St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (9-2, 6-0) vs. Lawrence Univ. (5-5, 2-3) Wednesday, January 6, 2016 - 5:30 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert concludes a seven-game homestand with a Midwest Conference matchup with Lawrence. The Green Knights are looking to remain unbeaten in league play.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lawrence 55-46 in an all-time series dating back to the 1917-18 season, making it one of the Green Knights' two oldest rivalries (along with UW-Oshkosh). The Green Knights have won 12 straight games in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Lawrence 81-63 on Feb. 4, 2015 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Green Knights, who shot 60.4 percent from the floor, led 62-51 with 8:33 remaining before going on a 17-0 run to salt the game away. Austin Elliott led St. Norbert with 20 points, while D.J. DeValk added 12 points. Ryan DePouw led Lawrence with 20 points with Jamie Nikitas and Mitch Willer each adding 12 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 178-60 in his tenth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 229-91.

Lawrence coach Joel DePagter (Lawrence, 1998) is 112-86 in his ninth season in Appleton.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 9-2 overall and is 7-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, who have won 50 consecutive games against Midwest Conference opponents, are coming off an 82-65 loss to Alma in the championship game of the Nicolet National Bank Holiday Tournament last Wednesday in De Pere.

Sophomore guard D.J. DeValk, who is seventh in Division III in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-3.73 per game, has moved into the team scoring lead with an average of 14.5 points per game. Junior guard Ben Bobinski is netting 13.5 points per game, while junior guard Terrence Garner is averaging 11.3 points and a team-high 6.3 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 74.8 points per game and is shooting 47.8 percent from the floor, 36.3 percent on 3-pointers and 74.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 65.2 points per game while shooting 42.2 percent from the floor, 32.2 percent on 3-pointers and 71.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the game 5-5 overall and is 3-3 in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings are coming off a 109-89 conference loss to Grinnell at home this past Saturday.

Senior guard Jamie Nikitas leads the Midwest Conference in scoring at 27.2 points per game and is also collecting a team-high 7.0 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Jeremy Stephani is averaging 12.7 points per game, while junior forward Mitch Willer is netting 8.7 points and 5.0 rebounds per game.

Lawrence is averaging 69.9 points per game and is shooting 45.6 percent from the floor, 29.6 percent on 3-pointers and 64.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 71.5 points per game while shooting 41.6 percent from the floor, 35.1 percent on 3-pointers and 71.4 percent at the free-throw line.

Sixty Stuff:

Since Gary Grzesk took over the helm of the St. Norbert men's basketball program in 2006-07, the Green Knights own an 86-11 record when holding their opponents under 60 points.

Four instances came in his first season of 2006-07, followed by two times in 2007-08 and 2010-11. The Green Knights also had a loss in 2011-12 and two in 2012-13.

The Green Knights have won 24 consecutive games when holding their opponents to less than 60 points. St. Norbert last lost when its opponents scored in the fifties in a 59-58 loss to Wheaton on March 2, 2013 in the first round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

Streak Skinny:

St. Norbert became the first Midwest Conference men's basketball team to post consecutive unbeaten league seasons in 64 years after finishing 18-0 in MWC play in 2013-14 and 2014-15.

The Green Knights, who have won a record 50 consecutive games against MWC opponents, were the first team to go two years without a league loss since Beloit in 1950 and 1951. The Green Knights have also won 34 consecutive home games against MWC foes.

St. Norbert's current streak began with a 57-52 win over Ripon on Feb. 12, 2013 in De Pere.

St. Norbert is 61-1 in its last 62 games against MWC foes. Grinnell was the last MWC team to beat the Green Knights, posting a 104-99 overtime win on Feb. 9, 2013 in Grinnell, Iowa.

Building a Winner:

Now in his tenth season, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title five times in the last six seasons.

The Green Knights have won 20 games five times in the last six years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 is a school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert also won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 85-18 record from 2012 to 2015 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 167-42. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.
