St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 18 St. Norbert College (7-0, 4-0) at Illinois College (1-6, 0-4) Wedneday, December 17, 2014 - 7 p.m. Bruner Center (1,600) - Jacksonville, Illinois

Game Overview:

St. Norbert looks to start a season 8-0 for the first time in 92 years when it travels Wednesday to Illinois College. The Green Knights have won 27 consecutive regular-season games.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Illinois College 31-7 in an all-time series dating back to the 1985-86 season. The Green Knights have won the last 15 games in the series. St. Norbert is 12-6 all-time on the road in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Illinois College 90-63 on Feb. 22, 2014 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Green Knights shot 59.4 percent from the floor and held a 37-22 rebounding edge. Kam Cerroni and Andrew Schwoerer had 14 points apiece, while Brandon Gries added 11 points, 12 rebounds and six assists for St. Norbert. Chris Marrs and Brandon Berry both had 15 points for the Blueboys.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 152-56 in his ninth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 203-87.

Illinois College coach Mike Worrell (Urbana, 1986) is 183-241 in his 19th season in Jacksonville.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 7-0 overall and 4-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, ranked No. 18 in this week's D3hoops.com Top 25, have won 30 of its last 31 games overall dating back to last season.

Senior forward Andrew Schwoerer is averaging 18.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game, and is shooting 59.3 percent from the floor. Senior guard Austin Elliott is averaging 16.1 points per game, while senior center

National Bank Holiday Tournament - De Pere, Wis. **Note:** Home games in **bold;** (rankings) by D3hoops.com. Steven Hofacker is posting 12.3 points and 6.1 rebounds per game while shooting 63.0 percent from the floor. Junior forward Bryan Dalton is averaging 11.4 points and 7.0 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 82.4 points per game, and is shooting 54.7 percent from the floor, 46.7 percent on 3-pointers and 74.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 66.1 points per game while shooting 38.1 percent from the floor, 31.1 percent on 3-pointers and 71.1 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Blueboys:

Illinois College enters the game 1-6 overall and 0-4 in the Midwest Conference. The Blueboys, who beat Rockford 90-68 on Nov. 21, are coming off an 80-71 loss Saturday at Ripon.

Sophomore guard Tim Schappaugh leads the Blueboys in scoring at 12.3 points per game. Sophomore forward Mitchell Patterson is netting 11.0 points per game while snaring 6.0 rebounds per game. Senior forward Brandon Fishburn is scoring 9.6 points per game.

Illinois College is scoring an average of 66.4 points per game, and is shooting 38.8 percent from the floor, 31.3 percent on 3-pointers and 73.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 79.4 points per game while shooting 46.5 percent from the floor, 31.9 percent on 3-pointers and 71.5 percent at the free-throw line.

Charity Case:

St. Norbert has "made hay" at the free-throw line this season, canning charity tosses at a clip of 18.4 made per game.

The Green Knights are second in the Midwest Conference in made free throws per game, just behind Grinnell's 21.7 made per game.

St. Norbert is 129-for-173 at the free-throw line as a team. Opponents have attempted just 83 free throws this season, making 59 (8.4 per game).

Start Me Up:

St. Norbert's 7-0 start matches its best start to a men's basketball season in 92 years. The Green Knights also went 7-0 to open the 2009-10 season.

The Green Knights went 8-0 during the 1922-23 season, and also went 12-0 in 1919-20.

Building a Winner:

In his first eight-plus seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title four times in the last five seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games four times in the last five years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 is a school record. The Green Knights won 23 games in 2010, and also won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 81-23 record from 2011 to 2014 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 141-38. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 5 ranking the weeks of Feb. 17, Feb. 24 and March 3, 2014.

Schwoerer Stuff:

St. Norbert senior forward Andrew Schwoerer is a pre-season All-America selection this season by both D3hoops.com and DIII News.

Schwoerer reached the career 1,000-point mark last season, only the third St. Norbert player since 1975 to do so during his junior season.

Schwoerer has 1,131 career points to place 17th on the St. Norbert career scoring list. David Wipperfurth is 16th with 1,146 points from 2008-11. Gary Herold is 15th with 1,222 points from 1956-58.
