Game Overview:

St. Norbert makes its sixth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in seven years when it hosts a four-team Central Regional at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights face Upper Midwest Athletic Conference tourna-ment champion Northwestern-St. Paul in the first round.

The Series:

Northwestern leads St. Norbert 1-0 in a series started during the 2009-10 season. The Eagles topped the Green Knights 72-70 in a Nicolet Bank Tournament game on Dec. 29, 2009 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. St. Norbert leads North Central 2-0 in a series started during the 1982-83

season. The Green Knights defeated the Cardinals 52-49 on Dec. 11, 1982 in the Wheaton Tournament. St. Norbert then beat North Central 69-56 on March 2, 1984 in the first round of the NCAA Division III Tournament's Midwest Regional at UW-Whitewater.

St. Norbert and St. Olaf have never met in men's basketball.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 192-60 in his tenth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 243-91.

Northwestern coach Tim Grosz (Northwestern-St. Paul, 1992) is 309-155 in his 16th season in St. Paul.

North Central coach Todd Raridon (Hastings, 1980) is 207-113 in his 12th season in Naperville. He was 269-125 in 15 seasons at Nebraska Wesleyan to give him a career record of 476-238 in 27 seasons of collegiate coaching.

St. Olaf coach Dan Kosmoski (Minnesota, 1980) is 276-281 in his 22nd season in Northfield.

NCAA Tournament Appearances: St. Norbert is making its eighth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its sixth in seven seasons, and is 3-7 all-time in the tournament. Two of St. Norbert's previous appearances ended at the hands of the eventual national champion - UW-Whitewater in 1984 and UW-Stevens Point in 2010. The Green Knights lost in the first round of last year's tournament with a heartbreaking 110-98 triple-overtime setback to Elmhurst.

Northwestern is making its sixth consecutive and overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance. The Eagles are 2-5 all-time in the tournament after reaching the Sweet 16 last season. North Central is making its eighth NCAA Division III Tournament appear-

ance and is 8-8 all-time. The Cardinals advanced to the 2013 national semifi-

St. Olaf is making its third consecutive and overall NCAA Division III Tournament appearance. The Oles are 2-2 all-time.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 7 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the NCAA Tournament 23-2 overall. The Green Knights, who have won six of the last seven Midwest Conference titles, won the Midwest Conference Tournament this past Saturday with a 71-69 thriller over Carroll.

Sophomore guard D.J. DeValk, a first-team All-MWC selection, leads the Green Knights in scoring at 15.8 points per game. Junior guard Ben Bobinski is averaging 11.9 points per game. Sophomore forward Mitchell Reinthaler is registering 10.8 points and 5.6 rebounds per game. Junior guard Terrence Garner, a secondteam All-MWC choice, is averaging 10.6 points and a team-high 6.2 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 74.0 points per game and is shooting 47.4 percent from the floor, 36.1 percent on 3pointers and 73.4 percent at the freethrow line. Opponents are scoring an average of 61.0 points per game while shooting 41.4 percent from the floor, 31.9 percent on 3-pointers and 68.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Eagles:

Northwestern enters the tournament 22-5 overall. The Eagles finished 12-4 in the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference regular-season race before beating champion St. Scholastica 93-70 this past Saturday to win the UMAC Tournament.

The Eagles boast six players in double figures in scoring. Senior guard Michael Carney is averaging 13.4 points per game, while senior forward Kyle Ooms averaging 12.2 points and 7.9 rebounds per game. Junior guard Cody Sprenger and junior guard Porter Morrell are both averaging 11.0 points per game. Junior guard Will Gisler is averaging 10.4 points per game while sophomore forward Clay Elrod is netting 10.2 points per game.

Northwestern is averaging 81.4 points per game and is shooting 50.0

percent from the floor, 39.1 percent on 3-pointers and 68.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 67.9 points per game while shooting 42.2 percent from the floor, 33.1 percent on 3pointers and 68.4 percent at the freethrow line.

About the Cardinals:

North Central, ranked No. 17 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the NCAA Tournament 19-7 overall. The Cardinals were the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin runner-up at 12-2 and lost in the semifinals of the league tournament to Elmhurst this past Friday 60-58.

Sophomore forward Alex Sorenson is averaging 15.4 points and 7.8 rebounds per game. Freshman forward Connor Raridon is averaging 12.8 points and 6.8 rebounds per game, while senior guard Jayme Moten is netting 10.7 points per game. Senior forward Kevin Honn is averaging 10.3 points per game.

North Central is averaging 77.4 points per game and is shooting 46.9 percent from the floor, 36.7 percent on 3-pointers and 70.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 67.5 points per game while shooting 40.2 percent from the floor, 31.8 percent on 3-pointers and 66.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Oles:

St. Olaf enters the tournament 18-9 overall. The Oles finished in second place in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference with a 14-6 record and won the MIAC Tournament with a 72-66 win at St. Thomas this past Sunday.

at St. Thomas this past Sunday. Senior forward Ben Figini leads the Oles with 18.3 points and 5.3 rebounds per game. Senior guard Justin Pahl is averaging 15.4 points per game, while senior guard Riley Aeikens is averaging 14.7 points and 5.2 rebounds per game.

St. Olaf is averaging 72.0 points per game and is shooting 48.0 percent from the floor, 37.1 percent on 3-pointers and 74.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 67.7 points per game

St. Norbert Men's Basketball Winning Streaks

St. Norbert's current 14-game winning streak is tied for the fifthlongest mark in school history since the conclusion of World War II. Four of the six longest winning streaks in that time have come in Gary Grzesk's 10-year tenure at the helm of the Green Knights.

while shooting 46.0 percent from the floor, 34.1 percent on 3-pointers and 71.2 percent at the free-throw line.

Streak Skinny:

St. Norbert became the first Midwest Conference men's basketball team to post three straight unbeaten league seasons in 64 years after again finishing 18-0 in MWC play in 2015-16. The Green Knights, who have won a

The Green Knights, who have won a record 64 consecutive games against MWC opponents, were the first team to go three years without a league loss since Beloit in 1949, 1950 and 1951. The Green Knights have also won 41 consecutive home games against MWC foes.

St. Norbert's current streak began with a 57-52 win over Ripon on Feb. 12, 2013 in De Pere.

St. Norbert is 75-1 in its last 76 games against MWC foes. Grinnell was the last MWC team to beat the Green Knights, posting a 104-99 overtime win on Feb. 9, 2013 in Grinnell, Iowa.

Streak Skinny II:

St. Norbert's current 64-game winning streak against Midwest Conference opponents is believed to be the longest conference victory skein in history by a current NCAA Division III member.

Wheaton (III.) fashioned a 61-game winning streak in the College Conference of Illinois in the late 1950s. UW-Eau Claire had a 49-game winning streak in the then-Wisconsin State University Conference in the early 1970s. Wheaton was a member of the NCAA College Division (currently Division II) at the time, while Eau Claire was an NAIA powerhouse during its lengthy streak.

Building a Winner:

Now in his tenth season, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title six times in the last seven seasons. The Green Knights are the first team to win four consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight from 1946-51.

The Green Knights have won 20 games six times in the last seven years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 is a school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 2016 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 85-18 record from 2012 to 2015 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 181-42. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert does not have a senior

on this season's roster.

* - St. Norbert is fourth in Division III in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-1.49. Sophomore guard D.J. DeValk is 21st in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-2.89.

* - St. Norbert is fifth in Division III in scoring defense at 61.0 points allowed per game and tenth in fewest turnovers per game at 10.3 per game.

* - St. Norbert has made 390 free throws in 531 attempts, while its opponents have attempted just 384, making 264. The Green Knights are 19th in Division III in fewest fouls per game at 15.8.

* - St. Norbert is 13th nationally in scoring margin at plus-13.0 points per game and is 14th in Division III in rebound margin at plus-7.8 rebounds per game.

* - St. Norbert's Midwest Conference title this season is its seventh since 2002. In those 15 years, the Green Knights' seven outright MWC titles are the most in the league. Lawrence has five titles, with four of those outright. Grinnell has three titles, while Lake Forest has one.

* - Since 1957-58, St. Norbert has gone 445-206 in home contests, good for a .684 winning percentage. In those 59 years, St. Norbert has only had a losing record at home games in six seasons, and has never suffered a home losing streak longer than four games. The Green Knights are 113-22 in its last 135 games played at Schuldes Sports Center.
