St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview No. 10 St. Norbert College (14-3) vs. Ripon College (14-3) Tuesday, January 31, 2017 - 7:30 p.m. Kress Events Center (3,993) - Green Bay, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert hosts Ripon in a game that may determine the 2016-17 Midwest Conference men's basketball champion. The Green Knights lead the Red Hawks by one game in the league standings with six games remaining.

The Series:

Ripon holds a 62-56 series lead over St. Norbert in a spirited rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have narrowed the gap by winning 20 of the last 23 meetings over the last 10 seasons.

Last Meeting:

Ripon defeated St. Norbert 81-55 on Jan. 18, 2017 at Storzer Center in Ripon. The Red Hawks got off to a quick start, led 34-18 at halftime and pulled away in the second half. Ben Bobinski led St. Norbert with 14 points while D.J. DeValk added 13 points. Ty Sabin paced Ripon with 33 points while Brendan McCoy finished with 13 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 208-64 in his 11th season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 259-95.

Ripon coach Ryan Kane (St. Norbert, 1999) is 72-41 in his fifth season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 10 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the game 14-3 overall and 11-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights held off Cornell 67-57 this past Saturday in Green Bay to maintain their onegame lead in the league standings.

Junior guard D.J. DeValk leads the Green Knights in scoring at 15.8 points per game. Senior guard Ben Bobinski is producing an average of 12.9

points per game. Junior forward Mitchell Reinthaler is averaging 10.3 points per game, while senior center Tim Marshall is averaging 6.9 points per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 70.5 points per game and is shooting 45.1 percent from the floor, 32.7 percent on 3-pointers and 72.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 55.6 points per game while shooting 38.7 percent from the floor, 32.1 percent on 3-pointers and 66.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game with a 14-3 overall record and is one game behind St. Norbert in the Midwest Conference with a 10-2 record. The Red Hawks kept pace with an 86-73 home win over Illinois College this past Saturday.

Senior guard and national player of the year candidate Ty Sabin leads Division III in scoring at 29.8 points per game. Senior guard Brendan McCoy is averaging 12.3 points per game while shooting 59.4 percent from beyond the three-point arc. Junior guard Isaac Masters is averaging 8.8 points per game.

Ripon is averaging 84.4 points per game and is shooting 52.2 percent from the floor, 44.1 percent on 3pointers and 75.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 73.6 points per game while shooting 41.1 percent from the floor, 34.2 percent on 3-pointers and 72.0 percent at the free-throw line.

D is for Defense:

As of Jan. 29, St. Norbert owns the No. 1 scoring defense in Division III, allowing 55.6 points per game this season.

The Green Knights are one of just two Division III teams holding opponents under 60 points per game this season. Christopher Newport is second at 56.8 points per game.

In Gary Grzesk's 272-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 45 times, going 45-0 in those games. The Green Knights are also No. 12 nationally in field-goal percentage defense at 38.7 percent. St. Norbert is 169-7 under Grzesk when shooting a higher field-goal percentage than its opponent.

Streak Skinny:

St. Norbert saw its 72-game winning streak against Midwest Conference opponents end in a loss to Ripon on Jan. 18. It is believed to be the longest conference victory skein in history by a current NCAA Division III member.

The Green Knights still have a lengthy active home-court winning streak against MWC foes, having won their last 47 games since a 105-94 loss to Grinnell on Dec. 8, 2012.

Dating back to the 2009-10 season, St. Norbert is 76-4 at home against MWC opponents and have never lost more than one conference home game in any of those eight seasons to date.

Building a Winner:

Now in his 11th season, head coach Gary Grzesk turned the St. Norbert men's basketball program into an annual contender for the Midwest Conference championship, winning the MWC title six times in the last seven seasons. The Green Knights are the first team to win four consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight from 1946-51.

The Green Knights have won 20 games six times in the last seven years under Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 and 2016 is the school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 94-13 record from 2013 to 2016 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 197-46. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.
