St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview NCAA DIVISION III TOURNAMENT - CENTRAL SECTIONAL Fri., March 11 - No. 7 St. Norbert (25-2) vs. No. 13 Alma (23-6) - 5 p.m. Sat., March 12 - vs. No. 2 Benedictine (28-0) or No. 10 Ohio Wesleyan (24-4) - 7 p.m. Rice Center (2,500) - Lisle, Illinois

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert makes its first NCAA Division III Sweet 16 appearance since 1984 when it faces Alma at the Central Sectional at Benedictine. The host Eagles and Ohio Wesleyan round out the four-team field. The winner will advance to the NCAA Division III Final Four on March 18-19 in Salem, Va.

The Series:

St. Norbert and Alma are tied 1-1 in a series dating back to the 2013-14 season. Both meetings have come in the St. Norbert Nicolet National Bank Holiday Tournament. The Green Knights won the first meeting over the Scots 103-69 on Dec. 29, 2013 before Alma returned the favor earlier this season with an 82-65 win on Dec. 30, 2015.

St. Norbert leads Ohio Wesleyan 1-0 in a series dating back to the 2013-14 season. The Green Knights topped the Battling Bishops 87-79 in a first-round NCAA Division III Tournament game on March 7, 2014 in Bloomington, Ill.

St. Norbert leads Benedictine 4-3 in a series dating back to the 1982-83 season. The two teams haven't met since a 70-60 Benedictine win on Jan. 3, 2001 in Lisle, Ill.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 194-60 in his tenth season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 245-91.

Alma coach Sam Hargraves (Calvin, 1998) is 59-71 in his fifth season in Alma.

Ohio Wesleyan coach Mike DeWitt (Ohio Wesleyan, 1987) is 284-178 in his 17th season in Delaware. Including two seasons at Hiram and three at Centre, DeWitt is 334-253 in 22 seasons of collegiate coaching.

Benedictine coach Keith Bunkenburg (Benedictine, 1989) is 338-215 in his 21st season in Lisle.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its eighth NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its sixth in seven seasons and is 5-7 all-time in the tournament. Two of St. Norbert's previous appearances ended at the hands of the eventual national champion - UW-Whitewater in 1984 and UW-Stevens Point in 2010. The Green Knights last played in the Sweet 16 in 1984 when the tournament was a 32-team field.

Alma is making its first NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and is 2-0 all-time in the tournament.

Ohio Wesleyan is making its seventh NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and its fifth straight overall. The Battling Bishops, who won the 1988 national title, is 10-5 all-time in the tournament.

Benedictine is making its seventh NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and is 3-6 all-time in the tournament. The Eagles advanced to the Elite Eight in 1991.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 7 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the NCAA Tournament's sectional round 25-2 overall. The Green Knights advanced to the Sweet 16 for the first time since 1984 with a pair of home wins this past weekend. St. Norbert topped Northwestern-St. Paul 77-58 and St. Olaf 63-61 at move into the second weekend.

Sophomore guard D.J. DeValk, a first-team All-MWC selection, leads the Green Knights in scoring at 16.1 points per game. Junior guard Ben Bobinski is averaging 12.1 points

per game. Sophomore forward Mitchell Reinthaler is registering 10.5 points and 5.6 rebounds per game. Junior guard Terrence Garner, a second-team All-MWC choice, is averaging 10.3 points and a team-high 6.4 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 73.7 points per game and is shooting 47.3 percent from the floor, 35.8 percent on 3-pointers and 73.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.9 points per game while shooting 41.3 percent from the floor, 31.6 percent on 3-pointers and 68.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Scots:

Alma, ranked No. 13 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the sectional round of the NCAA Tournament with a 23-6 overall record. The Scots advanced by beating Denison 74-60 and John Carroll 90-83 this past weekend.

Senior guard Scott Nikodemski leads the Scots in scoring at 14.6 points per game while shooting 66.3 percent from the floor. Senior forward D.J. Beckman is averaging 12.5 points per game, while sophomore guard Jason Beckman is netting 11.3 points per game while shooting 53.7 percent from beyond the three-point arc.

Alma is averaging 81.4 points per game and is shooting 51.1 percent from the floor (currently second nationally in Division III), 39.9 percent on 3-pointers and 75.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 71.3 points per game while shooting 40.0 percent from the floor, 32.7 percent on 3-pointers and 72.3 percent at the free-throw line.

St. Norbert Men's Basketball Winning Streaks

St. Norbert's current 16-game winning streak is tied for the second-longest mark in school history since the conclusion of World War II. Four of the six longest winning streaks in that time have come in Gary Grzesk's 10-year tenure at the helm of the Green Knights.

About the Battling Bishops:

Ohio Wesleyan, ranked No. 10 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the sectional round of the NCAA Tournament 24-4. The Battling Bishops defeated Pitt-Greensburg 114-68 and Lynchburg 97-94 this past weekend.

Sophomore guard Nate Axelrod leads Ohio Wesleyan in scoring at 16.7 points per game. Sophomore guard Seth Clark is averaging 15.3 points per game. Junior forward Ben Simpson is averaging 14.2 points and 9.9 rebounds per game, while senior guard Claude Gray is averaging 14.2 points per game. Senior forward Matt Jeske is averaging 10.3 points per game.

Ohio Wesleyan is averaging 87.8 points per game and is shooting 46.2 percent from the floor, 35.3 percent on 3-pointers and 74.7 percent at the freethrow line. Opponents are scoring an average of 74.1 points per game while shooting 43.5 percent from the floor, 33.7 percent on 3-pointers and 67.1 percent at the free-throw line.

play in the NCAA Tournament with an unblemished 28-0 record. The Eagles, who had a first-round bye, topped Hardin-Simmons 85-64 in a secondround game on Saturday in Lisle, Ill.

Junior guard Michael Blaszczyk leads the Eagles in scoring at 14.4 points per game. Senior forward Luke Johnson is averaging 14.2 points and 11.1 rebounds pr game. Junior guard Tahron Harvey is netting 13.6 points per game, while senior guard John Dodson is averaging 11.0 points per game. Junior forward Adam Reynolds is averaging 10.7 points per game.

Benedictine is averaging 87.6 points per game and is shooting 50.9 percent from the floor (third nationally in Division III), 35.3 percent on 3-pointers and 69.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 68.0 points per game while shooting 37.1 percent from the floor, 30.3 percent on 3-pointers and 70.2 percent at the free-throw line.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert has had a solid defensive season in 2015-16, allowing just 60.9 points per game. That is the best mark for the Green Knights since the 2012-13 team allowed just 60.5 points per game.

St. Norbert has held 25 of its 27 opponents to below their season average this season. The two other occasions were losses for the Green Knights. Alma scored 82 points and is averaging 81.4 points per game, while UW-Stevens Point scored 66 points and averaged 62.2 points per game this sea-

The Green Knights have held seven opponents to at least 20 points below their season scoring average.

St. Norbert is 105-11 under Gary Grzesk when allowing 60 points or less and is 74-1 when allowing 55 points or less.

Scoring Summary:

St. Norbert sophomore guard D.J. DeValk has scored 434 points this season in 27 games, good for a 16.1 points per game average.

DeValk's point total matches the most points scored in a season for a St. Norbert player in the last 14 seasons. Andrew Schwoerer also scored 434 points in 2014-15.

It also marks just the fourth time since the 2003-04 season a St. Norbert player has reached the 400-point plateau in a season. Kam Cerroni scored 428 points and Brandon Gries 425 points during the 2013-14 season.

Kari Hannula's 469 points are the most in a season since the 1999-2000 season. Nathan Hoffmann scored 464 points in 2001-02.

Streak Skinny:

St. Norbert became the first Midwest Conference men's basketball team to post three straight unbeaten league seasons in 64 years after again finishing 18-0 in MWC play in 2015-16.

The Green Knights, who have won a record 64 consecutive games against MWC opponents, were the first team to go three years without a league loss since Beloit in 1949, 1950 and 1951. The Green Knights have also won 41 consecutive home games against MWC foes.

St. Norbert's current streak began with a 57-52 win over Ripon on Feb. 12, 2013 in De Pere.

St. Norbert is 75-1 in its last 76 games against MWC foes. Grinnell was the last MWC team to beat the Green Knights, posting a 104-99 overtime win on Feb. 9, 2013 in Grinnell, Iowa.

Streak Skinny II:

St. Norbert's current 64-game winning streak against Midwest Conference opponents is believed to be the longest conference victory skein in history by a current NCAA Division III member.

Wheaton (Ill.) fashioned a 61-game winning streak in the College Conference of Illinois in the late 1950s. UW-Eau Claire had a 49-game winning streak in the then-Wisconsin State University Conference in the early 1970s.

Wheaton was a member of the NCAA College Division (currently Division II) at the time, while Eau Claire was an NAIA powerhouse during its lengthy streak.

Building a Winner:

Now in his tenth season, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title six times in the last seven seasons. The Green Knights are the first team to win four consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight from 1946-51.

The Green Knights have won 20 games six times in the last seven years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 and 2016 is the school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 85-18 record from 2012 to 2015 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 183-42. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.

Jump Shots:

- * St. Norbert does not have a senior on this season's roster.
- * St. Norbert is fourth in Division III in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-1.50. Sophomore guard D.J. DeValk is 12th in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-3.04.
- * St. Norbert is fourth in Division III in scoring defense at 61.0 points allowed per game and ninth in fewest turnovers per game at 10.0 per game.
- * St. Norbert has made 416 free throws in 567 attempts, while its opponents have attempted just 410, making 282. The Green Knights are 14th in Division III in fewest fouls per game at 15.6.
- * St. Norbert is 158-7 under Gary Grzesk when shooting a higher fieldgoal percentage than its opponent.
- * St. Norbert is 161-12 when leading at halftime under Gary Grzesk.
- * St. Norbert is 12th nationally in scoring margin at plus-12.8 points per game and is 17th in Division III in rebound margin at plus-7.4 rebounds per game.
- * St. Norbert's Midwest Conference title this season is its seventh since 2002. In those 15 years, the Green Knights' seven outright MWC titles are the most in the league. Lawrence has five titles, with four of those outright. Grinnell has three titles, while Lake Forest has one.

Winningest Teams in NCAA Division III Since 2012-13

St. Norbert has fashioned a 94-12 record since the start of the 2012-13 season, including a 91-9 mark over the last 100 games. The Green Knights' .887 winning percentage the last four seasons is the best mark in NCAA Division III during that stretch entering sectional play in this weekend's NCAA Division III Tournament. Below is the top ten Division III programs by winning percentage over the last four seasons.
