St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview
St. Norbert College (23-3 in 2011) at Carthage College (17-9 in 2011)
Tuesday, November 15, 2011 - 7:30 p.m.
Tarble Arena (2,385) - Kenosha, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert College opens the 2011-12 season when it travels to the southeastern corner of Wisconsin to face College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin favorite Carthage College in Kenosha.

The Series:

Carthage leads St. Norbert 3-0 in the all-time series dating back to the 1978-79 season. The Lady Reds topped the Green Knights in the last meeting by a 71-56 score on Feb. 14, 1981 at the Phoenix Sports Center in Green Bay at the UW-Green Bay Tournament.

Carthage is one of two NCAA Division III schools in Wisconsin that venerable St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley has not beaten during her 35-year tenure. The Green Knights have never defeated or faced Alverno College.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 554-258 entering her 35th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 883-455 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 554 wins ranks her 13th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history.

Carthage coach Tim Bernero (Lake Forest, 1987) is 130-80 entering his ninth season in Kenosha.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the 2011-12 season after finishing the 2010-11 campaign at 23-3 overall after winning its record 10th Midwest Conference championship with a 17-1 record. The Green Knights' 23 wins were their most ever in the regular season and one short of the school record 24 set in 1985. St. Norbert had won 21 of 22 games before falling to UW-Stevens Point 79-69 in the first-round of the NCAA Division III Tournament.

The Green Knights return two starters from last year's squad. Senior guard Krista Pelky led St. Norbert in scoring a year ago with 12.0 points per - MORE -

game. Senior forward Jamie Kuhl averaged 10.6 points per game while grabbing a team-high 7.0 rebounds per game a year ago. Pelky was a first-team All-Midwest Conference honoree last season, while Kuhl was a second-team All-MWC choice.

St. Norbert is averaged 65.1 points per game. The Green Knights shot 40.8 percent from the floor, 34.3 percent on 3-pointers and 75.0 percent at the free-throw line. Foes scored an average of just 51.8 points per game against the Green Knights' defense. Opponents shot 36.9 percent from the floor including 28.0 percent on 3-pointers and 71.4 percent on free throws.

About the Lady Reds:

Carthage finished 17-9 last season en route to an 8-6 mark in the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin, good for fourth place. The Lady Reds picked up four first-place votes and 45 points to narrowly edge perennial national power Illinois Wesleyan by one point for the top spot in the CCIW pre-season coaches' poll. The Lady Reds lost an exhibition game 64-38 at Marquette on Nov. 5.

Carthage returns three starters from last year's squad. Senior center Diana Jacklin scored 12.5 points with 6.6 rebounds a year ago en route to second-team All-CCIW honors. Jacklin was a first-team All-CCIW choice as a sophomore. Junior forward Cailee Corcoran netted 10.2 points per game last season, while senior guard Dani Ripkey averaged 8.1 points per game a year ago.

Carthage scored an average of 66.5 points per game last season and shot 44.6 percent from the floor, 34.3 percent on 3-pointers and 68.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents scored 56.7 points per game while shooting 36.7 percent from the floor, 29.8 percent on 3-pointers and 72.9 percent at the free-throw line.

Twenty Talk:

St. Norbert earned its fourth straight 20-win season a year ago.

The current stretch is the only time in the history of the program the Green Knights have won 20 games for at least three straight years.

St. Norbert has missed the NCAA Division III Tournament only once when winning at least 20 games, coming in 2009 following a 20-5 campaign. The Green Knights were 22-8 in 1980-81, but that was prior to the NCAA offering women's championships.

St. Norbert is 88-17 over the last four years, its best four-year stretch

Pre-Season Prognostications:

St. Norbert was tabbed to win its fourth Midwest Conference title in five years when it received the No. 1 spot in the league's pre-season Coaches' Poll.

The Green Knights received eight first-place votes to total 80 points. The total easily outdistanced last year's runner-up Monmouth, which had one-first place vote and 68 points.

Lake Forest was the choice for third place with 62 points, while Carroll was slotted fourth with 55 points. Ripon, which received one first-place vote, finished fifth in the balloting with 51 points.

Illinois College was picked for sixth with 42 points, Grinnell seventh with 40 points, Beloit eighth with 24 points, Knox ninth with 19 points and Lawrence tenth with nine points.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is 125-3 in its last 128 games when scoring at least 70 points, including having won 53 straight. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 303-22 when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert was 6-0 last season when reaching 70 points.

* - St. Norbert has achieved at least 10 wins in Midwest Conference play for 13 straight years. It is the longest current streak with double-digit wins in MWC women's basketball. The last time St. Norbert didn't win at least 10 league games was 1997-98, when it posted a 7-6 mark.
