St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview

St. Norbert College (11-4, 8-2) vs. No. 19 Cornell College (15-0, 10-0)

Saturday, January 19, 2013 - 3 p.m.
 Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert hosts nationally ranked Cornell in an important Midwest Conference game. The Green Knights trail Cornell by two games in the league standings with eight games remaining.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Cornell 11-1 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights topped the Rams in the Midwest Conference championship game in 1984, 1986, 1987 and 1988.

Last Meeting:

Cornell beat St. Norbert 63-42 for its first win in the series on Dec. 1 in Mount Vernon, Iowa. The Green Knights led by as many as 10 points in the first half before the Rams charged back for the win. Rikki Mulloy led the Rams with 17 points, while Taylor Dicus and Kellie Kuzmanic added 15 points. Lauren Carman was the only St. Norbert player to reach double figures with 10 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 584-267 in her 36th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 914-463 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 584 wins ranks her 13th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years) and Tennessee's Pat Summitt (38 years) have spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Cornell coach Brent Brase (Cornell College, 1990) is 70-118 in his eighth season in Mount Vernon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert comes into the game 11-4 overall and 8-2 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights are coming off a 60-59 win over Beloit on Wednesday, with sophomore forward Tasha Giese's two free throws with 5.7 seconds remaining proving the difference.

Senior guard Krista Hawkinson leads the Green Knights in scoring at 11.6 points per game. Giese is averaging 9.4 points per game and is grabbing a team-high 7.4 rebounds per game. Freshman guard Megan Doody is averaging 8.1 points per game and has made a team-high 21 three-point field goals this season. Junior forward Morgan Heim is averaging 7.1 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 57.7 points per game, and is shooting 36.6 percent from the floor, 26.7 percent on 3-pointers and 72.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 50.0 points per game while shooting 36.9 percent from the floor, 25.0 percent on 3-pointers and 67.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Rams:

Cornell enters the game enjoying a banner season at 15-0 overall and 9-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Rams, ranked No. 19 in this week's D3hoops.com Top 25, picked up a key win on Wednesday at home with a 71-53 triumph over Monmouth.

Sophomore guard Rikki Mulloy leads the Rams in scoring at 13.6 points per game, and has canned 39 percent (30-for-77) of her three-point field goal attempts. Sophomore center Taylor Dicus is averaging 13.1 points per game and 8.3 rebounds per game while shooting 62.7 percent from the floor. Senior center Camille Marie is averaging 10.8 points and 6.6 rebounds per game.

Cornell is averaging 70.8 points per game while shooting 45.3 percent from the floor, 35.7 percent on 3-pointers and 72.9 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 52.3 points per game while shooting

31.8 percent from the floor, 26.3 percent on 3-pointers and 67.7 percent at the free-throw line.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert has held the lead in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense for most of the season, holding its 15 opponents this season to an average of 50.0 points per game. The Green Knights are just ahead of Cornell's 52.3 points allowed per game.

St. Norbert held Monmouth to 22 points under its scoring average of 76.9 points per game in a 65-55 win over the Scots on Jan. 5 at Schuldes Sports Center.

The Green Knights have led the MWC in scoring defense in each of the last five seasons, including a low of 51.4 points per game during the 23-4 season of 2009-10. St. Norbert advanced to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament that season.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is 10-0 this season when scoring at least 57 points. The Green Knights are 1-4 this season when held below that total, picking up their lone win in that category in a 49-46 win over Carthage in the championship game of the Baylake Bank Tip-Off Tournament on Nov. 17.

* - St. Norbert is 136-4 in its last 140 games when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth last Feb. 3. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 314-23 when scoring at least 70 points.

* - St. Norbert owns an impressive 118-26 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in each of the last five seasons, with four years with at least 20 wins. It is the best five-year mark in school history.

* - St. Norbert is averaging just 15.7 turnovers per game, which is the best mark in the Midwest Conference. Carroll is second at 18.7 turnovers per game.
