### St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview NCAA DIVISION III TOURNAMENT - CENTRAL REGIONAL

**Fri., Mar. 4 - No. 14 St. Norbert (23-2) at No. 3 UW-Stevens Point (25-2) - 7 p.m.**  
**Sat., Mar. 5 - vs. Simpson (21-6) or Concordia-Moorhead (21-6) - 7 p.m.**  
**Berg Gym (1,200) - Stevens Point, Wisconsin**

#### Tournament Overview:

Two teams ranked in the D3hoops.com Top 25 are included among the four teams playing at the Stevens Point Regional looking to advance into the sectional round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

#### The Series:

UW-Stevens Point leads St. Norbert 12-11 in the all-time series, which began in 1978-79. The Green Knights have won three of the last four meetings - a 70-48 win in De Pere on Dec. 2, 1997, a 61-49 win in Stevens Point on Nov. 30, 1998 and a 71-57 win over the Pointers in the NCAA Division III Tournament on March 7, 2008 at Berg Gym. Stevens Point topped St. Norbert 71-58 last March 6 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere in a NCAA Division III Tournament game.

Simpson leads St. Norbert 2-0 in the all-time series dating back to 1982-83. The Storm beat the Green Knights 81-78 on March 5, 1983 in a NCAA Division III Tournament game and 74-59 on Nov. 18, 2006 in the Rockford College Tip-Off Tournament.

Concordia leads St. Norbert 1-0 in the all-time series. The Cobbers beat the Green Knights 85-68 on Feb. 20, 1989 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 554-257 in her 34th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 883-454 at St. Norbert.

UW-Stevens Point coach Shirley Egner (UW-La Crosse, 1980) is 407-177 in her 22nd season in Stevens Point.

Simpson coach Brian Niemuth (Grand View, 1988) is 456-185 in his 24th season in Indianola.

Concordia coach Jessica Rahman (Concordia-Moorhead, 1988) is 153-61 in her eighth season in Moorhead.

#### NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its tenth NCAA Tournament appearance, and is 9-13 all-time in the tournament. The Green Knights placed fourth when they hosted the Final Four in De Pere in 1985, and also advanced to the Sweet 16

in 1986, 1988 and 2003.

UW-Stevens Point is making its eighth NCAA Tournament appearance. The Pointers are 19-6 in the tournament, winning national championships in 1987 and 2002 with a fourth-place finish in 2004.

Simpson is making its 11th NCAA Tournament appearance, including its seventh straight trip. The Storm is 8-10 all-time in the tournament

Concordia is making its 17th NCAA Tournament appearance, but only its third since 1996. The Cobbers are 20-16 all-time in the tournament, and won the national title in 1988 after losing the national championship game in 1987 to UW-Stevens Point.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert, ranked No. 14 in this week's D3hoops.com Top 25, enters the NCAA Division III Tournament at 23-2 overall after winning its record 10th Midwest Conference championship with a 17-1 record. The Green Knights' 23 wins are their most ever entering NCAA Tournament play and one short of the school record 24 set in 1985. St. Norbert, which has won 21 of its last 22 games, earned the Midwest Conference automatic qualifier with a 56-54 overtime win over Monmouth on Saturday at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere.

Junior guard Krista Pelky leads St. Norbert in scoring with 11.9 points per game. Pelky tied a St. Norbert record with seven three-point field goals in a 63-41 win over Illinois College on Feb. 25. Senior forward Rachel Hermus is netting 11.1 points per game, while junior forward Jamie Kuhl is scoring 10.5 points per game while grabbing a team-high 7.3 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is averaging 64.9 points per game. The Green Knights are shooting 40.4 percent from the floor, 34.0 percent on 3-pointers and 74.7 percent at the free-throw line. Foes are scoring an average of just 50.7 points per game against the Green Knights' defense. Opponents are shooting 36.1 percent from the floor including 27.6

percent on 3-pointers and 71.5 percent on free throws.

### About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the tournament ranked No. 3 in the D3hoops.com Top 25. The Pointers finished the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference schedule an unblemished 16-0 and are 25-2 overall. Stevens Point beat UW-Whitewater 73-53 on Sunday in the WIAC Tournament championship game.

Senior forward Britta Petersen leads the Pointers in scoring at 14.3 points per game and is shooting a lusty .576 from the floor while grabbing a team-high 5.4 rebounds per game. Junior forward Ashley Averkamp is netting 10.0 points per game and is shooting .546 from the floor. Seven different Pointers average at least 6.5 points per game.

Stevens Point is scoring an average of 74.1 points per game and is shooting 46.9 percent from the floor (third-best in Division III), 36.3 percent on 3-pointers and 66.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 56.5 points per game while shooting 38.3 percent from the floor, 29.3 percent on 3-pointers and 71.0 percent at the free-throw line.

### About the Storm:

Simpson enters the NCAA Tournament with a 21-6 overall record. The Storm tied for the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference regular-season title with Coe at 14-2, but lost the IIAC Tournament title game at Coe 59-56 last Saturday.

Junior center Stacey Schutjer, who stands 6-foot-2, is the only Simpson player to score in double figures at 12.9 points per game. Schutjer shoots 58.1 percent from the floor while averaging 6.3 rebounds per contest. Senior guard Amy Hamilton averages 9.9 points per game. Seven different Simpson players are scoring at least 6.1 points per game or better.

Simpson is averaging 82.2 points per game while shooting 44.7 percent from the floor, 36.3 percent on

3-pointers and 73.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 62.2 points per game while shooting 37.0 percent from the floor, 31.7 percent on 3-pointers and 68.2 percent at the free-throw line.

#### About the Cobbers:

Concordia enters the NCAA Tournament with a 21-6 overall record. The Cobbers finished second in the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference with a 17-5 record but beat St. Thomas 71-61 in the MIAC Tournament title game this past Saturday.

Senior guard Erica Nord leads Concordia in scoring at 13.7 points per game. Senior guard Maggie Bauernfeind is scoring 12.1 points per game and is shooting 81.4 percent at the free-throw line. Seven Cobbers average 6.8 points per game or better.

Concordia is scoring an average of 68.9 points per game while shooting 41.8 percent from the floor, 35.6 percent on 3-pointers and 70.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring 58.0 points per game while shooting 36.3 percent from the floor, 30.1 percent on 3-pointers and 70.0 percent at the free-throw line.

#### Twenty Talk:

St. Norbert earned its fourth straight 20-win season with a 76-60 win over Carroll on Feb. 12. The current stretch is the only time in the history of the program the Green Knights have won 20 games for at least three straight years.

St. Norbert has missed the NCAA Division III Tournament only once when winning at least 20 games, coming in 2009 following a 20-5 campaign. The Green Knights were 22-8 in 1980-81, but that was prior to the NCAA offering women's championships.

St. Norbert is 88-16 over the last four years, its best four-year stretch ever.

#### D is for Defense:

St. Norbert is allowing its opponents to score just 50.7 points per game this season.

In this week's NCAA Division III national statistical rankings, St. Norbert had the 16th-best scoring defense out of 441 teams.

The Green Knights have allowed opponents to 49 points or less in 11 of their games this season, and have allowed 60 points or more just three times in 25 games.

The season-low allowed of 33 points

came against Monmouth on Dec. 4.

St. Norbert had not had a season where it has held its opponents to under an average of 52 points per game since 1986 until it allowed just 51.4 points per game en route to a 23-4 campaign a year ago.

#### Jump Shots:

\* - St. Norbert is 125-3 in its last 128 games when scoring at least 70 points, including having won 53 straight. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 303-22 when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert is 6-0 this season when reaching 70 points.

\* - St. Norbert has achieved at least 10 wins in Midwest Conference play for 13 straight years. It is the longest current streak with double-digit wins in MWC women's basketball. The last time St. Norbert didn't win at least 10 league games was 1997-98, when it posted a 7-6 mark.

\* - St. Norbert has won at least one NCAA Tournament game in six of its nine prior post-season appearances. The Green Knights reached the Final Four in 1985 and also advanced to the Sweet 16 in 1986, 1988 and 2003.
