St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (15-4) at Ripon College (12-5) Tuesday, January 30, 2018 - 5:30 p.m. Willmore Center (1,200) - Ripon, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert travels to Ripon for a key Midwest Conference game. The Green Knights lead Ripon, Lake Forest and Monmouth by one game in the league standings with six games remaining.

The Series:

Ripon holds a 63-57 series lead over St. Norbert in a spirited rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have narrowed the gap by winning 21 of the last 25 meetings over the last 10 seasons.

Last Meeting:

Ripon defeated St. Norbert 69-61 on Jan. 17, 2018 at Mulva Family Fitness & Sports Center in De Pere. The Red Hawks led 36-33 at halftime and pulled away in the second half. D.J. DeValk led the Green Knights with 21 points, while Connor Curtis added 16 points and nine rebounds. Isaac Masters had 24 points for the Red Hawks, while Tyler Semenas added 22 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 228-70 in his 12th season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 279-101.

Ripon coach Ryan Kane (St. Norbert, 1999) is 90-49 in his sixth season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 15-4 overall and 10-2 in the Midwest Conference after Saturday's 66-49 road win Saturday at Cornell. The Green Knights lead Ripon, Monmouth and Lake Forest by one game in the league standings.

Senior guard D.J. DeValk leads the Green Knights in scoring at 16.4 - MORE -

points per game, while senior forward Mitchell Reinthaler is averaging 14.4 points and 7.6 rebounds per game. Sophomore forward Connor Curtis is netting 13.4 points per game while shooting 65.8 percent from the floor. Junior guard Taylor Penn is averaging 7.4 points per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 72.0 points per game while shooting 46.1 percent from the floor, 37.2 percent on 3-pointers and 77.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 61.1 points per game while shooting 41.5 percent from the floor, 36.5 percent on 3-pointers and 71.9 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game 12-5 overall and 9-3 in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks have won seven consecutive games, including an 88-64 win at Illinois College this past Saturday.

Senior guard Isaac Masters leads the Red Hawks in scoring at 16.8 points per game. Senior guard Tyler Semenas is averaging 14.1 points per game, while junior guard Cal Schultz is netting 12.4 points per game. Sophomore guard Trent Jones is averaging 11.8 points per game.

Ripon is averaging 76.8 points per game while shooting 49.2 percent from the floor, 40.0 percent on 3pointers and 69.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 69.4 points per game while shooting 42.1 percent from the floor, 33.3 percent on 3-pointers and 68.6 percent at the free-throw line.

Thousand Talk:

St. Norbert senior guard D.J. DeValk scored 22 points in this past Saturday's game against Cornell to move into the Top 10 in St. Norbert career scoring.

DeValk currently has 1,326 points to reside in 10th place all-time in St. Norbert career scoring. LeRoy Weyenberg is ninth all-time with 1,379 points from 1961-65.

DeValk, who reached 1,000 career

points late in his junior season, joined Andrew Schwoerer (1,439, 2012-15), Joe Emmerich (1,811, 1980-84) and Schroeder as the only St. Norbert players to reach that mark during their junior year since 1975.

Stopper Stuff:

St. Norbert enters the game fifth in Division III in scoring defense at 61.1 points per game. Penn State-Behrend is the national leader at 58.2 points per game.

In their last three games, the Green Knights are allowing just 47.3 points per game. St. Norbert defeated Knox 76-41, Lawrence 85-52 and Cornell 66-49. The two games below 50 points are the Green Knights' best two defensive performances of the season.

In Gary Grzesk's 298-game tenure at St. Norbert, the Green Knights have held their opponent to 50 points or less 47 times, going 47-0 in those games.

Building a Winner:

St. Norbert has won the Midwest Conference title the last five years and seven times in the last eight seasons. The Green Knights are the first team to win at least four consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight from 1946-51.

The Green Knights have won 20 games six times in the last eight years under Gary Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 and 2016 is the school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 94-13 record from 2013 to 2016 marks the best fouryear total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 217-51. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.
