# St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview NICOLET NATIONAL BANK HOLIDAY TOURNAMENT

No. 18 St. Norbert College (8-0) vs. College of St. Scholastica (3-5) - 12/29 - 7 p.m. vs. John Carroll Univ. (5-2) or UW-Stout (2-7) - 12/30 - 5 or 7 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

#### **Game Overview:**

St. Norbert hosts the Eighth Annual Nicolet National Bank Holiday Tournament at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights are looking for their third consecutive and fifth overall tournament title. Admission to the tournament is free.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads St. Scholastica 3-0 in an all-time series that dates back to 1982-83. The Green Knights won the last meeting with a 70-42 win on Dec. 29, 2008 in the Second Annual Nicolet National Bank Holiday Tournament.

UW-Stout leads St. Norbert 5-0 in an all-time series that dates back to the 1979-80 season. The Blue Devils won the last meeting 59-58 on Dec. 19, 2005 in Menomonie.

St. Norbert and John Carroll have never met in men's basketball.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 153-56 in his ninth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 204-87.

St. Scholastica coach David Staniger (St. Scholastica, 1989) is 171-210 in his 15th season in Duluth.

John Carroll coach Mike Moran (Xavier, 1973) is 401-213 in his 23rd season in University Heights.

UW-Stout coach Ed Andrist (UW-Stout, 1976) is 185-183 in his 15th season in Menomonie. Including 11 seasons as coach at Mount Senario, Andrist is 435-374 overall in 26 total seasons.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the tournament 8-0 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 18 in this week's D3hoops.com Top 25, have won 31 of its last 32 games - MORE -

overall and 28 consecutive regularseason games dating back to last season.

Senior forward Andrew Schwoerer is averaging 18.5 points and 9.9 rebounds per game, and is shooting 59.8 percent from the floor. Senior guard Austin Elliott is averaging 15.4 points per game, while senior center Steven Hofacker is registering 11.8 points and 6.5 rebounds per game while shooting 64.4 percent from the floor. Junior forward Bryan Dalton is averaging 10.6 points and 6.3 rebounds per

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 83.0 points per game, and is shooting 55.2 percent from the floor (first in Division III), 44.9 percent on 3-pointers and 73.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 65.1 points per game while shooting 38.2 percent from the floor, 32.3 percent on 3-pointers and 70.8 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **About the Saints:**

St. Scholastica enters the tournament 3-5 overall. The Saints have been idle since Dec. 13, when they fell 71-58 in a road loss at Finlandia.

Senior guard LaMonte Hall leads the Saints in scoring at 11.5 points per game. Junior guard Jake Naslund averages 11.3 points per game. Junior guard Andrew Laughlin is netting 8.3 points per game, while sophomore guard Julius Johnson averages 6.4 points and 4.1 rebounds per game.

St. Scholastica is scoring an average of 65.6 points per game, and is shooting 43.1 percent from the floor, 32.6 percent on 3-pointers and 68.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 72.0 points per game while shooting 44.9 percent from the floor, 36.4 percent on 3-pointers and 70.2 percent at the free-throw line.

#### About the Blue Streaks:

John Carroll enters the tournament 5-2 overall. The Blue Streaks lost to No. 24-ranked Marietta 82-68 on Dec. 20.

John Carroll has eight players

averaging 8.3 points per game or Senior forward better. Hollinger leads John Carroll in scoring at 12.4 points per game. Senior guard David Hendrickson nets 12.3 points per game, while sophomore guard David Linane average 11.4 points per game. Sophomore forward Doug Caputo averages 9.4 points and a team-high 6.7 rebounds per game.

John Carroll is scoring an average of 91.0 points per game, and is shooting 47.5 percent from the floor, 37.3 percent on 3-pointers and 71.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 79.1 points per game while shooting 42.3 percent from the floor, 36.3 percent on 3-pointers and 73.1 percent at the free-throw line.

#### About the Blue Devils:

UW-Stout enters the tournament 2-7 overall. The Blue Devils last played on Dec. 20, when they dropped a 69-64 decision at Northwestern (Minn.). Of the 15 players on Stout's roster, 11 are freshmen.

Senior forward Jarvis Ragland leads the Blue Devils at 20.1 points and 5.9 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Brett Ahsenmacher is averaging 10.1 points per game, while freshman guard John Keefe is netting 9.2 points per game.

Stout is scoring an average of 69.2 points per game, and is shooting 43.2 percent from the floor, 31.4 percent on 3-pointers and 65.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 78.8 points per game while shooting 49.4 percent from the floor, 41.6 percent on 3-pointers and 67.3 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **Charity Case:**

St. Norbert has "made hay" at the free-throw line this season, canning charity tosses at a clip of 17.0 made per game.

The Green Knights are second in the Midwest Conference in made free throws per game, just behind Grinnell's 21.7 made per game.



free-throw line as a team. Opponents have attempted just 89 free throws this season, making 63 (7.9 per game).

#### Start Me Up:

St. Norbert's 8-0 start is its best beginning to a men's basketball season in 92 years.

The Green Knights went 8-0 during the 1922-23 season, and also went 12-0 in 1919-20.

#### **Building a Winner:**

In his first eight-plus seasons, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title four times in the last five seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games four times in the last five years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 is a school record. The Green Knights won 23 games in 2010, and also won 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 81-23 record from 2011 to 2014 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 142-38. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 13-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 5 ranking the weeks of Feb. 17, Feb. 24 and March 3, 2014.

#### **Schwoerer Stuff:**

St. Norbert senior forward Andrew Schwoerer is a pre-season All-America selection this season by both D3hoops.com and DIII News.

Schwoerer reached the career 1,000-point mark last season, only the third St. Norbert player since 1975 to do so during his junior season.

Schwoerer has 1,153 career points to place 16th on the St. Norbert career scoring list. Gary Herold is 15th with 1,222 points from 1956-58. Romie Kosnar is 14th with 1,234 points from 1947-51.
