St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 7 St. Norbert College (11-2) at Ripon College (11-2) Wednesday, January 18, 2017 - 7:30 p.m. Storzer Center (1,250) - Ripon, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert and Ripon square off in an important Midwest Conference game. The Green Knights, winners of 72 consecutive games against MWC foes, lead the Red Hawks by one game in the league standings.

The Series:

Ripon holds a 61-56 series lead over St. Norbert in a spirited rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have narrowed the gap by winning 20 of the last 22 meetings over the last nine seasons.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Ripon 83-63 on Jan. 26, 2016 at Storzer Center in Ripon. The Green Knights trailed by 10 late in the first half before rallying for a 31-31 halftime tie. St. Norbert shot 56 percent from the floor in the second half. D.J. DeValk had 21 points and Tim Marshall added 14 points to lead the Green Knights, who had all five starters reach double figures. Ty Sabin topped Ripon with 27 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 205-63 in his 11th season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 256-94.

Ripon coach Ryan Kane (St. Norbert, 1999) is 69-40 in his fifth season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 7 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the game 11-2 overall and 8-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights swept their double weekend this past Friday and Saturday with an 83-60 win over Illinois College and a 65-40 win over Monmouth. St. Norbert has won its last 72 consecutive games against Midwest Conference opponents.

Junior guard D.J. DeValk leads the Green Knights in scoring at 16.4 points per game. Senior guard Ben Bobinski is averaging 12.5 points per game. Freshman forward Connor Curtis is scoring 8.2 points per game, while sophomore guard Taylor Penn is scoring 7.3 points per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 71.9 points per game and is shooting 45.5 percent from the floor, 34.5 percent on 3-pointers and 75.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 54.1 points per game while shooting 36.7 percent from the floor, 30.5 percent on 3-pointers and 66.1 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game 11-2 overall and 7-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks split their conference double weekend, falling to Monmouth 79-70 on Friday before topping Cornell 78-66 on Saturday.

All-America senior guard Ty Sabin powers the Red Hawks averaging 29.8 points and 5.8 rebounds per game. Senior guard Brendan McCoy is netting 12.6 points per game and is shooting a lusty 58.8 percent (30-for-51) from beyond the three-point arc. Junior guard Isaac Masters and sophomore guard Cal Schultz are each scoring 8.2 points per game.

Ripon is averaging 84.4 points per game and is shooting 52.0 percent from the floor, 43.7 percent on 3pointers and 78.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 74.0 points per game while shooting 41.3 percent from the floor, 34.5 percent on 3-pointers and 71.2 percent at the free-throw line.

Term Limits:

The rest of the Midwest Conference might be happy President Obama is leaving office Friday, and not for political reasons.

During Obama's second term in office, St. Norbert is 79-1 against Midwest Conference opponents and 48-0 at home. The lone loss was a 104-99 overtime setback at Grinnell on Feb. 9, 2013 - just 20 days after Obama was reinaugurated.

The Green Knights are 136-22 overall and 83-6 at home against the MWC during Obama's entire eightyear tenure in office.

D is for Defense:

As of Jan. 17, St. Norbert owns the No. 1 scoring defense in Division III, allowing a scant 54.1 points per game this season.

In Gary Grzesk's 268-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 44 times, going 44-0 in those games.

St. Norbert is 167-7 under Grzesk when shooting a higher field-goal percentage than its opponent.

Streak Skinny:

St. Norbert's current 72-game winning streak against Midwest Conference opponents is believed to be the longest conference victory skein in history by a current NCAA Division III member.

Wheaton (III.) fashioned a 61game winning streak in the College Conference of Illinois in the late 1950s. UW-Eau Claire had a 49game winning streak in the then-Wisconsin State University Conference in the early 1970s.

Wheaton was a member of the NCAA College Division (currently Division II) at the time, while Eau Claire was an NAIA powerhouse during its lengthy streak.

Building a Winner:

Now in his 11th season, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title six times in the last seven seasons. The Green Knights are the first team to win four consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight from 1946-51.

The Green Knights have won 20 games six times in the last seven years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 and 2016 is the school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 94-13 record from 2013 to 2016 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 194-46. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.
