St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (1-0) vs. Benedictine Univ. (0-1) Saturday, November 18, 2017 - 4 p.m. Mulva Family Fitness & Sports Center (1,844) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert continues its six-game homestand to open the season when it hosts Benedictine. The Green Knights will also honor former coach Mike Heideman prior to the game.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Benedictine 5-3 in a series dating back to the 1982-83 season. The Green Knights won the last game in De Pere 91-74 on Jan. 5, 1988 at Schuldes Sports Center.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert tipped Benedictine 71-70 on Nov. 19, 2016 at Rice Center in Lisle, Ill. The Green Knights got a conventional three-point by D.J. DeValk with 9.4 seconds remaining to decide the outcome. DeValk led the Green Knights with 24 points. Ben Bobinski added 14 points. Benedictine was led by Brayden Olson's 16 points and Adam Reynolds' 14 points and 14 rebounds.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 214-66 in his 12th season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 265-97.

Benedictine coach Keith Bunkenburg (Benedictine, 1989) is 364-222 in his 23rd season in Lisle.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 1-0 overall after defeating UW-Eau Claire 77-69 this past Wednesday in the first game in the refurbished Mulva Family Fitness & Sports Center. It marked the tenth consecutive season the Green Knights have defeated a Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference - MORE -

Senior guard D.J. DeValk poured in 25 points, one short of his career high, to lead the Green Knights, Senior forward Mitchell Reinthaler added 22 points and a career-high 13 rebounds. Sophomore forward Joe Lemon registered 12 points and seven rebounds against the Blugolds.

St. Norbert is averaging 77.0 points per game while shooting 45.3 percent from the floor, 41.2 percent on 3-pointers and 81.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 69.0 points per game while shooting 51.9 percent from the floor, 23.8 percent on 3-pointers and 58.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Eagles:

Benedictine enters the game 0-1 overall after dropping a 74-68 decision at UW-Oshkosh this past Wednesday. The Eagles had a 33-30 halftime edge but couldn't hold on to an 11-point second-half lead.

Sophomore forward Kenny Bogus lead the Eagles with 24 points and six rebounds. Senior guard Brayden Olson added 18 points and seven rebounds, while sophomore forward Eric Grygo chipped in 10 points and seven rebounds.

Benedictine is averaging 68.0 points per game while shooting 42.6 percent from the floor, 13.0 percent on 3-pointers and 50.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 74.0 points per game while shooting 34.9 percent from the floor, 30.3 percent on 3-pointers and 76.9 percent at the free-throw line.

Thousand Talk:

St. Norbert senior guard D.J. DeValk scored 25 points against UW-Eau Claire this past Wednesday to vault into 22nd place on the school career scoring list.

DeValk currently has 1,055 points. Paul Schramka is 21st with 1,065 points from 1972-76 and Mike Wisneski is 20th with 1,072 points from 1959-63.

DeValk, who reached 1,000 career

points late in his junior season, joined Andrew Schwoerer (1,439, 2012-15), Joe Emmerich (1,811, 1980-84) and Lee Schroeder (1,308, 1986-90) as the only St. Norbert players to reach that mark during their junior year since 1975.

Double Trouble:

St. Norbert senior forward Mitchell Reinthaler recorded his second career double-double with 22 points and 13 rebounds in Wednesday's 77-69 win over UW-Eau Claire.

Reinthaler's previous double-double came in the first game of his sophomore season with 19 points and 10 rebounds in a 68-62 win over UW-Oshkosh.

The only other St. Norbert player to register a double-double since Reinthaler's first one is Terrence Garner, who totaled five during his last two seasons with the Green Knights.

Building a Winner:

St. Norbert has won the Midwest Conference title the last five years and seven times in the last eight seasons. The Green Knights are the first team to win at least four consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight from 1946-51.

The Green Knights have won 20 games six times in the last eight years under Gary Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 and 2016 is the school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 94-13 record from 2013 to 2016 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 203-48. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.
