### St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview MIDWEST CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

**Fri., Feb. 23 - St. Norbert (19-6) vs. Ripon (17-6) - 5 p.m.**

**Sat., Feb. 24 - Championship vs. Monmouth (18-7) or Lake Forest (17-8) - 3 p.m.**  
**Glennie Gym (1,600) - Monmouth, Illinois**

#### Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert, making its Midwest Conference-best 11th consecutive conference tournament appearance, travels to Monmouth and will face Ripon in a semifinal game. The Green Knights are vying for their seventh NCAA Division III Tournament appearance in nine years. The MWC Tournament champion receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

#### The Series:

Ripon holds a 64-57 series lead over St. Norbert in a spirited rivalry dating back to the 1932-33 season. The Green Knights have narrowed the gap by winning 21 of the last 26 meetings over the last 10 seasons.

St. Norbert leads Monmouth 30-13 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights are 12-9 all-time at Monmouth.

St. Norbert leads Lake Forest 46-21 in a series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights have captured 21 of the last 25 meetings in the series.

#### Last Meetings:

Ripon dispatched St. Norbert 76-61 on Jan. 30, 2018 in Ripon. The Red Hawks led 34-25 at halftime. Tyler Semenas had 27 points and Isaac Masters 20 points for the Red Hawks. Mitchell Reinthaler had 14 points to lead the Green Knights.

Monmouth beat St. Norbert 65-56 on Feb. 3, 2018 in De Pere. The Scots led 36-19 at halftime before the Green Knights got to within one point twice, but couldn't take the lead. D.J. Swift led Monmouth with 13 points, while Mitchell Reinthaler and Connor Curtis had 12 points apiece for St. Norbert.

St. Norbert topped Lake Forest 78-68 on Feb. 13, 2018 in Lake Forest, Ill. The Green Knights, who led 36-29 at halftime, got 26 points from Mitchell Reinthaler and 22 points from Wade Geenen. Sean Espinosa and Aram Arslanian had 14 points apiece for the Foresters.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 232-72 in his 12th season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 283-103.

Ripon coach Ryan Kane (St. Norbert, 1999) is 95-50 in his sixth season in Ripon.

Monmouth coach Todd Skrivseth (Coe, 1996) is 73-91 in his seventh season in Monmouth.

Lake Forest coach Ken Davis (Arizona State, 1983) is 53-42 in his fourth season in Lake Forest.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the tournament 19-6 overall. The Green Knights finished tied for second place in the Midwest Conference with Ripon at 14-4.

Senior guard D.J. DeValk, who is out for the season with a broken hand, was leading the Green Knights in scoring at 15.7 points per game. Senior forward Mitchell Reinthaler is averaging 14.6 points and 7.9 rebounds per game. Sophomore forward Connor Curtis is averaging 10.8 points per game, while junior guard Taylor Penn is netting 6.8 points per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 72.0 points per game while shooting 46.5 percent from the floor, 36.8 percent on 3-pointers and 74.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 62.1 points per game while shooting 40.6 percent from the floor, 35.8 percent on 3-pointers and 71.3 percent at the free-throw line.

### About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the tournament 17-6 overall and finished tied for second with St. Norbert in the Midwest Conference at 14-4. The Red Hawks have won 12 of their last 13 games.

Senior guard Tyler Semenas leads the Red Hawks in scoring at 15.5 points per game, while senior guard Isaac Masters is averaging 15.3 points per game. Junior guard Cal Schultz is netting 13.0 points per game, while sophomore guard Trent Jones is averaging 11.7 points per game.

Ripon is averaging 76.9 points per game while shooting 48.2 percent from the floor, 40.3 percent on 3-pointers and 69.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 67.2 points per game while shooting 41.8 percent from the floor, 32.1 percent on 3-pointers and 66.7 percent at the free-throw line.

### About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth enters the game 18-7 overall and won its first Midwest Conference title since 1990 with a 15-3 record. The Scots have won their last seven games.

Senior forward Justin Aluya is averaging 15.3 points and 9.4 rebounds per game to lead the Scots. Senior guard Will Jones is averaging 14.5 points per game, while freshman guard D.J. Swift is scoring 9.2 points per game.

Monmouth is averaging 76.7 points per game while shooting 46.6 percent from the floor, 35.9 percent on 3-pointers and 69.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 70.0 points per game while shooting 44.0 percent from the floor, 35.0 percent on 3-pointers and 69.7 percent at the free-throw line.

### About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the tournament 17-8. The Foresters finished in fourth place in the Midwest Conference at 13-5.

Senior guard Eric Porter leads the Foresters in scoring at 16.7 points per game while shooting 44.5 percent (97-for-218) from beyond the three-point arc. Junior forward Danny Sotos is averaging 12.9 points and 6.4 rebounds per game. Senior forward Orlando Brown is averaging 9.9 points per game, while freshman guard Sean Espinosa is averaging 8.6 points per game.

Lake Forest averaging 75.5 points per game while shooting 47.9 percent from the floor, 36.3 percent on 3-pointers and 68.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 69.5 points per game while shooting 43.0 percent from the floor, 32.0 percent on 3-pointers and 70.3 percent at the free-throw line.

### We Meet Again:

For the fifth time this decade, St. Norbert and Ripon will be meeting in a Midwest Conference Tournament semifinal game.

The Green Knights are 4-0 in those meetings with the Red Hawks, with all four of those games coming at the old Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere.

The 2018 matchup will be just the third time the two teams will meet on a neutral court. St. Norbert

topped Ripon 63-61 on Dec. 6, 1980 in Appleton, while the then-Redmen won 78-64 on Dec. 27, 1961 in Oshkosh.

**Glass Cleaner:**

St. Norbert senior forward Mitchell Reinthaler has grabbed 197 rebounds this season, making him three shy of becoming the first Green Knights in 20 years with a 200-rebound season.

The 6-foot-4 Reinthaler would be the first to grab 200 caroms in a season since 6-foot-8 Andy Riemer had 207 in 1997-98. Before Riemer, the last St.

Norbert player to do it was 6-foot-11 Todd Danen, who had 327 boards in 1975-76.

Reinthaler had a career-high 17 rebounds against Grinnell on Feb. 17.

**Building a Winner:**

With a win in Friday's semifinal, St. Norbert would gain its seventh 20-win season in the last nine years.

In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 and

2016 is the school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 94-13 record from 2013 to 2016 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 221-53. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.
