St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (8-3, 6-0) vs. Ripon College (4-6, 3-2) Tuesday, January 10, 2012 - 5:30 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert returns to Schuldes Sports Center and tries to remain unbeaten in the Midwest Conference when it hosts Ripon. The Red Hawks are two games behind the Green Knights in the conference standings.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Ripon 52-26 in a series started during the 1975-76 season. The Green Knights have won the last four meetings as well as 12 of the last 14 games in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert beat Ripon 57-39 last Jan. 29 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Green Knights slowly pulled away in the second half behind Jamie Kuhl's 17 points and Rachel Hermus' 13 points and 13 rebounds. Kacie Cullen led the Red Hawks with 12 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 562-261 in her 35th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 891-458 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 562 wins ranks her 13th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history.

Ripon coach Julie Johnson (Dakota State, 1988) is 285-219 in her 22nd season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game with an 8-3 record and a perfect 6-0 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights are coming off a 69-58 win over Carroll on Saturday, their 38th win in their last 39 games against Midwest Conference foes.

Senior guard Krista Pelky leads St. Norbert in scoring at 17.3 points per game, and is shooting 93.1 percent (54-for-58) at the free-throw line. Senior forward Jamie Kuhl is averaging 11.1 points per game, while junior guard Krista Hawkinson is netting 10.7 points per game. Freshman forward Tasha Giese is scoring 10.2 points per game while leading the Green Knights with 7.6 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 65.7 points per game, and is shooting 40.6 percent from the floor, 33.1 percent on 3-pointers and 74.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 56.4 points per game while shooting 36.3 percent from the floor, 28.4 percent on 3-pointers and 66.3 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game with a 4-6 overall record and a 3-2 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks have won their last two games since a 2-6 start. Ripon topped Oglethorpe 65-42 on Dec. 30, and then topped Illinois College 75-70 in overtime on the road last Wednesday.

Junior forward Erin Lind leads the Red Hawks in scoring at 14.5 points per game and also has a team-high 7.8 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Katie Raymond nets 11.3 points per game, while sophomore guard Jill Van Eperen is scoring 10.5 points per game while shooting nearly 58 percent from the floor and almost 82 percent at the free-throw line.

Ripon is averaging 60.6 points per game while shooting 41.2 percent from the floor, 26.9 percent on 3-pointers and 69.2 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 61.4 points per game while shooting 39.6 percent from the floor, 28.0 percent on 3-pointers and 71.6 percent at the free-throw line.

Pelky Patter:

Senior guard Krista Pelky remained atop the Midwest Conference scoring leaders following a 13-point, six-rebound, six-assist outing on Saturday against Carroll. Pelky has scored 119 points in her last seven games, working out to an average of 17 points per game.

Pelky is leading the Midwest Conference in scoring at 17.3 points per game. She is shooting 39.0 percent (57-for-146) from the floor but is a robust 48.9 percent (22-for-45) from beyond the three-point arc. Pelky is also 54-for-58 (93.1 percent)

at the free-throw line.

Pelky needs 67 points to reach the 1,000-point mark for her career and become the 14th player in school history to reach that scoring plateau.

Winning Tradition:

St. Norbert earned its fourth straight 20-win season last year after finishing the year 23-3 along with its third Midwest Conference title in four years. The stretch is the only time in the history of the program the Green Knights have won 20 games for at least three straight years.

St. Norbert went 88-16 over the last four seasons, its best four-year stretch ever. Including this season, the Green Knights own an impressive 96-19 record since the start of the 2007-08 season.

The Green Knights have advanced to the NCAA Division III Tournament a Midwest Conference-record 10 times, and have won at least one game in six of those appearances.

Jump Shots:

- * Sophomore guard Sara Van Hemelryk's 11 points Saturday against Carroll was a career-high total.
- * St. Norbert has won 38 of its last 39 games against Midwest Conference opponents. The Green Knights' lone loss in that stretch was a 59-52 loss at Illinois College last Jan. 14.
- * St. Norbert is 128-3 in its last 131 games when scoring at least 70 points, including having won 55 straight. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 306-22 when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert was 6-0 last season when reaching 70 points and is 3-0 this season.
- * St. Norbert has achieved at least 10 wins in Midwest Conference play for 13 straight years. It is the longest current streak with double-digit wins in MWC women's basketball. The last time St. Norbert didn't win at least 10 league games was 1997-98, when it posted a 7-6 mark.
