Week Overview

St. Norbert hits the road to face Lake Forest on Wednesday before coming home to host Carroll on Saturday.

The Series

St. Norbert leads the all-time series with Lake Forest 34-20. The Green Knights topped the Foresters 64-47 last Feb. 6 at Schuldes Sports Center. Denise Heuser and Emily Otzelberger each chipped in 14 points to lead St. Norbert.

St. Norbert leads the all-time series with Carroll 25-17. The Green Knights beat Carroll 76-61 last Feb. 20 in Waukesha. Denise Heuser had 13 points to lead five Green Knights in double figures.

The Coaches

St. Norbert head coach **Connie Tilley** 539-256 in her 34th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 868-454 at St. Norbert

Lake Forest head coach **Tamlyn Tills** is 166-231 in her 16th season overall, and is 30-24 in her third season in Lake Forest.

Carroll head coach **Kris Jacobsen** is 182-115 in her 13th season in Waukesha.

About the Green Knights

St. Norbert, ranked No. 25 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the week 8-1 overall and 4-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights swept a pair of games

at the D3hoops.com Classic in Las Vegas last week. Senior forward Rachel Hermus scored a career-high 26 points in her first action of the season, a 78-69 win over Bates last Tuesday.

Junior forward Jamie Kuhl added her second double-double of the season in a 50-45 win over Kenyon last Thursday. Kuhl finished with 15 points and 10 rebounds.

Kuhl leads St. Norbert averaging 11.7 points and 7.1 rebounds per game. Junior Krista Pelky is averaging 11.3 points a game.

The Green Knights are averaging 65.3 points while allowing 50.1 points per game.

St. Norbert is shooting 39.5 percent from the floor, including 36.6 percent on 3-pointers. Opponents are shooting 36.1 percent from the floor.

About the Foresters

Lake Forest enters Wednesday's matchup 3-4 overall and 1-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Foresters dropped a pair of games in the Hoop N Surf Classic in Honolulu on Dec. 19-20. The Foresters fell 73-67 to McMurry before losing 71-65 to Cal Lutheran.

Emily Weber leads eight Foresters averaging 5.0 points or more per game. Weber is averaging 9.6 points per contest. Aimee Lockwood is averaging 5.1 rebounds per game.

Lake Forest is averaging 69.0 points while allowing 61.6 points per game.

The Foresters are shooting 41.6 percent from the floor while holding opponents to 39.1 percent.

About the Pioneers

Carroll enters Saturday's matchup 7-2 overall and 3-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers last played on Dec. 14, a 68-64 win over MSOE. Carroll has won six of its last seven games.

Lyndsey Seewald is averaging 21.9 points per game for the Pioneers. Janelle Groer is chipping in 15.8 points per game.

The Pioneers are averaging 70.3 points while allowing 65.3 points per game.

Carroll is shooting 44.4 percent from the floor. Opponents are shooting 42.1 percent, including 35.1 percent on 3-pointers.

Happy Returns

St. Norbert senior forward Rachel Hermus returned from a knee injury suffered last season to score a career-high 26 points in a 78-69 win over Bates at the D3hoops.com Classic in Las Vegas on Dec. 28. Hermus finished 10-for-15 from the floor, and added six rebounds.

Senior forward Kristin Zimmerman also returned for her first action of the season in Las Vegas. Zimmerman finished with two points, three rebounds and three assists in the 78-69 win over Bates. Zimmerman also chipped in three points and four rebounds in the 50-45 win over Kenyon on Dec. 30.

Double it Up

St. Norbert junior forward Jamie Kuhl netted her third career double-double in a 50-45 win over Kenyon in the D3hoops.com Classic in Las Vegas on Dec. 30. Kuhl finished with 15 points and 10 rebounds.

St. Norbert in MWC Openers

St. Norbert is now 17-4 in its last 21 Midwest Conference openers. The Green Knights topped Grinnell 88-46 on Dec. 3 to open the 2010-11 MWC slate.

Schuldes Snippets

St. Norbert has won 43 of its last 45 games at Schuldes Sports Center, the last loss being a 71-58 defeat to UW-Stevens Point in the second round of the 2010 NCAA Division III Tournament.

The Green Knights are 89-16 in their last 105 games played at Schuldes Sports Center. St. Norbert has won its last 28 Midwest Conference regular-season home games.

St. Norbert owns a 272-76 record in homes games under Connie Tilley. The Green Knights have only had one losing record at home since 1977-78. St. Norbert went 3-7 at home during the 1995-96 season.

St. Norbert's current senior class has never lost a Midwest Conference home game.

Over the past six seasons, St. Norbert has compiled a 59-9 record in games played at Schuldes Sports Center. That includes a 39-4 record in the Midwest Conference.

State Conference Chatter

St. Norbert defeated UW-Oshkosh 50-42 in the championship game of the Baylake Bank Tip-Off Classic on Nov. 20. The win marks the eighth-straight year St. Norbert head coach Connie Tilley has won a game against a school from the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.

Since the start of the 2005-06 season, St. Norbert is a solid 11-6 against the WIAC, including having won eight of the last 11 games.

Winter Wonder

St. Norbert has won 15 consecutive games played in January and February. The Green Knights have won six-straight games in January and nine-straight games in February.

Since the 2007-08 season, The Green Knights are 43-6 in the months of January and February (21-5 in January and 22-1 in February).

Hot Shots

Since the start of the 2007-08 season, St. Norbert has shot a higher percentage from the floor than its opponents in 69 of 88 games. The Green Knights are 65-4 in those games.

Turning the Tide

St. Norbert has committed less turnovers than its opponents in 72 of the last 88 games, and astounding 81.8 percent of the time. The Green Knights have gone 64-8 in those games.

Defense Wins Championship

St. Norbert is 68-2 in its last 70 games when allowing 59 points or less, including having won 19 straight. All-time under Connie Tilley, the Green Knights are 360-41 in games when they have held opponents to 59 points or less.

The Sixties

Since St. Norbert head coach Connie Tilley took over during the 1977-78 season, the Green Knights have

scored 60 points or more in 606 of a possible 794 games. St. Norbert is an incredible 507-99 in those games which they reached the 60-point plateau.

St. Norbert is 140-16 since the 2002-03 season when scoring 60 points or more.

First to 70 is a Winner

St. Norbert is 122-3 in its last 125 games when scoring at least 70 points, including having won 50 straight. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 300-22 when scoring at least 70 points. The Green Knights were 12-0 when scoring at least 70 points last season.

Twenty Win Talk

St. Norbert has won 20 or more games in three consecutive seasons. Remarkably, throughout the rich history of the St. Norbert women's basketball program the Green Knights had never had three-straight 20-win seasons prior to the current streak.

St. Norbert has missed the NCAA Division III Tournament only once when winning at least 20 games, coming during the 2008-09 season during a 20-5 campaign. The Green Knights were 22-8 in 1980-81, but that was prior to the NCAA offering women's championships.

The Green Knights are one of only 25 teams in Division III to have won 20-or-more games the last three seasons.

D is for Defense

St. Norbert is allowing 50.1 points per game this season. The Green Knights ranked 12th in the Dec. 12 NCAA Division III statistical rankings with 48.1 points allowed per game.

St. Norbert has held five opponents to 49 point or less and have held two opponents to 40 point or less. The season-low

allowed of 33 points came against Monmouth on Dec. 4. The Green Knights also allowed 38 points to Knox on Dec. 11.

St. Norbert has not had a season where it has held opponents to under an average of 52 points per game since a 50.2 points per game mark in 1985-86.

Head of the Class

St. Norbert is 114-18 in Midwest Conference games since the 2002-03 season. That includes a 47-4 record in the MWC over the past three seasons.

Open it Up

St. Norbert is 5-0 in its last five season openers. The Green Knights have opened with the St. Norbert College Tip-Off Tournament the past four seasons. The Green Knights are 8-0 in the event.

As Predicted?

Prior to the 2010-11 season, St. Norbert was picked to win the Midwest Conference championship in a poll of MWC coaches. The Green Knights earned all nine possible first-place votes.

St. Norbert won the 2009-10 MWC championship with a 14-2 record and made it to the second round of the NCAA Division III Regional Tournament.

Tilley Named MWC Coach of the Year

At the conclusion of the 2009-10 season, St. Norbert head coach Connie Tilley was named Midwest Conference Coach of the Year. It was the fourth such honor for Tilley (2007-08, 2002-03, 1996-97).

Tilley led St. Norbert to a 14-2 record in the MWC, good for the ninth championship in school history and second in the last three seasons.

Connie TILLEY



Connie Tilley is in her 34th season at the helm of the women's basketball program at St. Norbert in 2010-11. But it hasn't been just basketball that has made Tilley one of the most successful coaches of women's sports in Division III athletics.

Tilley has previously coached men's golf, women's golf, volleyball and softball.

Her career record in all four sports combined is 869-455 for a .655 winning percentage and 19 conference titles. In 53 sports seasons, Tilley has had only five records below .500.

But it's basketball where she's made the biggest strides. In 2009, Tilley became the 15th coach in Division III history to achieve 500 career wins. Following the 2009-2010 season, Tilley has a 539-256 career record and has led St. Norbert to the Midwest Conference playoffs 20 times in 27 seasons in the league. Tilley is Wisconsin's all-time winningest NCAA collegiate women's basketball coach.

During the 2008-09 season, St. Norbert College named the playing court in Schuldes Sports Center as "Connie Tilley Court" in her honor.

The Green Knights won their record ninth Midwest Conference championship in 2010. Despite having just two seniors, St. Norbert finished 23-4 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament after defeating Calvin College in the first round.

Hired by then-athletics director Mel Nicks in 1977, Tilley has coached St. Norbert basketball to 13 conference titles, nine NCAA Tournament appearances and one Final Four. Four of her basketball teams have advanced to the Division III Sweet 16, most recently in 2003.

In addition, she coached the UW-La Crosse women's tennis team while completing graduate work there - and the team finished seventh in the nation.
