St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview

- St. Norbert College (9-3, 4-2 MWC) at Illinois College (8-5, 4-2 MWC) Sherman Gym (1,600) Jacksonville, Ill. Fri., Jan. 22 5 p.m.
- St. Norbert College (9-3, 4-2 MWC) at Knox College (1-12, 1-5 MWC) Memorial Gym (3,000) Galesburg, III. Sat., Jan. 23 2 p.m.

Weekend Overview:

St. Norbert tries to extend its modest two-game winning streak with a pair of games against MWC foes Illinois College and Knox during a road trip to the Land of Lincoln.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Illinois College 19-5 in a series begun in the 1984-85 season. The Green Knights have won 14 straight games in the series since a 78-68 Illinois College win on Feb. 2, 2001 in Jacksonville, Ill.

St. Norbert leads Knox 24-0 in a series begun in the 1993-94 season.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert beat Illinois College 59-47 last Feb. 27 in the semifinals of the Midwest Conference Tournament in De Pere. Morgan Strasser led St. Norbert with 15 points, while Rachel Macon had 20 points for Illinois College, which had 30 turnovers.

St. Norbert beat Knox 66-52 last Friday at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. St. Norbert shot 52.5 percent from the floor (32-for-61) as Denise Heuser led the Green Knights with 20 points. Lynn Mueller led Knox with 12 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 517-254 in her 33rd season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 846-452 at St. Norbert.

Illinois College coach Brenna Kelly (Culver Stockton, 1985) is 281-240 in her 23rd season in Jacksonville.

Entering Friday's game with Carroll, Knox coach Emily Cline (Cornell, 2001) is 11-24 in her second season in Galesburg.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend with a 9-3 overall record and a 4-2 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights swept Knox and Grinnell at home this weekend by scores of 78-52 and 74-53, respectively.

Senior guard Denise Heuser leads the team in scoring at 15.4 points per game, and has made a team-high 19 3-pointers this season. Heuser scored - MORE -

20 points in the win over Knox and then matched a career-high with 23 points against Grinnell. Junior forward Rachel Hermus is scoring 8.3 points per game while averaging a team-high 5.3 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Krista Pelky is netting 7.9 points per game, while senior forward Emily Otzelberger is scoring 7.3 points per game while shooting 61.7 percent from the floor.

St. Norbert is averaging 66.6 points per game. The Green Knights are shooting 44.3 percent from the floor, 34.5 percent on 3-pointers and 70.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 52.3 points per game. The opposition is shooting 37.6 percent from the floor including 28.5 percent on 3-pointers and 65.6 percent on free throws.

About the Lady Blues:

Illinois College enters the weekend with a 9-4 overall record and a 4-2 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Lady Blues were swept on their two-game road trip last weekend, losing 76-73 in overtime to Ripon and 75-64 to Beloit.

Senior guard Candy Norville leads Illinois College in scoring at 14.5 points per game. Junior center Rachel Macon is averaging 12.3 points and 7.7 rebounds per game while shooting 59.1 percent from the floor. Junior guard Carrie Walberg is netting 10.4 points and 8.5 rebounds per game.

Illinois College is averaging 69.8 points per game while shooting 41.5 percent from the floor, 36.6 percent on 3-pointers and 64.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 64.1 points per game while shooting 39.5 percent from the floor, 30.9 percent on 3-pointers and 70.9 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Prairie Fire:

Knox enters Friday's game with Carroll with a 5-7 overall record and a 1-5 ledger in the Midwest Conference. The Prairie Fire has lost their last four games, including a 78-52 loss at St. Norbert last Friday and a 74-51 loss at Ripon on Saturday.

Sophomore forward Kelly Ricketts leads the Prairie Fire in scoring and rebounding at 9.9 points and 5.8 rebounds per game. Junior guard Jenny Haskell is netting an average of 8.3 points per game, while senior guard Erin Navolio is netting 8.1 points per game and has made a team-high 15 3-pointers.

Knox is scoring an average of 64.2 points per game while shooting 37.9 percent from the floor, 27.9 percent on 3-pointers and 59.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 67.4 points per game and are shooting 42.5 percent from the floor, 38.5 percent on 3-pointers and 66.8 percent at the free-throw line.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert is allowing its opponents to score just 52.3 points per game this season. The Green Knights' scoring defense is 9.1 points per game better than the next-best team, which is Beloit's 61.4 points per game.

In this week's NCAA Division III national statistical rankings, St. Norbert had the 20th-best scoring defense out of 424 teams.

The Green Knights have allowed opponents to 49 points or less in five of their games this season, including a low of 35 points in a 54-35 win over UW-La Crosse in the championship game of the St. Norbert Tip-Off Tournament on Nov. 21

St. Norbert has not had a season where it has held its opponents to under an average of 52 points per game since a 50.2 points per game mark in 1985-86.

- * St. Norbert is 24th nationally in turnover margin (plus-6.42 per game) and 29th in assist to turnover ratio (plus-0.9).
