St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview
St. Norbert College (2-1) vs. UW-Stevens Point (1-1)
Saturday, November 25, 2017 - 7 p.m.
Mulva Family Fitness & Sports Center (1,844) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert hosts UW-Stevens Point for the first time in 25 years in a rare Saturday night game at Mulva Family Fitness & Sports Center. The game concludes a stretch of four games facing three Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference opponents for the Green Knights.

The Series:

UW-Stevens Point leads St. Norbert 50-27 in a series dating back to 1922-23. The Pointers have won 11 consecutive games in the series since a 50-46 St. Norbert win on Dec. 1, 1980 at Quandt Fieldhouse in Stevens Point.

Last Meeting:

UW-Stevens Point defeated St. Norbert 66-61 on Nov. 24, 2015 at Quandt Fieldhouse in Stevens Point. The Green Knights led 33-24 at halftime before the Pointers rallied in the second half. Ben Bobinski led the Green Knights with 18 points, while D.J. DeValk added 14 points. Zack Goedeke led the Pointers with 26 points, while Sean McGann added 13 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 215-67 in his 12th season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 266-98.

UW-Stevens Point coach Bob Semling (UW-Eau Claire, 1981) is 263-72 in his 13th season in Stevens Point.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 2-1 overall following a tough 60-57 setback to UW-Oshkosh at home on Tuesday. The Green Knights' game against UW-Stevens Point marks the third contest against a Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foe in the first four games of the season.

Senior forward Mitchell Reinthaler leads the Green Knights, averaging - MORE -

19.7 points and 8.0 rebounds per game. Senior guard D.J. DeValk is averaging 15.7 points per game. Junior guard Taylor Penn is netting 8.0 points per game, while sophomore forward Joe Lemon is averaging 7.0 points per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 68.0 points per game while shooting 38.3 percent from the floor, 35.9 percent on 3-pointers and 77.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.7 points per game while shooting 43.4 percent from the floor, 27.4 percent on 3-pointers and 68.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the game 1-1 overall. The Pointers have been idle since a 93-72 win at Buena Vista last Saturday. Stevens Point opened the season with a 60-45 loss to St. Olaf on Nov. 15.

Junior guard Nate Dodge leads the Pointers in scoring, averaging 18.0 points per game while going 10-for-17 (58.8 percent) from beyond the three-point arc. Junior forward Mark Nelson is averaging 10.0 points per game, while junior forward Brett Tauber is averaging 9.0 points and 5.5 rebounds per

Stevens Point is averaging 69.0 points per game while shooting 44.0 percent from the floor, 49.1 percent on 3-pointers and 55.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 66.0 points per game while shooting 47.3 percent from the floor, 48.8 percent on 3-pointers and 83.9 percent at the free-throw line.

Thousand Talk:

St. Norbert senior guard D.J. DeValk scored 10 points against UW-Oshkosh on Tuesday to move into 20th place on the school career scoring list.

DeValk currently has 1,077 points, Mike Wisneski's 1,072 points from 1959-63. Aaron Faulkner, who scored 1,095 points from 2002-05, is in 19th place.

DeValk, who reached 1,000 career points late in his junior season,

joined Andrew Schwoerer (1,439, 2012-15), Joe Emmerich (1,811, 1980-84) and Lee Schroeder (1,308, 1986-90) as the only St. Norbert players to reach that mark during their junior year since 1975.

Building a Winner:

St. Norbert has won the Midwest Conference title the last five years and seven times in the last eight seasons. The Green Knights are the first team to win at least four consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight from 1946-51.

The Green Knights have won 20 games six times in the last eight years under Gary Grzesk. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice.

St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 and 2016 is the school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 94-13 record from 2013 to 2016 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 204-48. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.

Jump Shots:

- * UW-Stevens Point's last trip to De Pere was almost 25 years to the day of this visit. The Pointers claimed a 76-40 win on Nov. 24, 1992 at Schuldes Sports Center.
- * St. Norbert was picked to win the Midwest Conference for the sixth consecutive season in the preseason coaches poll. The Green Knights reaped all nine possible first-place votes with a maximum total of 81 points. Lake Forest was picked for second with 67 points, while Cornell and Grinnell were tied for third with 60 points. Ripon was picked for fifth with 56 points, followed by Monmouth (38), Lawrence (35), Illinois College (23), Beloit (21) and Knox (nine).
