St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview

MIDWEST CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

Fri., Feb. 26 - No. 8 St. Norbert (21-2) vs. Lake Forest (12-10) - 6 p.m.
Sat., Feb. 27 - Championship vs. Carroll (19-4) or Ripon (15-8) - 3 p.m.
Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert, making its Midwest Conference-best ninth consecutive conference tournament appearance, hosts Carroll, Ripon and Lake Forest this weekend. The Green Knights, who have won six out of the last seven MWC titles, are vying for their sixth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in seven years. The MWC Tournament champion receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lake Forest 41-20 in a series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights have captured 16 of the last 19 meetings in the series.

St. Norbert holds a 49-45 lead on Carroll in a series dating back to the 1933-34 season. The Green Knights have won the last 14 of the last 16 meetings.

Ripon holds a 61-56 series lead over St. Norbert in a spirited rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have narrowed the gap by winning 20 of the last 22 meetings over the last nine seasons.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 190-60 in his tenth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 241-91.

Lake Forest coach Ken Davis (Arizona State, 1983) is 22-22 in his second season in Lake Forest.

Carroll coach Paul Combs (Ripon, 1993) is 43-27 in his third season in Waukesha. Including stops at Lakeland, UW-Platteville and Wayne State (Neb.), Combs is 259-187 in 17 years of collegiate coaching.

Ripon coach Ryan Kane (St. Norbert, 1999) is 58-37 in his fourth season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 8 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the tournament 21-2 overall after finishing 18-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, who have won 62 consecutive games against Midwest Conference opponents, are coming off a 72-62 road win this past Saturday at Cornell.

Sophomore guard D.J. DeValk leads the Green Knights in scoring at 15.3 points per game. Junior guard Ben Bobinski, this week's MWC Player of the Week, is netting 12.4 points per game. Junior guard Terrence Garner is aver-

aging 10.9 points and a team-high 6.4 rebounds per game, while sophomore forward Mitchell Reinthaler is totaling 10.9 points and 5.9 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 74.7 points per game and is shooting 47.5 percent from the floor, 36.6 percent on 3-pointers and 72.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 61.3 points per game while shooting 41.3 percent from the floor, 32.8 percent on 3-pointers and 68.3 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the tournament 12-10 overall. The Foresters, who lost 61-48 at home to Carroll this past Saturday, finished 10-8 in the Midwest Conference.

Junior forward Jim Schick leads the Foresters with averages of 15.8 points and 11.0 rebounds per game. Freshman forward Danny Sotos is averaging 12.9 points and 5.0 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Eric Porter is netting 12.3 points per game.

Lake Forest is averaging 73.1 points per game and is shooting 46.0 percent from the floor, 35.9 percent on 3-pointers and 66.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 70.3 points per game while shooting 43.0 percent from the floor, 33.5 percent on 3-pointers and 65.6 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the tournament 19-4 overall. The Pioneers finished as the Midwest Conference runner-up with a 15-3 league showing.

Junior guard Kyle Keranen is averaging 15.2 points per game while shooting 47.3 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Senior forward Brian Nagy is averaging 12.8 points and 8.1 rebounds per game. Sophomore forward Marcus Johnson is averaging 11.3 points per game.

Carroll is averaging 74.7 points per game and is shooting 50.5 percent from the floor, 37.0 percent on 3-pointers and 72.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 68.8 points per game while shooting 43.2 percent from the floor, 30.8 percent on 3-pointers and 68.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the tournament at 15-8 overall. The Red Hawks finished Midwest Conference play 13-5 to grab the No. 3 seeding.

Junior guard Ty Sabin leads the Red Hawks in scoring at a lusty 26.5

points per game. Senior guard Ty Ketz is averaging 13.0 points per game, while freshman guard Cal Schultz is netting an average of 5.7 points per game.

Ripon is averaging 76.7 points per game and is shooting 47.5 percent from the floor, 41.0 percent on 3-pointers and 74.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 72.4 points per game while shooting 43.3 percent from the floor, 31.0 percent on 3-pointers and 67.3 percent at the free-throw line.

Streak Skinny:

St. Norbert became the first Midwest Conference men's basketball team to post three straight unbeaten league seasons in 64 years after again finishing 18-0 in MWC play in 2015-16.

The Green Knights, who have won a record 62 consecutive games against MWC opponents, were the first team to go three years without a league loss since Beloit in 1949, 1950 and 1951. The Green Knights have also won 39 consecutive home games against MWC foes.

St. Norbert's current streak began with a 57-52 win over Ripon on Feb. 12, 2013 in De Pere.

St. Norbert is 73-1 in its last 74 games against MWC foes. Grinnell was the last MWC team to beat the Green Knights, posting a 104-99 overtime win on Feb. 9, 2013 in Grinnell, Iowa.

Streak Skinny II:

St. Norbert's current 62-game winning streak against Midwest Conference opponents is believed to be the longest conference victory skein in history by a current NCAA Division III member.

Wheaton (Ill.) fashioned a 61-game winning streak in the College Conference of Illinois in the late 1950s. UW-Eau Claire had a 49-game winning streak in the then-Wisconsin State University Conference in the early 1970s.

Wheaton was a member of the NCAA College Division (currently Division II) at the time, while Eau Claire was an NAIA powerhouse during its lengthy streak.

Building a Winner:

Now in his tenth season, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title six times in the last seven seasons. The Green Knights are the first team to win four consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight

The Green Knights have won 20 games six times in the last seven years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 is a school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games three times (1984, 2002 and 2016). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 85-18 record from 2012 to 2015 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 179-42. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in

the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is second in Division III in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-1.51. Sophomore guard D.J. DeValk is 15th in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-3.08.

* - St. Norbert is seventh in Division III in scoring defense at 61.3 points allowed per game and tenth in fewest turnovers per game at 10.2 per game.

* - St. Norbert's Midwest Conference title this season is its seventh since 2002. In those 15 years, the Green Knights' seven outright MWC titles are the most in the league. Lawrence has five titles,

with four of those outright. Grinnell has three titles, while Lake Forest has one.

* - St. Norbert is 31-5 all-time at home under Gary Grzesk against this year's tournament field. The Green Knights are 13-1 against Ripon, 11-2 against Carroll and 7-2 against Lake Forest.

* - Since 1957-58, St. Norbert has gone 443-206 in home contests, good for a .683 winning percentage. In those 59 years, St. Norbert has only had a losing record at home games in six seasons, and has never suffered a home losing streak longer than four games. The Green Knights are 111-22 in its last 133 games played at Schuldes Sports Center.
