St. Norbert College Green Knights Men's Basketball Preview MIDWEST CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT Fri., Feb. 22 - St. Norbert (18-7) vs. Monmouth (13-12) - 7 p.m. Sat., Feb. 23 - Championship vs. Grinnell (19-5) or Lake Forest (16-9) - 3 p.m. Mulva Family Fitness & Sports Center (1,844) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert, making its Midwest Conference-best 12th consecutive conference tournament appearance, hosts the MWC Tournament for the eighth time in 10 years. The Green Knights are vying for their seventh NČAA Division III Tournament appearance in 10 years. The MWC Tournament champion receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Monmouth 31-14 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights are 18-4 all-time at home in the series.

St. Norbert leads Grinnell 33-18 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights are 21-4 all-time and 13-1 under Gary Grzesk at home in the series.

St. Norbert leads Lake Forest 48-21 in a series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights have captured 23 of the last 27 meetings in the series.

Last Meetings:

Monmouth defeated St. Norbert 74-63 this past Saturday at Glennie Gym in Monmouth, Ill. The Green Knights led 32-30 at halftime before the Scots rallied. Jared Murphy led St. Norbert with 16 points, while Joe Ciriacks added 11 points. Will Carius finished with 25 points and D.J. Swift 23 points for the Scots.

St. Norbert defeated Grinnell 116-97 on Feb. 9, 2019 at Mulva Family Fitness & Sports Center in De Pere. The Green Knights led 57-45 at halftime and held on in the second half. Nolan Beirne had 21 points for St. Norbert, with Logan Krekling and Jacob Bolwerk adding 17 apiece. Vinny Curta and Jackson Qualley had 20 points apiece for the Pioneers.

St. Norbert topped Lake Forest 63-62 on Jan. 16, 2019 at Mulva Family Fitness & Sports Center in De Pere. Joe Ciriacks hit a baseline runner with 0.5 seconds left for the win. Connor Curtis had 16 points and Ciriacks 13 for St. Norbert. Aram Arslanian led the Foresters with 21 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Gary Grzesk (UW-Green Bay, 1996) is 250-80 in his 13th season in De Pere. He was 51-31 in three seasons at Lakeland before arriving at St. Norbert to give him an overall mark of 301-111.

Monmouth coach Todd Skrivseth (Coe, 1996) is 88-104 in his eighth season in Monmouth.

Grinnell coach David Arsenault Jr. (Grinnell, 2009) is 32-16 in his second season in Grinnell.

Lake Forest coach Ken Davis (Arizona State, 1983) is 69-52 in his fifth season in Lake Forest.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the tournament 18-7 overall and won the Midwest Conference for the sixth time in the last seven years with a 16-2 record. The Green Knights are coming off a 74-63 loss Saturday at Monmouth.

Junior guard Joe Ciriacks tops the Green Knights in scoring at 14.6 points per game. Junior forward Connor Curtis, who has missed the last six games due to injury, is averaging 14.5 points and 7.4 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Jared Murphy is averaging 10.2 points per game, while sophomore guard Wade Geenen is averaging 8.8 points per game. Junior forward Joe Lemon is posting 8.8 points and 7.1 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 76.9 points per game while shooting 46.5 percent from the floor, 37.0 percent on 3-pointers and 73.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 68.6 points per game while shooting 44.5 percent from the floor, 34.1 percent on 3-pointers and 74.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Scots:

Monmouth enters the tournament 13-12 overall and 11-7 in the Midwest Conference. The Scots, defeated St. Norbert 74-63 on Saturday, won a tiebreaker with Ripon for the fourth spot in the league tournament after finishing 11-7 in MWC play.

Junior forward Will Carius, a transfer from NCAA Division II Northern Michigan, is averaging 25.4 points and 11.2 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard D.J. Swift is totaling 15.8 points per game, while junior guard Justin Batterton is averaging 9.6 points per game. Junior guard Tyler Houston is averaging 6.8 points per game.

Monmouth is averaging 74.8 points per game while shooting 45.6 percent from the floor, 32.2 percent on 3-pointers and 75.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 74.0 points per game while shooting 44.7 percent from the floor, 36.2 percent on 3-pointers and 73.5 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Grinnell enters the tournament 19-4 overall. The Pioneers finished in second place in the Midwest Conference, one game behind St. Norbert at 15-3. Grinnell topped Lake Forest 125-119 on Saturday.

Senior guard Vinny Curta leads the Pioneers in scoring at 25.2 points per game. Sophomore guard Hannes Kogelnik is averaging 18.0 points per game, while freshman guard Jackson Qualley is averaging 17.0 points per game. Senior guard Ky-Sean Johnson is netting 15.0 points per game.

Grinnell is averaging 118.4 points per game while shooting 43.3 percent from the floor, 35.9 percent on 3-pointers and 69.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 101.8 points per game while shooting 55.5 percent from the floor, 40.4 percent on 3-pointers and 65.2 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the tournament 16-9 overall after a third-place finish at 12-6 in the Midwest Conference. The Foresters lost 125-119 Saturday at Grinnell.

Sophomore guard Sean Espinosa is averaging 18.1 points per game, while senior forward Danny Sotos is averaging 14.5 points per game. Freshman guard Tashon Brown is scoring 13.2 points per game, while Sam Husting is averaging 12.0 points per game.

Lake Forest is averaging 84.5 points per game while shooting 50.9 percent from the floor, 41.7 percent on 3-pointers and 73.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 77.8 points per game while

shooting 45.9 percent from the floor, 33.8 percent on 3-pointers and 70.9 percent at the free-throw line.

Midwest Mastery:

St. Norbert has enjoyed a banner run in the Midwest Conference dating back to the end of the 2012-13 season.

Including the last two games of the 2012-13 regular season, St. Norbert is now a lusty 110-10 in its last 120 games against Midwest Conference opponents. This includes an enviable 8-2 mark in the Midwest Conference Tournament.

St. Norbert's five consecutive Midwest Conference men's basketball titles from 2013-17 was the first program to win at least five consecutive MWC men's basketball titles since Beloit won six straight from 1946-51.

Dating back to the 2009-10 season, St. Norbert is 95-7 at home against MWC opponents.

Building a Winner:

St. Norbert has six 20-win seasons in the last nine years. In the program's previous 86 seasons, St. Norbert had 20-win seasons just twice. St. Norbert's 25 wins in 2014 and 2016 is the school record. The Green Knights won 24 games in 2015, 23 games in 2010 and 21 games twice (1984 and 2002). St. Norbert won 20 games in 2011 and 2013.

St. Norbert's 94-13 record from 2013 to 2016 marks the best four-year total in school history.

Since starting the 2007-08 season 2-5, St. Norbert is a solid 239-60. St. Norbert reached its highest national ranking in the 17-year history of the D3hoops.com Top 25 with a No. 3 ranking the week of Feb. 23, 2015.
