The Series

St. Norbert leads Lawrence 58-14 in a series begun in the 1975-76 season. The Green Knights have won 22 of the last 24 meetings, including the last 10.

In the last meeting, St. Norbert toppled Lawrence 68-34 last Feb. 13 at Schuldes Sports Center. Denise Heuser poured in 14 points to lead the Green Knights. Jamie Kuhl added 12 points.

The Coaches

St. Norbert head coach **Connie Tilley** 545-257 in her 34th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 874-455 at St. Norbert.

Lawrence head coach **Dennis Nagan** is 0-15 in his first season in Appleton.

About the Green Knights

St. Norbert, ranked No. 24 in this week's D3hoops.com Top 25, enters 14-2 overall and 10-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights have won 12 of the last 13 games. St. Norbert swept a pair of Midwest Conference games at home this past weekend, topping Lake Forest 66-59 on Friday before beating Illinois College 65-52 on Saturday.

St. Norbert has five players averaging 9.4 points or more this season. Juniors Jamie Kuhl and Krista Pelky are both scoring 10.8 points per game. Rachel Hermus is averaging 13.2 points per contest in nine games this season. Kuhl is grabbing 7.6 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 63.6 points while allowing

52.2 points per game. The Green Knights rank first in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense.

St. Norbert is shooting 39.6 percent from the floor while holding opponents to 37.1 percent shooting. The Green Knights are allowing teams to shoot just 27.8 percent on 3-pointers.

About the Vikings

Lawrence enters 0-15 overall and 0-10 in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings dropped a pair of Midwest Conference games this past weekend falling 53-46 at home to Grinnell on Friday before losing 75-39 to Monmouth on Saturday.

Alex Deshler is averaging 9.2 points per game to lead the Vikings. Nakita Chadwick is averaging 8.6 points and 8.0 rebounds for Lawrence.

Lawrence is averaging 47.6 points, while allowing 66.5 points per game. The Vikings are shooting 32.2 percent from the floor. Opponents are shooting 39.5 percent.

Share the Wealth

All of St. Norbert's current starters have led the Green Knights in scoring for a game this season. Every starter is averaging a healthy 9.4 points per game or more. Rachel Hermus is averaging 13.2 points in nine games, Jamie Kuhl and Krista Pelky are averaging 10.8 points apiece, Stefanie Bunday is averaging 9.8 points and Erin Baganz is averaging 9.4 points per game.

Charity Stripe Chatter

St. Norbert has attempted at least 25 free throws in five of its last seven games, and have hoisted 20 or more in seven of the last nine games. Over that stretch, St. Norbert is shooting 74.5 (161-for-216) percent. Currently St. Norbert is ranked 31st in NCAA Division III in free-throw percentage, shooting 73.9 percent.

Deja Vu

St. Norbert senior forward Rachel Hermus matched a career-high 26 points in the 69-57 win over Carroll at Schuldes Sports Center on Jan. 8. Hermus reached the 26-point plateau in the 78-69 win over Bates at the D3hoops.com Classic in Las Vegas on Dec. 28.

Hermus finished 10-for-15 from the floor, and added six rebounds in the win over Bates and finished 10-for-16 from the floor with seven rebounds in the win over Carroll.

Double it Up

St. Norbert junior forward Jamie Kuhl netted her fourth double-double of her career an third of the 2010-11 season in the 69-57 win over Carroll on Jan. 8. Kuhl finished with 12 points and a career-high 14 rebounds.

Schuldes Snippets

St. Norbert has won 46 of its last 48 games at Schuldes Sports Center, the last loss being a 71-58 defeat to UW-Stevens Point in the second round of the 2010 NCAA Division III Tournament.

The Green Knights are 92-16 in their last 108 games played at Schuldes Sports Center. St. Norbert has won its last 31 Midwest Conference regular-season home games.

St. Norbert owns a 275-76 record in homes games under Connie Tilley. The Green Knights have only had one losing record at home since 1977-78. St. Norbert went 3-7 at home during the 1995-96 season.

St. Norbert's current senior class has never lost a

championship game of the Baylake Bank Tip-Off Classic on Nov. 20. The win marks the eighth-straight year St. Norbert head coach Connie Tilley has won a game against a school from the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.

Since the start of the 2005-06 season, St. Norbert is a solid 11-6 against the WIAC, including having won eight of the last 11 games.

Winter Wonder

St. Norbert has won 21 of the last 22 games played in January and February. The Green Knights have won 11 of 12 games in January and nine-straight games in February.

Since the 2007-08 season, The Green Knights are 49-7 in the months of January and February (25-6 in January and 24-1 in February).

Hot Shots

Since the start of the 2007-08 season, St. Norbert has shot a higher percentage from the floor than its opponents in 72 of 93 games. The Green Knights are 68-4 in those games.

Turning the Tide

St. Norbert has committed less turnovers than its opponents in 77 of the last 95 games, and astounding 81.1 percent of the time. The Green Knights have gone 69-8 in those games.

Defense Wins Championships

St. Norbert is 74-3 in its last 75 games when allowing 59 points or less. The Green Knights have won 25 of the last 26 games when allowing 59 points or less. All-time under Connie Tilley, the Green Knights are 366-42 in games when they have held opponents to 59 points or less.

The Sixties

Since St. Norbert head coach Connie Tilley took over during the 1977-78 season, the Green Knights have scored 60 points or more in 611 of a possible 800 games. St. Norbert is an incredible 512-99 in those games which they reached the 60-point plateau.

St. Norbert is 145-16 since the 2002-03 season when scoring 60 points or more.

First to 70 is a Winner

St. Norbert is 122-3 in its last 125 games when scoring at least 70 points, including having won 50 straight. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 300-22 when scoring at least 70 points. The Green Knights were 12-0 when scoring at least 70 points last season. St. Norbert is 3-0

Twenty Win Talk

St. Norbert has won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons. Remarkably, throughout the rich history of the St. Norbert women's basketball program the Green Knights had never had three-straight 20-win seasons prior to the current streak.

St. Norbert has missed the NCAA Division III Tournament only once when winning at least 20 games, coming during the 2008-09 season during a 20-5 campaign. The Green Knights were 22-8 in 1980-81, but that was prior

to the NCAA offering women's championships.

The Green Knights are one of only 25 teams in Division III to have won 20-or-more games the last three seasons.

D is for Defense

St. Norbert is allowing 52.2 points per game this season. The Green Knights currently rank 28th in NCAA Division III statistical rankings with 51.7 points allowed per game.

St. Norbert has held five opponents to 49 point or less and have held two opponents to 40 point or less. The season-low allowed of 33 points came against Monmouth on Dec. 4. The Green Knights also allowed 38 points to Knox on Dec. 11.

St. Norbert has not had a season where it has held opponents to under an average of 52 points per game since a 50.2 points per game mark in 1985-86.

Head of the Class

St. Norbert is 120-19 in Midwest Conference games since the 2002-03 season. That includes a 51-5 record in the MWC over the past three seasons.

As Predicted?

Prior to the 2010-11 season, St. Norbert was picked to win the Midwest Conference championship in a poll of MWC coaches. The Green Knights earned all nine possible first-place votes.

St. Norbert won the 2009-10 MWC championship with a 14-2 record and made it to the second round of the NCAA Division III Regional Tournament.

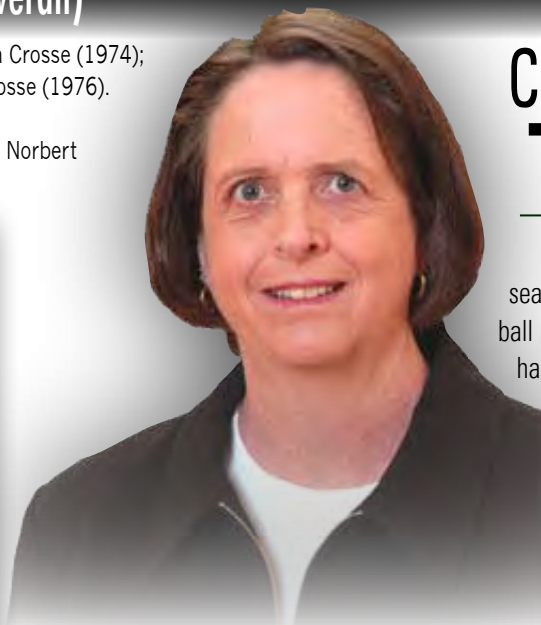

Connie TILLEY



Connie Tilley is in her 34th season at the helm of the women's basketball program at St. Norbert in 2010-11. But it hasn't been just basketball that has made Tilley one of the most successful coaches of women's sports in Division III athletics.

Tilley has previously coached men's golf, women's golf, volleyball and softball.

Her career record in all four sports combined is 874-456 for a .655 winning percentage and 19 conference titles. In 53 sports seasons, Tilley has had only five records below .500.

But it's basketball where she's made the biggest strides. In 2009, Tilley became the 15th coach in Division III history to achieve 500 career wins. Following the 2009-2010 season, Tilley has a 545-257 career record and has led St. Norbert to the Midwest Conference playoffs 20 times in 27 seasons in the league. Tilley is Wisconsin's all-time winningest NCAA collegiate women's basketball coach.

During the 2008-09 season, St. Norbert College named the playing court in Schuldes Sports Center as "Connie Tilley Court" in her honor.

The Green Knights won their record ninth Midwest Conference championship in 2010. Despite having just two seniors, St. Norbert finished 23-4 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament after defeating Calvin College in the first round.

Hired by then-athletics director Mel Nicks in 1977, Tilley has coached St. Norbert basketball to 13 conference titles, nine NCAA Tournament appearances and one Final Four. Four of her basketball teams have advanced to the Division III Sweet 16, most recently in 2003.

In addition, she coached the UW-La Crosse women's tennis team while completing graduate work there - and the team finished seventh in the nation.
