St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 7 St. Norbert College (11-3) vs. Knox College (1-13) Saturday, January 21, 2017 - 7 p.m. Kress Events Center (3,993) - Green Bay, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert looks to get back on track when it hosts Knox on Saturday. The Green Knights are currently tied with Ripon atop the Midwest Conference standings halfway through the league schedule.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Knox 34-10 in a series dating back to the 1985-86 season. The Green Knights have won 15 straight games in the series since the Prairie Fire swept the season series in the 2007-08 season.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Knox 76-37 on Dec. 2, 2016 at Memorial Gym in Galesburg, Ill. The Green Knights led 36-21 at halftime and held the Prairie Fire to five field goals in the second half. D.J. DeValk led St. Norbert with 14 points, while Ben Bobinski added 12 points. Robert Suntken led Knox with seven points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 205-64 in his 11th season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 256-95.

Knox coach Kevin Walden (Knox, 2001) is 11-95 in his fifth season in Galesburg.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 11-3 overall and 8-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights had their NCAA Division III-record winning streak against conference opponents snapped at 72 consecutive games in an 81-55 loss at Ripon this past Wednesday.

Junior guard D.J. DeValk tops the Green Knights in scoring at 16.1 points - MORE -

per game. Senior guard Ben Bobinski is scoring an average of 12.6 points per game. Junior forward Mitchell Reinthaler is averaging 8.8 points per game, while freshman forward Connor Curtis is averaging 7.8 points per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 70.7 points per game and is shooting 44.8 percent from the floor, 33.0 percent on 3-pointers and 75.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 56.0 points per game while shooting 38.2 percent from the floor, 31.2 percent on 3-pointers and 65.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Prairie Fire:

Knox enters the game 1-13 overall and is 1-8 in the Midwest Conference. The Prairie Fire is coming off an 87-73 home loss to Illinois College this past Wednesday.

Freshman guard Deryk Ruple leads the Prairie Fire in scoring at 13.0 points per game. Junior forward Marko Protic is averaging 9.3 points and 6.5 rebounds per game. Senior guard Deandre Weathersby and senior guard Marcellis Davis are both averaging 8.8 points per game.

Knox is averaging 66.4 points per game and is shooting 42.3 percent from the floor, 29.0 percent on 3-pointers and 63.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 85.3 points per game while shooting 46.9 percent from the floor, 36.2 percent on 3-pointers and 73.6 percent at the free-throw line.

D is for Defense:

As of Jan. 18, St. Norbert owns the No. 1 scoring defense in Division III, allowing 56.0 points per game this season. The Green Knights are one of just three Division III teams holding opponents under 60 points per game.

In Gary Grzesk's 269-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 44 times, going 44-0 in those games.

The Green Knights are also No. 10 nationally in field-goal percent-

age defense at 38.2 percent. St. Norbert is 167-7 under Grzesk when shooting a higher field-goal percentage than its opponent.

Streak Skinny:

St. Norbert saw its 72-game winning streak against Midwest Conference opponents end in a loss to Ripon on Jan. 18. It is believed to be the longest conference victory skein in history by a current NCAA Division III member.

Wheaton (Ill.) fashioned a 61-game winning streak in the College Conference of Illinois in the late 1950s. UW-Eau Claire had a 49-game winning streak in the then-Wisconsin State University Conference in the early 1970s.

Wheaton was a member of the NCAA College Division (currently Division II) at the time, while Eau Claire was an NAIA powerhouse during its lengthy streak.

Building a Winner:

Now in his 11th season, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title six times in the last seven seasons. The Green Knights are the first team to win four consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight from 1946-51.

The Green Knights have won 20 games six times in the last seven years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 and 2016 is the school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 94-13 record from 2013 to 2016 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 194-47. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.
