St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview NCAA DIVISION III TOURNAMENT - CENTRAL REGIONAL

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert makes its fifth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in six years when it hosts a four-team Central Regional at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights face at-large qualifier Elmhurst in the first round.

The Series:

St. Norbert and Elmhurst are tied 4-4 in an all-time series begun in the 1999-2000 season. The Green Knights have won the last two games in the series, including the last meeting in a 74-48 win over the Bluejays on Nov. 23, 2010 at Schuldes Sports Center.

St. Thomas leads St. Norbert 6-3 in an all-time series begun in the 1949-50 season. The two teams have not met since a 61-48 St. Thomas win on Dec. 14, 1991 in St. Paul, Minn.

Northwestern leads St. Norbert 1-0 in a series started during the 2009-10 season. The Eagles topped the Green Knights 72-70 in a Nicolet Bank Tournament game on Dec. 29, 2009 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 169-57 in his ninth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 220-88.

Elmhurst coach John Baines (Illinois Wesleyan, 1998) is 33-18 in his second season in Elmhurst. He was 57-38 in three seasons at St. Francis (Ill.) to give him an overall record of 90-56 in five seasons.

St. Thomas coach John Tauer (St. Thomas, 1995) is 98-18 in his fourth season in St. Paul.

Northwestern coach Tim Grosz (Northwestern-St. Paul, 1992) is 284-151 in his 15th season in St. Paul.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its seventh NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its fifth in six seasons, and is 3-6 all-time in the tournament. Two of St. Norbert's previous appearances ended at the hands of the eventual national champion - UW-Whitewater in 1984 and UW-Stevens Point in 2010. The Green Knights lost to Final Four-qualifier Illinois Wesleyan in the second round of last year's NCAA Tournament by an 84-68 score.

ance and its first since 2009. The Bluejays are 2-3 all-time in the tournament.

St. Thomas is making its 16th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance. The Tommies have made 10 consecutive appearances and won the national championship in 2011. St. Thomas, who lost 88-77 to Augustana last year in the first round, is 23-15 all-time in the tournament.

Northwestern is making its fifth consecutive and overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance. The Eagles are 0-4 all-time in the tournament.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 5 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the tournament 24-1 overall. The Green Knights ran their winning streak to 15 games with a 91-73 win over Grinnell in the championship game of the Midwest Conference Tournament.

Senior forward Andrew Schwoerer, the co-MWC Player of the Year, leads the Green Knights with 16.8 points and 7.2 rebounds per game. Senior guard Austin Elliott is averaging 13.8 points and 4.6 assists per game. Senior center Steven Hofacker is averaging 10.4 points and 5.6 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Ben Bobinski is netting an average of 8.3 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 79.2 points per game, and is shooting an NCAA all divisions-best 54.7 percent from the floor, 43.0 percent on 3-pointers and 74.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.9 points per game while shooting 38.8 percent from the floor, 33.4 percent on 3-pointers and 68.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Bluejays:

Elmhurst enters the tournament 17-9 overall after finishing in third place in the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin at 9-5. The Bluejays have lost their last two games, both to Illinois Wesleyan. Elmhurst lost 80-67 this past Friday in a CCIW Tournament semifinal game.

Junior guard Kyle Wuest is averaging 14.8 points per game. Junior forward Erik Crittenden is netting 11.6 points and 6.2 rebounds per game. Junior guard Bryant Ackerman is averaging 10.7 points per game, while junior forward Will Nixon is averaging 8.4 points and a team-high 6.3 rebounds per game.

Elmhurst is scoring an average of

76.3 points per game, and is shooting 43.7 percent from the floor, 35.1 percent on 3-pointers and 74.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 68.1 points per game while shooting 40.4 percent from the floor, 31.6 percent on 3-pointers and 71.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Tommies:

St. Thomas, ranked No. 3 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, is 24-3 overall. The Tommies, who won the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference with a 17-3 mark, won the MIAC Tournament with a 66-63 win over Bethel on Sunday.

Senior guard Marcus Alipate leads the Tommies in scoring at 13.3 points per game. Junior guard Taylor Montero is netting 12.1 points per game, while senior forward Connor Nord is netting 10.8 points and a team-high 7.3 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Grant Shaeffer is averaging 10.6 points per game.

St. Thomas is scoring an average of 75.3 points per game, and is shooting 48.3 percent from the floor, 43.1 percent on 3-pointers and 70.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 62.0 points per game while shooting 47.1 percent from the floor, 34.5 percent on 3-pointers and 62.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Eagles:

Northwestern enters the tournament 18-9 overall. The Eagles, who currently have a 16-game winning streak, won the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference Tournament with a 68-39 win over Minnesota-Morris this past Saturday.

Junior guard Michael Carney leads the Eagles in scoring with an average of 15.5 points per game. Sophomore guard Porter Morrell averages 10.4 points per game, while sophomore guard Will Gisler averages 9.8 points and 6.2 rebounds per game. Junior forward Caleb Janson is averaging 8.2 points and 7.0 rebounds per game.

Northwestern is scoring an average of 70.3 points per game, and is shooting 42.7 percent from the floor, 37.5 percent on 3-pointers and 71.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 63.4 points per game while shooting 42.7 percent from the floor, 33.2 percent on 3-pointers and 71.1 percent at the free-throw line.

ball team to post consecutive unbeaten league seasons in 64 years after finishing 18-0 for the second-straight year.

The Green Knights, who have won a record 44 consecutive games against MWC opponents, were the first team to go two years without a league loss since Beloit in 1950 and 1951.

St. Norbert's current streak began with a 57-52 win over Ripon on Feb. 12, 2013 in De Pere.

St. Norbert is 55-1 in its last 56 games against MWC foes. Grinnell was the last MWC team to beat the Green Knights, posting a 104-99 overtime win on Feb. 9, 2013 in Grinnell, Iowa.

Building a Winner:

In his first eight-plus seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title five times in the last six seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games five times in the last six years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 is a school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's current 85-18 record from 2012 to 2015 marks the best four-

year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 158-39. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 16-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.

Schwoerer Stuff:

St. Norbert senior forward Andrew Schwoerer was named Co-Midwest Conference Player of the Year following another banner season.

Schwoerer, who was named a CoSIDA Academic All-District selection on Feb. 5, reached the career 1,000-point mark last season, only the third St. Norbert player since 1975 to do so as a junior.

Schwoerer has 1,425 career points to place sixth on the St. Norbert career scoring list. Schwoerer is the first St. Norbert player in 25 years to crack the top 10 in career scoring. Bill Feller currently sits in the No. 5 spot with 1,481 points from 1951-55.

Schwoerer is currently 13th in Division III in field-goal percentage at 60.9 percent.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is currently second in Division III in three-point field-goal percentage (43.0 percent). St. Thomas is the national leader at 43.1 percent.

* - St. Norbert is second nationally in scoring margin (plus-18.3 points per game), third in rebounding margin

(plus-11.0 per game), fourth in assist-to-turnover ration (plus 1.6) and fifth in fewest personal fouls per game (13.8).

* - St. Norbert freshman guard D.J. DeValk is 45th in Division III in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-2.36, while senior guard Austin Elliott is 79th at plus-1.94.

* - St. Norbert has won games this season while scoring in the 50s (once), 60s (four times), 70s (seven times), 80s (eight times), 90s (twice), 100s (twice) and 110s (once).

* - St. Norbert has made 408 free throws in 548 attempts, while its opponents have attempted just 307, making 210.

* - St. Norbert's Midwest Conference title this season is its sixth since 2002. In those 14 years, the Green Knights' six outright MWC titles are the most in the league. Lawrence has five titles, with four of those outright. Grinnell has three titles, while Lake Forest has one.

* - Since 1957-58, St. Norbert has gone 431-204 in home contests, good for a .679 winning percentage. In those 58 years, St. Norbert has only had a losing record at home games in six seasons, and has never suffered a home losing streak longer than four games. The Green Knights are 99-20 in its last 119 games played at Schuldes Sports Center.
