St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (9-3, 7-0) vs. Illinois College (3-8, 3-3) Fri., Jan. 13 - Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wis. - 5 p.m. St. Norbert College (9-3, 7-0) vs. Knox College (1-11, 1-6) Sat., Jan. 14 - Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wis. - 2 p.m.

Weekend Overview:

St. Norbert looks to remain unbeaten in the Midwest Conference when it hosts Illinois College and Knox this weekend at Schuldes Sports Center.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Illinois College 23-6 in a series begun in the 1984-85 season. The Green Knights have won 18 of the last 19 games in the series, the lone blemish coming last season in a 59-52 Lady Blues' win in Jacksonville, Ill.

St. Norbert leads Knox 28-0 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The amount of wins is tied for fifth-most in a series for St. Norbert, trailing Lawrence (60), Ripon (53), Beloit (47), Lake Forest (37) and is tied with Carroll at 28.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert topped Illinois College 63-41 last Feb. 25 in a Midwest Conference Tournament semifinal game at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights' Krista Pelky tied a school record with seven three-point field goals en route to a 21-point night. Jamie Kuhl added 10 points for St. Norbert.

St. Norbert defeated Knox 90-75 on Dec. 10 at Memorial Gym in Galesburg, Ill. St. Norbert trailed 66-57 with 9:47 remaining before closing the game on a 33-9 run. Jamie Kuhl and Tasha Giese each had 23 points for St. Norbert, while Krista Pelky added 17 points. Becky Duffy's 15 points led Knox.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 563-261 in her 35th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 892-458 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 563 wins ranks her 13th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history.

Illinois College coach Brenna Kelly (Culver Stockton, 1985) is 303-264 in her 25th season in Jacksonville.

Entering Friday's game at Beloit, Knox coach Emily Cline (Cornell College, 2001) is 23-58 in her fourth season in Galesburg.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads into the weekend with a 9-3 overall record and a 7-0 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, who have won 39 of their last 40 games against Midwest Conference foes, are coming off a 56-45 win over Ripon on Tuesday.

Senior guard Krista Pelky, now 51 points shy of 1,000 for her career, leads the Green Knights in scoring at 17.2 points per game. Junior guard Krista Hawkinson is netting an average of 11.2 points per game, while senior forward Jamie Kuhl is scoring 11.1 points per game. Freshman forward Tasha Giese is grabbing a team-high 7.7 rebounds per game while scoring 9.7 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 64.9 points per game, and is shooting 41.2 percent from the floor, 33.1 percent on 3-pointers and 74.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 55.4 points per game while shooting 36.5 percent from the floor, 29.0 percent on 3-pointers and 66.3 percent at the charity stripe.

About the Lady Blues:

Illinois College enters the game with a 3-8 overall record and a 3-3 ledger in the Midwest Conference. The Lady Blues, who have lost five of their last six games, lost 59-51 at Grinnell on Tuesday. Illinois College's last win came 76-70 last Saturday at Lake Forest.

Sophomore forward Holly Wohltman leads Illinois College in scoring at 12.3 points per game, and is shooting 53.6 percent from the floor. Sophomore forward Brittney Burgess is netting 11.7 points per game, while freshman guard Morgan Brinker is scoring 10.8 points per game.

Illinois College is averaging 63.2 points per game while shooting 37.8 percent from the floor, 32.3 percent on 3-pointers and 74.6 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 65.4 points per game while shooting 38.7 percent from the floor, 33.1 percent on 3-pointers and 73.0 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Prairie Fire:

Knox enters Friday's game at Beloit with a 1-11 overall record and a 1-6 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Prairie Fire entered the weekend in the midst of a seven-game losing streak following a heartbreaking 93-89 home loss to Lake Forest on Tuesday.

The Prairie Fire, which has adopted Grinnell's famed offensive "system" this season, is led in scoring by senior forward Krystyna Williams' 11.2 points and has 7.6 rebounds per game. Senior forward Kelly Ricketts is scoring 8.9 points per game with 4.5 rebounds per game. Senior guard Steph Nunez is averaging 7.3 points per game and has made a team-high 21 three-point field goals this season.

Knox is averaging 78.1 points per game while shooting 31.7 percent from the floor, 21.5 percent on 3pointers and 63.7 percent on free throws. Knox has attempted 465 3pointers in 12 games, an average of 38.8 per game. Opponents are scoring 92.0 points per game while shooting 48.0 percent from the floor, 30.3 percent on 3-pointers and 69.4 percent at the free-throw line.

Winning Tradition:

St. Norbert earned its fourth straight 20-win season last year after finishing the year 23-3 along with its third Midwest Conference title in four years. The stretch is the only time in the history of the program the Green Knights have won 20 games for at least three straight years.

St. Norbert went 88-16 over the last four seasons, its best four-year stretch ever. Including this season, the Green Knights own an impressive 97-19 record since the start of the 2007-08 season.

The Green Knights have advanced to the NCAA Division III Tournament a Midwest Conference-record 10 times, and have won at least one game in six of those appearances.
