# The Series:

St. Norbert leads Alma 1-0 in a series dating back to the 2013-14 season. The Green Knights won the only meeting over the Scots 103-69 on Dec. 29, 2013 in the Nicolet National Bank Holiday Tournament. St. Norbert, which shot 60.6 percent from the floor, was led by 25 points from Andrew Schwoerer and 15 points from Brandon Gries. D.J. Beckman had 29 points for Alma, including seven three-point field goals.

St. Norbert has never faced Anderson or UW-River Falls in men's basketball.

# The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 177-59 in his tenth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 228-90.

Anderson coach Owen Handy (Wheaton, 2003) is 35-49 in his fourth season in Anderson.

Alma coach Sam Hargraves (Calvin, 1998) is 41-69 in his fifth season in Alma.

UW-River Falls coach Jeff Berkhof (UW-River Falls, 1994) is 112-131 in his tenth season in River Falls.

# About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 23 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the tournament 8-1 overall. The Green Knights, 6-0 in the Midwest Conference, improved their winning streak against league opponents to 50 games with a 76-67 win over Illinois College this past Tuesday in De Pere.

Sophomore forward Mitchell Reinthaler, who has sat out the last two games, leads the Green Knights in scoring at 14.7 points per game. Sophomore guard D.J. DeValk is averaging 14.0 points per game, while jun-

ior guard Ben Bobinski is netting 13.1 points per game. Junior guard Terrence Garner, who was one assist short of registering a tripledouble against Illinois College, is averaging 10.0 points and 6.3 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 73.8 points per game and is shooting 47.0 percent from the floor, 34.8 percent on 3-pointers and 72.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 63.2 points per game while shooting 40.9 percent from the floor, 28.6 percent on 3-pointers and 70.9 percent at the free-throw line.

### About the Ravens:

Anderson enters the tournament 5-3 overall. The Ravens, who are 1-2 in the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference, have been idle since Dec. 19, when they posted an 85-77 home win over Calvin.

The Ravens have five players with a scoring average in double figures. Freshman forward Cole Hartman leads Anderson at 17.4 points and 7.1 rebounds per game, and is shooting 70.4 percent from the floor. Junior guard Nathaniel Acree is averaging 16.1 points per game, while sophomore guard Trevor Lucas is netting 15.5 points per game.

Anderson is averaging 87.3 points per game and is shooting 47.6 percent from the floor, 34.6 percent on 3-pointers and 72.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 80.4 points per game while shooting 43.8 percent from the floor, 31.6 percent on 3-pointers and 72.6 percent at the free-throw line.

#### About the Scots:

Alma enters the tournament with a 5-4 overall record. The Scots had won four consecutive games before losing 82-81 to No. 25-ranked Texas Lutheran on Dec. 20. The Scots are 3-1 against the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin this season.

Senior guard D.J. Beckman leads the Scots in scoring at 13.8 points per game. Senior guard Scott Nikodemski is averaging 13.7 points per game and is shooting 72.2 percent from the floor, while sophomore guard Jason Beckman is netting 11.1 points per game.

Alma is averaging 83.6 points per game and is shooting 50.2 percent from the floor, 41.2 percent on 3-

pointers and 77.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 75.3 points per game while shooting 40.2 percent from the floor, 33.8 percent on 3-pointers and 76.5 percent at the free-throw line.

#### About the Falcons:

UW-River Falls enters the tournament 5-4 overall. The Falcons have been idle since Dec. 19, when they posted an 89-82 road win over Viterbo.

Senior forward Jon Christensen leads the Falcons posting numbers of 21.8 points and 8.9 rebounds per game. Junior forward Garret Pearson is averaging 15.0 points per game, while sophomore guard C.J. Lewis is netting 10.7 points per game.

River Falls is averaging 73.1 points per game and is shooting 44.9 percent from the floor, 36.5 percent on 3-pointers and 62.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 73.6 points per game while shooting 43.5 percent from the floor, 35.1 percent on 3-pointers and 70.3 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **Tourney Talk:**

Since the inception of the Nicolet National Bank Holiday Tournament in 2007, it has featured several exciting moments as well as the expectation of the unexpected.

In the nine years of the tournament, a team ranked in the D3hoops.com Top 25 has participated eight years. However, only twice in the first eight years has a ranked team won the tournament.

No. 12 Augustana beat No. 15 St. Norbert 57-56 in the 2010 championship game, while No. 14 St. Norbert topped Viterbo 70-63 in the 2013 title contest.

St. Norbert has two championship-game wins over nationally ranked foes. The Green Knights stunned No. 1 UW-Platteville 70-68 in the 2008 title game and also clipped No. 6 UW-Whitewater 66-55 in the 2012 championship.

#### Sixty Stuff:

Since Gary Grzesk took over the helm of the St. Norbert men's basketball program in 2006-07, the Green Knights own an 86-11 record when holding their opponents under 60 points.

Four instances came in his first season of 2006-07, followed by two

times in 2007-08 and 2010-11. The Green Knights also had a loss in 2011-12 and two in 2012-13.

The Green Knights have won 24 consecutive games when holding their opponents to less than 60 points. St. Norbert last lost when its opponents scored in the fifties in a 59-58 loss to Wheaton on March 2, 2013 in the first round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

### Streak Skinny:

St. Norbert became the first Midwest Conference men's basketball team to post consecutive unbeaten league seasons in 64 years after finishing 18-0 in MWC play in 2013-14 and 2014-15.

The Green Knights, who have won a record 50 consecutive games against MWC opponents, were the first team to go two years without a league loss since Beloit in 1950 and 1951. The Green Knights have also won 34 consecutive home games against MWC foes.

St. Norbert's current streak began with a 57-52 win over Ripon on Feb. 12, 2013 in De Pere.

St. Norbert is 61-1 in its last 62 games against MWC foes. Grinnell was the last MWC team to beat the Green Knights, posting a 104-99 overtime win on Feb. 9, 2013 in Grinnell, Iowa.

### **Building a Winner:**

Now in his tenth season, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title five times in the last six seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games five times in the last six years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 is a school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 85-18 record from 2012 to 2015 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 166-41. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.
