St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview NCAA DIVISION III REGIONAL TOURNAMENT

Fri., March 5 - No. 25 St. Norbert (22-3) vs. No. 12 Calvin (24-4) - 7:30 p.m.
Sat., March 6 - vs. No. 23 UW-Stevens Point (21-6) or UM-Morris (19-7) - 5 p.m.
Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Tournament Overview:

Three teams ranked in the D3hoops.com Top 25 are included among the four teams playing at the St. Norbert Regional looking to advance into the sectional round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

The Series:

St. Norbert has never faced Calvin in women's basketball.

St. Norbert and UW-Stevens Point are tied 11-11 in the all-time series, which began in 1978-79. The Green Knights have won the last three meetings - a 70-48 win in De Pere on Dec. 2, 1997, a 61-49 win in Stevens Point on Nov. 30, 1998 and a 71-57 win over the Pointers in the NCAA Division III Tournament on March 7, 2008 at Berg Gym.

UM-Morris leads St. Norbert 1-0 in the all-time series, with the Cougars picking up a 53-51 win on Nov. 25, 1989 in St. Paul, Minn.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 530-254 in her 33rd season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 859-452 at St. Norbert.

Calvin coach John Ross (UW-Oshkosh, 1990) is 154-40 in his seventh year in Grand Rapids. He is a Manitowoc native.

UW-Stevens Point coach Shirley Egner (UW-La Crosse, 1980) is 379-174 in her 21st season in Stevens Point.

UM-Morris coach Tim Grove (North Dakota, 1999) is 65-42 in his fourth season in Morris.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its ninth NCAA Tournament appearance, and is 8-12 all-time in the tournament. The Green Knights placed fourth when they hosted the Final Four in De Pere in 1985, and also advanced to the Sweet 16 in 1986, 1988 and 2003.

Calvin is making its 12th NCAA Tournament appearance. The Knights are 14-11 all-time in the tournament and last made an appearance when they advanced to the Elite Eight in 2007.

UW-Stevens Point is making its seventh NCAA Tournament appearance. The Pointers are 16-5 in the tournament, winning national championships

in 1987 and 2002 with a fourth-place finish in 2004.

UM-Morris is making its second NCAA Tournament appearance, and went 2-1 during the 1983 tournament.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 25 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the NCAA Tournament at 22-3 overall. The Green Knights, who have won 15 straight games since a 62-61 loss at Ripon on Jan. 9, won the Midwest Conference Tournament with a 73-57 win over Ripon this past Saturday in De Pere.

Senior guard Denise Heuser, the Midwest Conference Player of the Year, is the Green Knights' leading scorer at 14.3 points per game. Senior forward Emily Otzelberger is averaging 9.0 points per game while shooting 58.7 percent from the floor. Sophomore guard Krista Pelky averages 8.7 points per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 69.2 points per game. The Green Knights are shooting 45.8 percent from the floor, 30.0 percent on 3-pointers and 68.4 percent at the free-throw line. Foes are scoring an average of 50.0 points per game against the Green Knights' defense. Opponents are shooting 36.9 percent from the floor including 26.1 percent on 3-pointers and 66.5 percent on free throws.

About the Knights:

Calvin, ranked No. 12 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the tournament at 24-4 overall. The nights were runner-up in the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association to Hope at 14-2. Three of Calvin's four losses this season were to Hope, with the other a 58-47 loss at Carthage on Dec. 4.

MIAA Player of the Year Carissa Verkaik, a 6-foot-2 freshman forward, leads Calvin with 18.2 points and 9.5 rebounds per game and shoots 57.2 percent from the floor. Senior forward Brook VanEck is the only other Calvin player averaging in double figures in scoring at 11.0 points per game, and also grabs 11.0 rebounds per game.

Calvin is averaging 68.2 points per game while shooting 44.0 percent from the floor, 33.1 percent on 3-pointers and 74.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 56.4 points per game while shooting 35.0 percent from the floor, 29.1 percent on 3-pointers and 68.3 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the tournament with a 21-6 overall record. The Pointers, who are 4-3 in their last seven games, finished second in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference with an 11-5 record, but won the WIAC Tournament with a 68-64 win at UW-Whitewater on Saturday.

Junior center Britta Petersen leads the Pointers with 15.2 points and 6.2 rebounds per game while shooting 54.5 percent from the floor. Junior guard Andrea Fleese is scoring 11.0 points per game, while sophomore guard Cassie Bandow is scoring 10.1 points per game while shooting 53.2 percent (41-for-77) from beyond the three-point arc.

Stevens Point is averaging 69.2 points per game while shooting 44.7 percent from the floor, 34.4 percent on 3-pointers and 71.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 61.1 points per game while shooting 39.8 percent from the floor, 32.5 percent on 3-pointers and 68.3 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Cougars:

Minnesota-Morris enters the tournament at 19-7 overall. The Cougars won the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference with a 13-1 record, but lost in the UMAC Tournament semifinals 63-42 to Presentation last Friday. Five of Morris' seven losses this season have come to NCAA Division II or NAIA competition.

Junior forward Steph Roggenbuck is averaging 12.8 points and 6.9 rebounds per game. Freshman forward Emily Mehr is the only other Cougar scoring in double figures at 100 points per

game, and is shooting 51.1 percent from the floor.

Morris is scoring an average of 68.4 points per game while shooting 40.6 percent from the floor, 32.4 percent on 3-pointers and 75.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 60.3 points per game while shooting 38.5 percent from the floor, 29.3 percent on 3-pointers and 66.6 percent at the free-throw line.

Schuldes Snippets:

St. Norbert has won 37 of its last 38 games at Schuldes Sports Center, the lone blemish coming in the 2009 Midwest Conference Tournament championship to Ripon 56-49.

The Green Knights had a 24-game home court winning streak prior to its loss to Ripon and are 13-0 at home this season.

St. Norbert is 83-15 in its last 98 games played at Schuldes Sports Center, and has won its last 26 Midwest Conference regular-season home games.

Twenty Talk:

St. Norbert earned its third straight 20-win season with a 76-61 win over

Carroll on Feb. 20.

Remarkably, throughout the rich history of the St. Norbert women's basketball program the Green Knights have never had three straight 20-win seasons.

St. Norbert has missed the NCAA Division III Tournament only once when winning at least 20 games, coming last season during a 20-5 campaign. The Green Knights were 22-8 in 1980-81, but that was prior to the NCAA offering women's championships.

St. Norbert is 64-13 over the last three years, matching the previous best three-year stretch of 64-12 from 1985 to 1987.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert is allowing its opponents to score an even 50.0 points per game this season.

In this week's NCAA Division III national statistical rankings, St. Norbert had the seventh-best scoring defense out of 424 teams.

The Green Knights have allowed opponents to 49 points or less in 11 of their games this season, and have yielded 54 points or less for 13 of their last 15 games.

The season-low allowed of 34 points came against Lawrence on Feb. 2 and again on Feb. 13. The Green Knights also held UW-La Crosse to 35 points in a 54-35 win in the championship game of the St. Norbert Tip-Off Tournament on Nov. 21. St. Norbert has allowed 54 points or less in 19 of 25 games this season. The Green Knights are 5-2 this season when allowing 54 points or more this season.

St. Norbert has not had a season where it has held its opponents to under an average of 52 points per game since a 50.2 points per game mark in 1985-86.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert's game against No. 12 Calvin is the highest-ranked team by D3hoops.com to play a host institution in this year's NCAA Division III Tournament.

* - St. Norbert is 118-3 in its last 121 games when scoring at least 70 points, including having won 46 straight. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 295-22 when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert is 11-0 when scoring at least 70 points this season.
