The Series

St. Norbert leads the all-time series 35-20 with Lake Forest. The Green Knights beat Lake Forest 61-57 on Jan. 5 in Lake Forest.

St. Norbert leads the all-time series 21-6 with Illinois College. The Green Knights have won 16 of the last 17 games in the series. Illinois College topped St. Norbert 59-52 last Friday in Jacksonville.

The Coaches

St. Norbert head coach **Connie Tilley** 543-257 in her 34th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 872-455 at St. Norbert.

Lake Forest head coach **Tamlyn Tills** is 169-233 in her 16th season overall, and is 33-26 in her third season in Lake Forest.

Illinois College head coach **Brenna Kelly** is 295-250 in her 24th season in Jacksonville.

About the Green Knights

St. Norbert, ranked No. 24 in this week's D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the weekend 12-2 overall and 8-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights suffered their first defeat of the season, a 59-52 loss at Illinois College last Friday. St. Norbert rebounded with a 62-55 win at Knox on Saturday. Rachel Hermus poured in 15 points with five rebounds in the win.

Juniors Krista Pelky and Jamie Kuhl are both averaging 10.9 points per game to lead St. Norbert. Kuhl is also averaging 7.6 rebounds a game to lead the Green

Knights. Hermus is averaging 15.4 points per game in seven games played this season.

St. Norbert is averaging 63.4 points while allowing 51.7 points per game. The Green Knights are shooting 39.9 percent from the floor while holding opponents to 37.1 percent.

About the Foresters

Lake Forest enters the weekend 6-6 overall and 4-3 in the Midwest Conference. The Foresters split a pair of conference games this past weekend topping Ripon 76-46 on Friday before dropping a 73-60 decision to Beloit on Saturday.

Sam Schuring leads Lake Forest averaging 10.8 points per game. Alex Messacar is averaging 10.3 points per game. Amiee Lockwood is averaging 4.9 rebounds per game to lead Lake Forest.

Lake Forest is averaging 68.8 points while allowing 60.0 points per game. The Foresters are shooting 41.7 percent from the floor. Opponents are shooting 38.5 percent.

About the Lady Blues

Illinois College enters the weekend 8-5 overall and 6-2 in the Midwest Conference. The Lady Blues have won five of the last six games, including a 59-52 win over St. Norbert on Friday. Illinois College beat Ripon 49-46 on Saturday.

Carrie Walberg is averaging 15.0 points and 7.8 rebounds per game to lead Illinois College. Rachel Macon is averaging 14.8 points per game.

Charity Stripe Chatter

St. Norbert has attempted at least 25 free throws in four of its last five games, and have hoisted 20 or more in six of the last seven games. Over that stretch, St. Norbert is shooting 73.3 (129-for-176) percent.

Deja Vu

St. Norbert senior forward Rachel Hermus matched a career-high 26 points in the 69-57 win over Carroll at Schuldes Sports Center on Jan. 8. Hermus reached the 26-point plateau in the 78-69 win over Bates at the D3hoops.com Classic in Las Vegas on Dec. 28.

Hermus finished 10-for-15 from the floor, and added six rebounds in the win over Bates and finished 10-for-16 from the floor with seven rebounds in the win over Carroll.

Double it Up

St. Norbert junior forward Jamie Kuhl netted her fourth double-double of her career an third of the 2010-11 season in the 69-57 win over Carroll on Jan. 8. Kuhl finished with 12 points and a career-high 14 rebounds.

Schuldes Snippets

St. Norbert has won 44 of its last 46 games at Schuldes Sports Center, the last loss being a 71-58 defeat to UW-Stevens Point in the second round of the 2010 NCAA Division III Tournament.

The Green Knights are 90-16 in their last 106 games played at Schuldes Sports Center. St. Norbert has won its last 29 Midwest Conference regular-season home games.

St. Norbert owns a 273-76 record in homes games under Connie Tilley. The Green Knights have only had one losing record at home since 1977-78. St. Norbert went 3-7 at home during the 1995-96 season.

St. Norbert's current senior class has never lost a regular-season Midwest Conference home game.

State Conference Chatter

St. Norbert defeated UW-Oshkosh 50-42 in the championship game of the Baylake Bank Tip-Off Classic on Nov. 20. The win marks the eighth-straight year St. Norbert head coach Connie Tilley has won a game against a school from the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.

Since the start of the 2005-06 season, St. Norbert is a solid 11-6 against the WIAC, including having won eight of the last 11 games.

Winter Wonder

St. Norbert has won 19 of the last 20 games played in January and February. The Green Knights have won nine of ten games in January and nine-straight games in February.

Since the 2007-08 season, The Green Knights are 47-7 in the months of January and February (23-6 in January and 24-1 in February).

Hot Shots

Since the start of the 2007-08 season, St. Norbert has shot a higher percentage from the floor than its opponents in 71 of 91 games. The Green Knights are 67-4 in those games.

Turning the Tide

St. Norbert has committed less turnovers than its opponents in 75 of the last 93 games, and astounding 80.6 percent of the time. The Green Knights have gone 67-8 in those games.

Defense Wins Championships

St. Norbert is 72-3 in its last 75 games when allowing 59 points or less. The Green Knights have won 23 of the last 24 games when allowing 59 points or less. All-time under Connie Tilley, the Green Knights are 364-42 in games when they have held opponents to 59 points or less.

Little Help From My Friends

St. Norbert played short-handed in the 61-57 win at Lake Forest on Jan. 5. The Green Knights were without starting senior guard Stefanie Bunday. To overcome, five Green Knights played 29 minutes or more, and four scored double figures.

St. Norbert has held five opponents to 49 point or less and have held two opponents to 40 point or less. The season-low allowed of 33 points came against Monmouth on Dec. 4. The Green Knights also allowed 38 points to Knox on Dec. 11.

St. Norbert has not had a season where it has held opponents to under an average of 52 points per game since a 50.2 points per game mark in 1985-86.

Head of the Class

St. Norbert is 118-19 in Midwest Conference games since the 2002-03 season. That includes a 51-5 record in the MWC over the past three seasons.

As Predicted?

Prior to the 2010-11 season, St. Norbert was picked to win the Midwest Conference championship in a poll of MWC coaches. The Green Knights earned all nine possible first-place votes.

St. Norbert won the 2009-10 MWC championship with a 14-2 record and made it to the second round of the NCAA Division III Regional Tournament.

Since St. Norbert head coach Connie Tilley took over during the 1977-78 season, the Green Knights have scored 60 points or more in 609 of a possible 798 games. St. Norbert is an incredible 510-99 in those games which they reached the 60-point plateau.

St. Norbert is 143-16 since the 2002-03 season when scoring 60 points or more.

First to 70 is a Winner

St. Norbert is 122-3 in its last 125 games when scoring at least 70 points, including having won 50 straight. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 300-22 when scoring at least 70 points. The Green Knights were 12-0 when scoring at least 70 points last season. St. Norbert is 3-0 this season when reaching 70 points.

Twenty Win Talk

St. Norbert has won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons. Remarkably, throughout the rich history of the St. Norbert women's basketball program the Green Knights had never had three-straight 20-win seasons prior to the current streak.

St. Norbert has missed the NCAA Division III Tournament only once when winning at least 20 games, coming during the 2008-09 season during a 20-5 campaign. The Green Knights were 22-8 in 1980-81, but that was prior to the NCAA offering women's championships.

The Green Knights are one of only 25 teams in Division III to have won 20-or-more games the last three seasons.

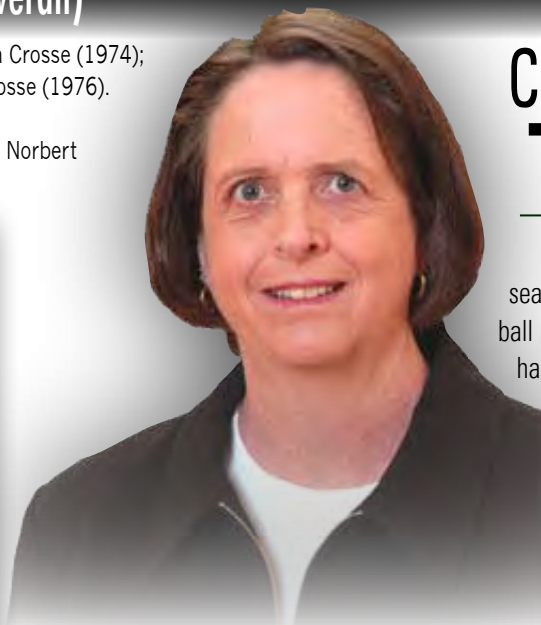

Connie TILLEY



Connie Tilley is in her 34th season at the helm of the women's basketball program at St. Norbert in 2010-11. But it hasn't been just basketball that has made Tilley one of the most successful coaches of women's sports in Division III athletics.

Tilley has previously coached men's golf, women's golf, volleyball and softball.

Her career record in all four sports combined is 872-456 for a .655 winning percentage and 19 conference titles. In 53 sports seasons, Tilley has had only five records below .500.

But it's basketball where she's made the biggest strides. In 2009, Tilley became the 15th coach in Division III history to achieve 500 career wins. Following the 2009-2010 season, Tilley has a 543-257 career record and has led St. Norbert to the Midwest Conference playoffs 20 times in 27 seasons in the league. Tilley is Wisconsin's all-time winningest NCAA collegiate women's basketball coach.

During the 2008-09 season, St. Norbert College named the playing court in Schuldes Sports Center as "Connie Tilley Court" in her honor.

The Green Knights won their record ninth Midwest Conference championship in 2010. Despite having just two seniors, St. Norbert finished 23-4 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament after defeating Calvin College in the first round.

Hired by then-athletics director Mel Nicks in 1977, Tilley has coached St. Norbert basketball to 13 conference titles, nine NCAA Tournament appearances and one Final Four. Four of her basketball teams have advanced to the Division III Sweet 16, most recently in 2003.

In addition, she coached the UW-La Crosse women's tennis team while completing graduate work there - and the team finished seventh in the nation.
