St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview MIDWEST CONFERENCE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT Fri., Feb. 25 - No. 16 St. Norbert (21-2) vs. Illinois College (13-10) - 6 p.m. Sat., Feb. 26 - Championship vs. Monmouth (15-8) or Carroll (15-8) - 3 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Tournament Overview:

The winner of the Midwest Conference Tournament will receive the league's automatic qualifier into the NCAA Division III Tournament.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Illinois College 22-6 in a series begun in the 1984-85 season. The Green Knights have won 17 of the last 18 games in the series, the lone blemish coming earlier this year in a 59-52 Lady Blues' win on Jan. 14 in Jacksonville, Ill.

St. Norbert leads Monmouth 22-5 in a series begun in the 1986-87 season. The Green Knights have won the last six games and 15 of the last 16 games in the series. The only Monmouth win in that stretch was a 70-59 decision on Jan. 25, 2008 in Monmouth, Ill.

St. Norbert leads Carroll 27-17 in a series begun in the 1982-83 season. St. Norbert has won eight consecutive games in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 552-257 in her 33rd season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 881-455 at St. Norbert.

Illinois College coach Brenna Kelly (Culver Stockton, 1985) is 300-255 in her 24th season in Jacksonville.

Monmouth coach Melissa Bittner (Monmouth, 2003) is 77-61 in her sixth season in Monmouth.

Carroll coach Kris Jacobsen (UW-Platteville, 1989) is 190-121 in her 13th season in Waukesha.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the tournament at 21-2 overall after winning its record 10th Midwest Conference championship with a 17-1 record. The Green Knights' 21 wins are the most regular-season triumphs in program history.

Senior forward Rachel Hermus leads the Green Knights in scoring at 11.8 points per game. Junior guard Krista Pelky is adding 11.3 points per game. Junior forward Jamie Kuhl is scoring 10.7 points per game while grabbing an average of 7.4 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 65.4 points per game. The Green Knights are - MORE -

shooting 40.4 percent from the floor, 34.3 percent on 3-pointers and 74.5 percent at the free-throw line. Foes are scoring an average of just 51.0 points per game against the Green Knights' defense. Opponents are shooting 36.0 percent from the floor including 29.0 percent on 3-pointers and 70.7 percent on free throws.

About the Lady Blues:

Illinois College enters the tournament with a 13-10 overall record and an 11-7 mark in the MWC. The Lady Blues finished in a tie for third place with Carroll and Lake Forest and edged out the Foresters for the final spot on a tiebreaker.

Senior center Rachel Macon leads Illinois College in scoring with an average of 18.5 points per game, and shoots a robust 58.8 percent from the floor. Senior guard Carrie Walberg is the only other Lady Blue to average double figures in scoring at 13.0 points per game. Walberg grabs 6.9 rebounds per game while Macon grabs 6.8.

Illinois College is scoring an average of 59.2 points per game and is shooting 42.6 percent from the floor, 27.3 percent on 3-pointers and 65.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 57.8 points per game while shooting 38.1 percent from the floor, 27.5 percent on 3-pointers and 73.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth finished the regular season 15-8 overall and 13-5 in the Midwest Conference to finish in second place. The Scots are making their first MWC Tournament appearance since 1998.

Junior guard Haley Jones leads the Scots in scoring at 11.7 points per game. Sophomore center Zipporah Williams nets 10.3 points per game while snaring 7.7 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Colleen Forrest is averaging 10.0 points per game and has made 45.1 percent (69-for-153) of her three-point field goal attempts.

Monmouth is averaging 65.5 points per game while shooting

42.0 percent from the floor, 36.6 percent on 3-pointers and 68.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 57.7 points per game while shooting 36.3 percent from the floor, 25.4 percent on 3-pointers and 70.5 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the tournament with a 15-8 overall record and an 11-7 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers beat Illinois College 74-63 this past Saturday to grab a spot in the league tournament.

Senior guard Lyndsey Seewald averaged 20.1 points per game, tops in the Midwest Conference. Seewald makes 46.2 percent of her field goals and 88.6 percent of her free throws. Junior forward Janelle Groer nets 16.2 points with 5.9 rebounds per game.

Carroll is scoring an average of 68.2 points per game while shooting 44.5 percent from the floor, 30.1 percent on 3-pointers and 70.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 63.9 points per game while shooting 44.4 percent from the floor, 31.4 percent on 3-pointers and 72.3 percent at the free-throw line.

Schuldes Snippets:

St. Norbert has won 49 of its last 51 games at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights are 11-0 at home this season and were 14-1 at home last year.

The lone two blemish came in the post-season. UW-Stevens Point beat St. Norbert 71-58 in a second-round NCAA Tournament game last year. Ripon topped the Green Knights 56-49 in the 2009 Midwest Conference Tournament championship to snap a 24-game overall home winning streak.

St. Norbert is 95-16 in its last 111 games played at Schuldes Sports Center, and has won its last 34 Midwest Conference regular-season home games. St. Norbert's current senior class never lost a regular-season Midwest Conference home game.

St. Norbert owns a 278-76 record in home games under Connie Tilley. The Green Knights have only had one losing record at home since 1977-78. St. Norbert went 3-7 at home during the 1995-96 season.

St. Norbert earned its fourth straight 20-win season with a 76-60 win over Carroll on Feb. 12. The current stretch is the only time in the history of the program the Green Knights have won 20 games for at least three straight years.

St. Norbert has missed the NCAA Division III Tournament only once when winning at least 20 games, coming in 2009 following a 20-5 campaign. The Green Knights were 22-8 in 1980-81, but that was prior to the NCAA offering women's championships.

St. Norbert is 86-16 over the last four years, its best four-year stretch ever.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert is allowing its opponents to score just 51.0 points per game this season.

In this week's NCAA Division III statistical rankings, Norbert had the 19th-best scoring defense out of 441 teams.

The Green Knights have allowed opponents to 49 points or less in 10 of their games this season, and have allowed 60 points or more just three times in 23 games.

The season-low allowed of 33 points came against Monmouth on Dec. 4.

St. Norbert had not had a season where it has held its opponents to

under an average of 52 points per game since 1986 until it allowed just 51.4 points en route to a 23-4 campaign a year ago.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is 125-3 in its last 128 games when scoring at least 70 points, including having won 53 straight. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 303-22 when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert is 6-0 this season when reaching 70 points.

* - St. Norbert has achieved at least 10 wins in Midwest Conference play for 13 straight years. It is the longest current streak with double-digit wins in MWC women's basketball. The last time St. Norbert didn't win at least 10 league games was 1997-98, when it posted a 7-6 mark.
