence has five titles, with four of those outright. Grinnell

has three titles, while Lake Forest has one.

* - St. Norbert is 27-2 all-time at home under Gary Grzesk against this year's tournament field. The Green Knights are 11-1 against Ripon, 9-1 against Grinnell and 7-0 against Monmouth.

* - Since 1957-58, St. Norbert has gone 429-204 in home contests, good for a .678 winning percentage. In those 58 years, St. Norbert has only had a losing record at home games in six seasons, and has never suffered a home losing streak longer than four games. The Green Knights are 97-20 in its last 117 games played at Schuldes Sports Center.
