St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview MIDWEST CONFERENCE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT Fri., Feb. 22 - St. Norbert (15-8) vs. Monmouth (19-4) - 7 p.m. Sat., Feb. 23 - Championship vs. No. 14 Cornell (22-1) or Carroll (13-8) - 3 p.m. Small Multi-Sport Center (2,500) - Mount Vernon, Iowa

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert makes its 11th consecutive Midwest Conference Tournament appearance when it travels to the Hawkeye State and Cornell College for the tournament. The Green Knights are competing with Cornell, Monmouth and Carroll for this year's automatic berth into the NCAA Division III Tournament.

The Series:

- St. Norbert leads Monmouth 25-6 in a series begun in the 1986-87 season. The Green Knights have won 18 of the last 20 games in the series.
- St. Norbert leads Cornell 12-1 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights topped the Rams in the Midwest Conference championship game in 1984, 1986, 1987 and 1988.
- St. Norbert leads Carroll 30-19 in an all-time series dating back to the 1982-83 season. The Green Knights have won 11 of the last 13 meetings over the past six seasons.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 588-271 in her 36th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 917-467 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 588 wins ranks her 13th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years) and Tennessee's Pat Summitt (38 years) have spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Monmouth coach Melissa Bittner (Monmouth, 2003) is 113-76 in her eighth season in Monmouth.

Cornell coach Brent Brase (Cornell College, 1990) is 77-119 in his eighth season in Mount Vernon.

Carroll coach Kris Jacobsen (UW-Platteville, 1989) is 216-142 in her 15th season in Waukesha.

tied for third place in the Midwest Conference at 12-6. The Green Knights are 3-4 in their last seven games, and are coming off a 62-57 loss at Illinois College this past Saturday.

Senior guard Krista Hawkinson leads the Green Knights at 11.2 points per game. Sophomore forward Tasha Giese is shooting 54.3 percent from the floor to average 9.5 points per game, and also has a team-high average of 7.0 rebounds per game. Junior forward Morgan Heim and freshman guard Megan Doody are both averaging 7.4 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 57.0 points per game, and is shooting 37.5 percent from the floor, 24.8 percent on 3-pointers and 66.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 50.3 points per game while shooting 36.1 percent from the floor, 23.5 percent on 3-pointers and 69.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Scots:

Monmouth enters the tournament at 19-4 overall and finished in second place in the Midwest Conference at 14-4. The Scots, who lost their only meeting with St. Norbert this season 65-55 on Jan. 5, have won seven of their last eight games after routing Lake Forest 97-62 this past Saturday.

Senior forward Zipporah Williams leads the Scots with 13.1 points and 8.9 rebounds per game. Junior forward Marla Willard is averaging 12.9 points per game while grabbing a team-high 9.7 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Paige Nord is averaging 11.0 points per game.

Monmouth is averaging 75.6 points per game while shooting 44.3 percent from the floor, 36.5 percent on 3-pointers and 68.4 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 62.7 points per game while shooting 35.1 percent from the floor, 27.0 percent on 3-pointers and 68.6 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Rams:

Cornell enters the tournament 22-1 overall after winning the Midwest

Conference with a 17-1 record. The Rams, ranked No. 14 in the D3hoops.com Top 25, suffered their only loss on Jan. 19 when it fell at St. Norbert 47-44.

Senior center Camille Marie leads the Rams in scoring at 13.5 points per game and also averages 6.3 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Rikki Mulloy is averaging 13.3 points per game. Sophomore center Taylor Dicus is averaging 12.3 points and 8.8 rebounds per game, and is shooting 63.4 percent from the floor.

Cornell is scoring an average of 73.1 points per game, and is shooting 46.6 percent from the floor, 35.7 percent on 3-pointers and 74.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 53.2 points per game while shooting 33.2 percent from the floor, 26.1 percent on 3-pointers and 67.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the tournament 13-8 overall after finishing in a third-place tie with St. Norbert at 12-6 in the Midwest Conference standings. The Pioneers have won their last four games, including an 85-70 win over Knox this past Saturday.

Junior guard Emily DeNoyer leads Carroll in scoring at 12.0 points per game. Senior forward Hilary Arthur is averaging 10.6 points per game. Freshman guard Malory Christenson is averaging 9.4 points per game, while senior guard Kelly Menden is averaging 9.0 points per game.

Carroll is scoring an average of 65.5 points per game, and is shooting 39.6 percent from the floor, 31.9 percent on 3-pointers and 69.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.2 points per game while shooting 42.3 percent from the floor, 29.8 percent on 3-pointers and 68.3 percent at the free-throw line.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert has held the lead in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense for most of the season, holding its 23 opponents this season to an average of 50.3 points per

St. Norbert held Monmouth to 22 points under its scoring average of 76.9 points per game in a 65-55 win over the Scots on Jan. 5 at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights held No. 19 Cornell to 27 points under its scoring average in a 47-44 win on Jan. 19.

The Green Knights have led the MWC in scoring defense in each of the last five seasons, including a low of 51.4 points per game during the 23-4 season of 2009-10. St. Norbert

advanced to the second round of the NCAA Division III Tournament that season.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is 12-2 this season when scoring at least 57 points. The Green Knights are 3-6 this season when held below that total, with all three of those wins coming at home. St. Norbert claimed a 49-46 win over No. 20 Carthage in the championship game Baylake Bank Tip-Off the Tournament on Nov. 17 and a 47-44 win over No. 19 Cornell on Jan. 19. St.

Norbert also topped Ripon 46-31 on Feb. 12.

* - St. Norbert is 137-4 in its last 141 games when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth last Feb. 3. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 315-23 when scoring at least 70 points.

* - St. Norbert owns an impressive 122-30 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in each of the last five seasons, with four years with at least 20 wins. It is the best fiveyear mark in school history.
