St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 13 St. Norbert College (12-3) at Lawrence Univ. (7-7) Wednesday, January 25, 2017 - 7:30 p.m. Alexander Gym (1,250) - Appleton, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert looks keep its hold on first place in the Midwest Conference when it travels to Lawrence. The Green Knights hold a one-game lead on Ripon in the league standings with eight games remaining.

Broadcast:

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lawrence 58-46 in an all-time series dating back to the 1917-18 season, making it one of the Green Knights' two oldest rivalries (along with UW-Oshkosh). The Green Knights have won 15 straight games in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Lawrence 76-45 on Dec. 7, 2016 at Kress Center in Green Bay. The Green Knights led 29-12 at halftime and led by as many as 33 points in the second half. D.J. DeValk led St. Norbert with 12 points, while Taylor Penn added 11 points. Jeremy Stephani led the Vikings with 13 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 206-64 in his 11th season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 257-95.

Lawrence coach Joel DePagter (Lawrence, 1998) is 124-101 in his tenth season in Appleton.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 12-3 overall and 9-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, ranked No. 13 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, defeated Knox 65-48 this past Saturday in Green Bay.

Junior guard D.J. DeValk leads the Green Knights in scoring at 15.5 points per game. Senior guard Ben Bobinski is scoring an average of 12.2 points per game. Junior forward Mitchell Reinthaler is averaging 10.2 - MORE -

points per game, while freshman forward Connor Curtis is averaging 7.5 points per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 70.3 points per game and is shooting 45.3 percent from the floor, 32.9 percent on 3-pointers and 73.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 55.5 points per game while shooting 38.3 percent from the floor, 31.5 percent on 3-pointers and 65.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the game 7-7 overall and 7-3 in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings, who have won five of their last six games, won at Beloit 62-58 on Saturday.

Junior guard Jeremy Stephani leads the Vikings in scoring at 13.5 points per game. Senior forward Mitch Willer is averaging 12.1 points and a team-high 7.3 rebounds per game. Junior forward Ben Peterson is averaging 9.9 points and 6.1 rebounds per game.

Lawrence is averaging 69.3 points per game and is shooting 45.8 percent from the floor, 34.9 percent on 3-pointers and 63.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 72.6 points per game while shooting 39.8 percent from the floor, 32.5 percent on 3-pointers and 69.9 percent at the free-throw line.

D is for Defense:

As of Jan. 23, St. Norbert owns the No. 1 scoring defense in Division III, allowing 55.5 points per game this season.

The Green Knights are one of just two Division III teams holding opponents under 60 points per game this season. Christopher Newport is the other at 57.6 points per game.

In Gary Grzesk's 270-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 45 times, going 45-0 in those games.

The Green Knights are also No. 9 nationally in field-goal percentage defense at 38.3 percent. St. Norbert is 168-7 under Grzesk when shooting a higher field-goal percentage than its opponent.

Streak Skinny:

St. Norbert saw its 72-game winning streak against Midwest Conference opponents end in a loss to Ripon on Jan. 18. It is believed to be the longest conference victory skein in history by a current NCAA Division III member.

Wheaton (Ill.) fashioned a 61game winning streak in the College Conference of Illinois in the late 1950s. UW-Eau Claire had a 49game winning streak in the then-Wisconsin State University Conference in the early 1970s.

Wheaton was a member of the NCAA College Division (currently Division II) at the time, while Eau Claire was an NAIA powerhouse during its lengthy streak.

Building a Winner:

Now in his 11th season, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title six times in the last seven seasons. The Green Knights are the first team to win four consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight from 1946-51.

The Green Knights have won 20 games six times in the last seven years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 and 2016 is the school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 94-13 record from 2013 to 2016 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 195-47. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.
