St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview Ripon College (4-13, 1-9) at St. Norbert College (13-4, 9-1) Tuesday, February 5, 2008 - 6 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert continues a four-game homestand when it Ripon in a Midwest Conference game. The Green Knights lead Beloit, Lake Forest and Carroll by one game in the league standings.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Ripon 45-24 in a series begun in the 1975-76 season. The Red Hawks have won 10 of the last 17 games in the series, but St. Norbert has won the last five meetings. The Green Knights swept the season series the last two seasons, and won 60-48 earlier this season on Dec. 5 in Ripon.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert beat Ripon 60-48 on Dec. 5 at the Storzer Center in Ripon. The Green Knights led by as many as 21 points midway through the second half. Morgan Strasser and Cortney Biese each had 13 points for St. Norbert, while Jessica DeHamer had 13 points for Ripon.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 479-245 in her 31st season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 809-443 at St. Norbert.

Ripon coach Julie Johnson (Dakota State, 1988) is 234-180 in her 18th season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters Tuesday's game against Ripon at 13-4 overall and 9-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights lead Beloit, Lake Forest and Carroll by one game in the league standings. St. Norbert has been off since this past Wednesday, when it snuck past Lawrence 48-45 at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights have won six consecutive home games and are 8-1 at Schuldes Sports Center this season.

All times Central Standard Time. The Green Knights are led in scoring by junior guard Morgan Strasser. Strasser is the only St. Norbert player scoring in double figures, averaging 12.8 points per game. Sophomore guard Denise Heuser is averaging 8.2 points per game, while senior guard Linsey Propson is scoring 8.1 points per game. The trio combined to score 33 of St. Norbert's 48 points against Lawrence.

St. Norbert is averaging 63.4 points per game. The Green Knights are shooting 41.8 percent from the floor, 26.0 percent on 3-pointers and 67.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents have been held to 55.4 points per game. Foes are shooting 36.8 percent from the floor including 26.8 percent on 3-pointers and 70.2 percent on free throws.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game with a 4-13 overall record and a 1-9 showing in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks have lost six consecutive games, including a 61-43 defeat at home at the hands of Beloit this past Saturday. Ripon's last win came on Jan. 12 in a 54-52 triumph at Lawrence.

The Red Hawks do not have a player scoring in double figures this season. Junior forward Jeni Yaeger leads the squad with 8.8 points per game, and also grabs 5.8 rebounds per game. Sophomore forward Jessica DeHamer averages 8.4 points per game and has a teamhigh 5.9 rebounds per game. Freshman guard Emily Meyer is third on the team in scoring at 6.7 points per game.

Ripon is averaging just 51.2 points per game this season, and has been held under 50 points eight times this season. The Red Hawks are shooting 34.5 percent from the floor, 20.9 percent on 3-pointers and 61.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 59.1 points per game while shooting 41.8 percent from the floor, 25.8 percent on 3-pointers and 66.6 percent at the free-throw line.

Lock Them Up:

St. Norbert's defense has been the strength of the team - and a necessity - as the Green Knights have ascended to the top of the Midwest Conference standings.

The Green Knights are allowing just 55.4 points per game, which is the second-best defensive mark in the Midwest Conference.

St. Norbert needed its "D" in last Wednesday's win against Lawrence. The Green Knights shot just 30 percent from the floor but managed to pull out a 48-45 win over the Vikings.

The Green Knights had three wins by one possession or less at home since Christmas, also beating Beloit 55-54 on Jan. 12 and Lake Forest 84-82 on Jan. 19. St. Norbert got defensive stops on the last possession of all three gams to earn the wins.

Toppling the Top 25:

St. Norbert picked up its first win in nearly five years against a team ranked in the D3hoops.com Top 25 when it beat Lake Forest on Jan. 19.

The Foresters were ranked 19th in that week's poll, and fell 84-82 to the Green Knights in De Pere.

St. Norbert had not beaten a team ranked by D3hoops.com since beating No. 6 Carleton 60-47 on March 8, 2003 in a second-round NCAA Division III Tournament game.

The Green Knights have played five teams who have been ranked at some point this season. Carroll, Lake Forest, UW-Eau Claire, Medaille and Amherst have all cracked the Top 25 at one time or another this season.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert's run of nine straight years with at least 10 conference wins is the longest in the Midwest Conference.

* - St. Norbert is leading the Midwest Conference in field-goal percentage at 43.1 percent. The Green Knights are also leading the Midwest Conference in field-goal percentage defense at 36.8 percent.
