St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (6-2, 4-0) vs. Lake Forest College (4-3, 3-0) Saturday, December 17, 2011 - 1 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert plays its last Midwest Conference game before the holiday break when it hosts Lake Forest in a key league matchup Saturday at Schuldes Sports Center.

#### **Broadcast:**

The game will be broadcast live on WACY-TV 32 with Ted Stefaniak and Dean Leisgang on the call. WACY is available to Time Warner Cable customers in Northeast Wisconsin on Channel 13.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lake Forest 36-20 in a hotly contested series begun in the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights have won seven of the last eight games in the series, and have also won eight of the last nine games played in De Pere.

#### **Last Meeting:**

St. Norbert beat Lake Forest 66-59 last Jan. 21 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. Four Green Knights registered double figures in scoring, led by Erin Baganz's 18 points. Tabytha Harvey led the Foresters with 24 points, 20 of those coming in the second half.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 560-260 in her 35th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 889-457 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 558 wins ranks her 13th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history.

Lake Forest coach Tamlyn Tills (UW-La Crosse, 1982) is 44-33 in her fourth season in Lake Forest. Including stops at Concordia-Chicago, Loras and Concordia-Chicago, Tills is 181-240 in 17 years of collegiate coaching.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the game with a 6-2 overall record and an unblemished 4-0 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights have been off for final exams since last Saturday, when it topped Knox on the road 90-75.

scoring at 18.8 points per game, and has made 56.3 percent of her three-point field goal attempts this season. Senior forward Jamie Kuhl, who was named this week's Midwest Conference Player of the Week, is averaging 11.4 points and 6.6 rebounds per game. Freshman forward Tasha Giese is averaging 9.8 points and a team-high 7.5 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 66.2 points per game, and is shooting 40.1 percent from the floor, 33.0 percent on 3-pointers and 78.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 55.5 points per game while shooting 34.2 percent from the floor, 27.6 percent on 3-pointers and 65.1 percent at the charity stripe.

#### **About the Foresters:**

Lake Forest enters the game with a 4-3 overall record and a 3-0 ledger in the Midwest Conference. The Foresters have been idle since Dec. 6, when they lost on the road at North Central (Ill.) 66-55. This game is Lake Forest's first road conference game of the season.

Junior guard Sam Schuring leads the Foresters in scoring at 13.6 points per game. Sophomore guard Gina Ambrose is averaging 9.3 points and 3.9 rebounds per game. Junior forward Liz Radtke is scoring 9.1 points per game while shooting 47.8 percent from the floor, and is also grabbing 4.7 rebounds per game.

Lake Forest is averaging 65.3 points per game while shooting 38.7 percent from the floor, 27.1 percent on 3-pointers and 76.0 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 57.7 points per game while shooting 36.9 percent from the floor, 22.9 percent on 3-pointers and 69.4 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **Pelky Patter:**

Senior guard Krista Pelky continued her hold on the Midwest Conference scoring lead with a 17-point performance at Knox last Saturday. Pelky has scored 79 points in her last four games, working out to an average of 19.8 points per game.

Pelky is leading the Midwest Conference in scoring at 18.8 points per game. She is shooting 42.6 percent (43-for-101) from the floor but is a robust 56.3 percent (18-for-32) from beyond the three-point arc. Pelky is also 46-for-50 (92.0 percent) at the free-throw line.

Pelky needs 107 points to reach the 1,000-point mark for her career and become the 14th player in school history to reach that scoring plateau.

#### **Schuldes Snippets:**

St. Norbert has won 54 of its last 57 games at Schuldes Sports Center. St. Norbert had won its last 45 regular-season home games until the Green Knights lost 49-44 to UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 22.

The other two blemishes came in the post-season. UW-Stevens Point beat St. Norbert 71-58 in a second-round NCAA Tournament game in 2010. Ripon topped the Green Knights 56-49 in the 2009 Midwest Conference Tournament championship to snap a 24-game overall home winning streak.

St. Norbert is 100-17 in its last 117 games played at Schuldes Sports Center, and still owns a 35-game Midwest Conference regular-season home winning streak.

St. Norbert owns a 283-77 record in home games under Connie Tilley. The Green Knights have only had one losing record at home since 1977-78. St. Norbert went 3-7 at home during the 1995-96 season.

#### **Jump Shots:**

\* - St. Norbert is 128-3 in its last 131 games when scoring at least 70 points, including having won 55 straight. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 306-22 when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert was 6-0 last season when reaching 70 points and is 3-0 this season.

\* - St. Norbert has achieved at least 10 wins in Midwest Conference play for 13 straight years. It is the longest current streak with double-digit wins in MWC women's basketball. The last time St. Norbert didn't win at least 10 league games was 1997-98, when it posted a 7-6 mark.
