St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview MIDWEST CONFERENCE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT Fri., Feb. 28 - St. Norbert (19-4) vs. Carroll (15-8) - 8 p.m. Sat., March 1 - Championship vs. Cornell (20-3) or Monmouth (18-5) - 6 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

#### **Tournament Overview:**

The winner of the Midwest Conference Tournament will receive the league's automatic qualifier into the NCAA Division III Tournament. This is the ninth time in the last 15 seasons St. Norbert has hosted the tournament.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads Carroll 32-19 in an all-time series dating back to the 1982-83 season. The Green Knights have won 13 of the last 15 meetings over the past six-plus seasons.

St. Norbert leads Cornell 13-2 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights topped the Rams in the Midwest Conference championship game in 1984, 1986, 1987 and 1988.

St. Norbert leads Monmouth 25-8 in a series begun in the 1986-87 season. The Green Knights have won 18 of the last 22 games in the series.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 607-276 in her 37th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 936-472 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 607 wins ranks her 12th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years) and Tennessee's Pat Summitt (38 years) have spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Carroll coach Kris Jacobsen (UW-Platteville, 1989) is 231-151 in her 16th season in Waukesha.

Cornell coach Brent Brase (Cornell College, 1990) is 100-123 in his ninth season in Mount Vernon.

Monmouth coach Melissa Bittner (Monmouth, 2003) is 131-82 in her ninth season in Monmouth.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the game 19-4 overall and captured a share of its record 12th Midwest Conference title at 16-2 after a thrilling 75-72 double-over-- MORE -

Sophomore center Heidi Van Sistine moved into the team scoring lead after a 23-point performance against Illinois College. Van Sistine is averaging 11.1 points and 5.7 rebounds per game, both team highs. Van Sistine is shooting 74.7 percent (109-for-146) from the floor. Freshman guard Brianna Byrne is averaging 10.7 points per game. Senior guard Morgan Heim is netting 9.3 points per game, while senior guard Lana Tomashek is netting 8.9 points per game. Junior forward Tasha Giese has totaled averages of 7.9 points and 5.0 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 70.0 points per game, and is shooting 48.5 percent from the floor, 30.6 percent on 3-pointers and 66.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 50.8 points per game while shooting 35.6 percent from the floor, 24.5 percent on 3-pointers and 68.7 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **About the Pioneers:**

Carroll enters the tournament 15-8 overall and finished in fourth place in the Midwest Conference at 12-6. The Pioneers have won five of their last seven games, their only losses in that stretch coming in a 92-90 double-overtime loss to Cornell on Feb. 8 and a 62-58 setback to St. Norbert three days later.

Senior guard Emily DeNoyer leads Carroll in scoring at 14.8 points per game. Sophomore center Breann Maryanski is netting 11.5 points per game while grabbing 7.7 rebounds per game. Sophomore forward Malory Christenson is averaging 11.2 points per game, while junior guard Corrine Engels is averaging 10.7 points per game.

Carroll is averaging 68.9 points per game while shooting 43.5 percent from the floor, 28.5 percent on 3-pointers and 68.2 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 63.9 points per game while shooting 42.9 percent from the floor, 30.8 percent on 3-pointers and 64.5 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **About the Rams:**

Cornell enters the tournament 20-3 overall and finished tied with St.

Norbert atop the Midwest Conference at 16-2. The Rams have won 12 consecutive games since an 84-62 loss at Monmouth on Jan. 4.

Junior center Taylor Dicus comes into the tournament averaging a double-double at 15.8 points and 10.0 rebounds per game. Junior guard Rikki Mulloy is averaging 13.8 points per game. Sophomore forward Kellie Kuzmanic averages 8.3 points and 5.0 rebounds per game.

Cornell is scoring an average of 75.8 points per game, and is shooting 43.6 percent from the floor, 31.5 percent on 3-pointers and 66.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 57.3 points per game while shooting 34.0 percent from the floor, 24.2 percent on 3-pointers and 69.7 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **About the Scots:**

Monmouth enters the tournament 18-5 overall and placed third in the Midwest Conference at 14-4. The Scots have won seven of their last eight games, with the only loss a 58-53 defeat at Carroll on Feb. 15.

Senior forward Marla Willard has also averaged a double-double this season, scoring 16.3 points with 10.2 rebounds per game. Senior guard Kaley Corban is averaging 12.1 points per game, while senior forward Jacquice Cooper is averaging 10.5 points and 6.6 rebounds per game.

Monmouth is scoring an average of 74.4 points per game, and is shooting 43.7 percent from the floor, 27.0 percent on 3-pointers and 66.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 63.5 points per game while shooting 37.5 percent from the floor, 28.0 percent on 3-pointers and 65.3 percent at the free-throw line.

#### D is for Defense:

St. Norbert entered this week ranked tenth in the NCAA Division III national statistical rankings in scoring defense.

The Green Knights have held first their 23 opponents to a combined 50.8 points per game this season. The Green Knights are comfortably atop in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense, well ahead of Cornell's 57.3 points allowed.

The Green Knights held Cornell to almost 34 points under its season average in a 64-47 win. St. Norbert also held Illinois College to 30 points under its average in a 66-42 win on Jan. 18.

\* - St. Norbert has qualified for the MWC Tournament 15 times in the last 16 years. In the 31 years since joining the MWC for women's basketball in 1983-84, the Green Knights have quali-

fied for the league's post-season 23 times - a league record.

- \* St. Norbert is ranked third in this week's NCAA Division III national statistics in field-goal percentage at 48.5 percent. Thomas More is the national leader at 51.4 percent.
- \* St. Norbert is 12th in Division III in assist-to-turnover ratio. The Green Knights are carrying a plus-1.11 margin into this week.
- \* St. Norbert is 13th in Division III in scoring margin. The Green Knights are outscoring their opponents by 19.2 points per game. Thomas More is the national leader at 40.8 points per game.
- \* St. Norbert is 147-4 in its last 151 games when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 324-23 when scoring at least 70 points.
- \* St. Norbert owns an impressive 141-35 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in six of the last seven seasons, with four years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
