St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (11-2) at Illinois College (6-7) Fri., Jan. 12 - Bruner Center (1,600) - Jacksonville, III. - 5:30 p.m. St. Norbert College at Monmouth College (8-5) Sat., Jan. 13 - Glennie Gym (1,600) - Monmouth, III - 1 p.m.

Weekend Overview:

St. Norbert goes on its first extended road trip of the 2017-18 season when it heads to the Land of Lincoln for games at Illinois College and Monmouth.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Illinois College 36-7 in an all-time series dating back to the 1985-86 season. The Green Knights have won the last 20 games against the Blueboys and are 14-6 all-time at Illinois College in the series.

St. Norbert leads Monmouth 30-11 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights are 12-9 all-time at Monmouth in the series.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert defeated Illinois College 75-56 on Dec. 2, 2017 at Jim Kress Gymnasium in De Pere. The Green Knights led 30-20 at halftime before pulling away in the second half. D.J. DeValk led St. Norbert with 15 points, while Mitchell Reinthaler and Joe Ciriacks added 14 points apiece. Sean McDonald led the Blueboys with nine points.

St. Norbert topped Monmouth 91-62 on Feb. 4, 2017 at Glennie Gym in Monmouth, Ill. The Green Knights racehorsed out to a 31-3 lead in the first 9:38 of the game en route to a 46-20 halftime edge. Ben Bobinski had 22 points for St. Norbert, while Mitchell Reinthaler added 16 points. Will Jones led Monmouth with 16 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 224-68 in his 12th season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 275-99.

Illinois College coach Mike Worrell (Urbana, 1986) is 208-291 in his 22nd season in Jacksonville.

Monmouth coach Todd Skrivseth (Coe, 1996) is 63-89 in his seventh season in Monmouth.

Midwest Conference at 6-0. The Green Knights defeated Grinnell 97-85 this past Saturday in De Pere.

Senior guard D.J. DeValk leads the Green Knights in scoring at 16.6 points per game. Senior forward Mitchell Reinthaler, the two-time reigning MWC Player of the Week, is averaging 16.1 points and a teamhigh 8.2 rebounds per game. Sophomore forward Connor Curtis is averaging 13.0 points per game, while junior forward Joe Lemon is collecting 7.9 points and 6.5 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 70.2 points per game while shooting 43.8 percent from the floor, 35.8 percent on 3-pointers and 75.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.9 points per game while shooting 42.2 percent from the floor, 36.6 percent on 3-pointers and 73.3 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Blueboys:

Illinois College enters the game 6-7 overall and 1-5 in the Midwest Conference. The Blueboys are coming off a 91-82 non-conference loss at Blackburn on Monday.

Freshman guard Brady Hays leads the Blueboys in scoring at 14.0 points per game. Junior guard Mason Speer averages 13.4 points per game, while senior forward Max Stutsman nets 13.4 points and 5.5 rebounds per game. Junior forward Sean McDonald averages 11.7 points and 5.2 rebounds per game.

Illinois College is averaging 77.4 points per game while shooting 44.4 percent from the floor, 36.2 percent on 3-pointers and 76.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 80.9 points per game while shooting 48.9 percent from the floor, 37.2 percent on 3-pointers and 71.2 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth enters Friday's game with Ripon at 8-5 overall and 5-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Scots beat Lawrence 65-62 this past Saturday in Appleton.

Senior guard Will Jones is averaging 14.9 points and 7.3 rebounds per game. Senior forward Justin Aluya is registering 14.8 points and 8.2 rebounds per game. Junior guard Lamont Mitchell is averaging 13.9 points and 5.8 rebounds per game.

Monmouth is averaging 74.4 points per game while shooting 45.8 percent from the floor, 36.8 percent on 3-pointers and 65.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 68.6 points per game while shooting 42.6 percent from the floor, 37.9 percent on 3-pointers and 72.1 percent at the free-throw line.

Thousand Talk:

St. Norbert senior guard D.J. DeValk scored 12 points in Saturday's 97-85 win over Grinnell in De Pere.

DeValk currently has 1,229 points to be 10 points shy of 13th on the St. Norbert career scoring list. Romie Kosnar is 15th with 1,237 points from 1947 to 1951. Nathan Hoffmann is 14th with 1,238 points from 1999 to 2002, while Richard Rankin is 13th with 1,239 points from 1961-65.

DeValk, who reached 1,000 career points late in his junior season, joined Andrew Schwoerer (1,439, 2012-15), Joe Emmerich (1,811, 1980-84) and Lee Schroeder (1,308, 1986-90) as the only St. Norbert players to reach that mark during their junior year since 1975.

Building a Winner:

St. Norbert has won the Midwest Conference title the last five years and seven times in the last eight seasons. The Green Knights are the first team to win at least four consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight from 1946-51.

The Green Knights have won 20 games six times in the last eight years under Gary Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 and 2016 is the school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 94-13 record from 2013 to 2016 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 213-49. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.
