Game Overview

St. Norbert opens the 2010-11 campaign hosting the Baylake Bank Tip-Off Classic.

The Series

St. Norbert has never faced Macalester or Mary Hardin-Baylor in women's basketball.

St. Norbert trails the all-time series 15-11 with UW-Oshkosh in a series that started during the 1979-80 season. The Green Knights defeated the Titans 60-41 last Nov. 28 at the Kolf Sports Center. Kristin Zimmerman led St. Norbert with 16 points, while Denise Heuser scored 15 points.

The Coaches

St. Norbert head coach **Connie Tilley** 531-255 in her 34th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 860-453 at St. Norbert

Macalester head coach **Ellen Thompson** is 45-79 in her sixth season in St. Paul.

Mary Hardin-Baylor head coach **Kim Kirkpatrick-Thornton** is 77-58 in her sixth season in Belton.

UW-Oshkosh head coach **Terri Schumacher** is 52-75 in her sixth season in Oshkosh.

About the Green Knights

St. Norbert, ranked No. 21 in the D3hoops.com pre-season Top 25 poll, finished 23-4 overall and 14-2 in the

Midwest Conference during the 2009-10 season. The Green Knights earned a trip to the second-round of the NCAA Division III tournament and won the MWC title for the ninth time in school history.

St. Norbert loses its top two scorers from a season ago, but return five players who averaged 6.0 points per game or more. Junior guard Krista Pelky is the leading returning scorer. Pelky averaged 8.2 points per contest last season. Senior guard Stefanie Bunday averaged 7.3 points and dished out 3.3 assists per game a year ago.

The Green Knights averaged 69.1 points while allowing 51.4 points per game last season, ranking seventh nationally. St. Norbert led the Midwest Conference in scoring defense by nearly 10 full points during the 2009-10 season.

About the Scots

Macalester finished 16-10 overall and 16-6 in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Association during the 2009-10 season. The Scots finished fourth in the MIAC last season.

Macalester returns its third-leading scorer from a season ago. Jessica Rene averaged 9.3 points per contest a year ago. Rene shot 42.6 (43-for-101) percent from three-point range. Senior center Majra Mucic scored 7.4 points and grabbed 4.7 rebounds per game last season.

The Scots averaged 68.7 points while allowing 60.4 points per game last season. Macalester shot 41.9

About the Crusaders

Mary Hardin-Baylor finished 21-6 overall and 17-4 in the American Southwest Conference during the 2009-10 season. The Crusaders are picked to finish first in the ASC West Division preseason poll.

Mary Hardin-Baylor returns its second leading scorer from a season ago. Senior guard Lindsay Eaton averaged 11.1 points and 5.9 rebounds per game last season. Senior forward Stacie Stephens averaged 6.5 points per game.

The Crusaders averaged 66.7 points while allowing 57.4 points per game last season. The Crusaders shot 41.2 percent from the floor while allowing opponents to shoot 36.8 percent.

About the Titans

UW-Oshkosh finished 8-17 overall and 3-13 in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Association. The Titans return four of their top five scorers from a season ago. Oshkosh is 1-0 heading into Tuesday's game with Lawrence. The Titans opened the 2010-11 season with a 59-53 win at Loras on Nov. 15.

Sophomore guard Katie Kitzke averaged 10.9 points per game a season ago. Senior guard Michell Boeder chipped in 9.0 points per game. Senior Shelby Churchill averaged 5.8 points and 8.0 rebounds last season.

UW-Oshkosh averaged 59.0 points while allowing 62.4 points per game last season. The Titans shot 40.6 percent from the floor while allowing opponents to shoot 41.1 percent.

Schuldes Snippets

St. Norbert has won 38 of its last 40 games at Schuldes Sports Center, the last loss being a 71-58 defeat to UW-Stevens Point in the second-round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

The Green Knights are 84-16 in their last 100 games played at Schuldes Sports Center. St. Norbert has won its last 26 Midwest Conference regular-season home games.

St. Norbert owns a 267-76 record in homes games under Connie Tilley. The Green Knights have only had one losing record at home in 1977-78. St. Norbert went 3-7 at home during the 1995-96 season.

HOME COOKING

Over the past five seasons, St. Norbert has compiled a 54-9 record in games played at Schuldes Sports center. That includes a 36-4 record in the Midwest Conference.

Twenty Win Talk

St. Norbert has won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons. Remarkably, throughout the rich history of the St. Norbert women's basketball program the Green Knights had never had three-straight 20-win seasons.

St. Norbert has missed the NCAA Division III Tournament only once when winning at least 20 games, coming during the 2008-09 season during a 20-5 campaign. The Green Knights were 22-8 in 1980-81, but that was prior to the NCAA offering women's championships.

The Green Knights are one of only 25 teams in Division III to have won 20-or-more games the last three seasons.

Pick Me a Winner

Over the past three seasons, St. Norbert has compiled a 65-14 overall record. That mark is good for a .823 winning percentage. The Green Knights have the 16th-best winning percentage in Division III basketball since the 2007-08 season.

First to 70 is a Winner

St. Norbert is 119-3 in its last 122 games when scoring at least 70 points, including having won 47 straight. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 296-22 when scoring at least 70 points. The Green Knights were 12-0 when scoring at least 70 points last season.

Open it Up

St. Norbert is 4-0 in its last four season openers. The Green Knights have opened with the St. Norbert College Tip-Off Tournament the past three seasons. The Green Knights are 6-0 in the event.

D is for Defense

St. Norbert allowed only 51.4 points per game last season. The Green Knights ranked seventh nationally in

scoring defense out of 424 teams.

St. Norbert allowed opponents to 49 points or less in 11 games last season, and yielded 54 points or less in 13 of its last 17 games.

The season-low allowed of 34 points came against Lawrence on Feb. 2 and again on Feb. 13. The Green Knights also held UW-La Crosse to 35 points in a 54-35 win in the championship game of the St. Norbert College Tip-Off Tournament on Nov. 21. St. Norbert allowed 54 points or less in 19 of 27 games last season.

St. Norbert had not had a season where it has held its opponents to under an average of 52 points per game since a 50.2 points per game mark in 1985-86.

Connie TILLEY



Connie Tilley will enter her 34th season at the helm of the women's basketball program at St. Norbert in 2010-11. But it hasn't been just basketball that has made Tilley one of the most successful coaches of women's sports in Division III athletics.

Tilley has previously coached men's golf, women's golf, volleyball and softball.

Her career record in all four sports combined is 861-453 for a .655 winning percentage and 19 conference titles. In 53 sports seasons, Tilley has had only five records below .500.

But it's basketball where she's made the biggest strides. In 2009, Tilley became the 15th coach in Division III history to achieve 500 career wins. Following the 2009-2010 season, Tilley has a 531-255 career record and has led St. Norbert to the Midwest Conference playoffs 20 times in 27 seasons in the league. Tilley is Wisconsin's all-time winningest NCAA collegiate women's basketball coach.

During the 2008-09 season, St. Norbert College named the playing court in Schuldes Sports Center as "Connie Tilley Court" in her honor.

The Green Knights won their record ninth Midwest Conference championship in 2010. Despite having just two seniors, St. Norbert finished 23-4 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament after defeating Calvin College in the first round.

Hired by then-athletics director Mel Nicks in 1977, Tilley has coached St. Norbert basketball to 12 conference titles, eight NCAA Tournament appearances and one Final Four. Four of her basketball teams have advanced to the Division III Sweet 16, most recently in 2003.

In addition, she coached the UW-La Crosse women's tennis team while completing graduate work there - and the team finished seventh in the nation.
