Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert makes its 11th NCAA Division III Tournament appearance and heads to Southeastern Wisconsin to face No. 9-ranked Carthage. The Green Knights and Lady Reds are joined at the regional by Hope and Wisconsin Lutheran.

The Series:

Carthage leads St. Norbert 4-1 in the all-time series dating back to the 1978-79 season. St. Norbert defeated Carthage 49-46 last season on Nov. 17, 2012 to win the St. Norbert Tip-Off Tournament in De Pere. Morgan Heim led the Green Knights with 14 points, while Cailee Corcoran had 11 points and 10 rebounds for the Lady Reds.

St. Norbert leads Wisconsin Lutheran 2-0 in the all-time series. The Green Knights and Warriors met in the 1990-91 and 1991-92 season.s

St. Norbert has never faced Hope in women's basketball.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 609-276 in her 37th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 938-472 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 609 wins ranks her 12th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years) and Tennessee's Pat Summitt (38 years) have spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Carthage coach Tim Bernero (Lake Forest, 1987) is 201-96 in his 11th season in Kenosha.

Hope coach Brian Morehouse (Hope, 1991) is 453-70 in his 18th season in Holland.

Wisconsin Lutheran coach Klay Knueppel (Wisconsin Lutheran, 1992) is 191-83 in his 10th season in Milwaukee.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 11th NCAA Tournament appearance, and is 9-14 all-time in the tournament. The Green Knights placed fourth when they hosted the Final Four in De Pere in 1985, and also advanced to the Sweet 16 in 1986, 1988 and 2003. St. Norbert made its last appearance in 2011, when it lost 79-69 at UW-Stevens Point. St. Norbert has never played a first-round NCAA Tournament game outside the state of Wisconsin.

Carthage is making its fifth NCAA Tournament appearance, and its third straight. The Lady Reds are 6-4 all-time in the tournament.

Hope is making its 15th NCAA Tournament appearance. The Flying Dutch are 29-12 all-time in the tournament, and won national championships in 1990 and 2006.

Wisconsin Lutheran is making its sixth NCAA Tournament appearance. The Warriors are 1-5 all-time in the tournament.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Tournament at 21-4 overall. The Green Knights, regular-season and tournament champions of the Midwest Conference, topped Monmouth 69-60 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere this past Saturday to secure an automatic berth into the tournament.

Sophomore center Heidi Van Sistine holds the team scoring and rebounding lead at 11.4 points and 6.1 rebounds per game. Van Sistine is shooting 73.8 percent (118-for-160) from the floor, seven made field goals shy of qualifying for the NCAA statistics in that category. Freshman guard Brianna Byrne is averaging 10.6 points per game. Senior guard Morgan Heim is netting 9.6 points per game and 4.6 rebounds per game. Junior forward Tasha Giese is averaging 8.1 points and 4.8 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 70.0 points per game, and is shooting 48.4 percent from the floor, 30.8 percent on 3-pointers and

68.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 51.3 points per game while shooting 35.5 percent from the floor, 24.8 percent on 3-pointers and 68.6 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Lady Reds:

Carthage enters the NCAA Tournament at 24-3 overall and ranked No. 9 in the D3hoops.com Top 25. The Lady Reds, regular-season and tournament champions of the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin, defeated Illinois Wesleyan 63-59 this past Saturday to win the CCIW Tournament.

Senior center Michelle Wenzel averages 15.0 points and 7.9 rebounds per game to lead the Lady Reds. Senior guard Stephanie Kuzmanic is averaging 14.7 points per game, while senior forward Kristi Schmidt tallies 12.6 points and 5.9 rebounds per game. Senior guard Haley Stercic averages 9.7 points per game and shoots 48.2 percent from beyond the three-point arc.

Carthage is averaging 78.0 points per game while shooting 50.3 percent from the floor, 39.2 percent on 3-pointers and 67.0 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 60.4 points per game while shooting 36.4 percent from the floor, 27.1 percent on 3-pointers and 72.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Flying Dutch:

Hope enters the NCAA Tournament unblemished at 27-0. The Flying Dutch, regular-season and tournament champions of the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association, won the MIAA Tournament with an 88-79 win over archrival Calvin this past Saturday.

Sophomore guard Maura McAfee leads Hope leads the Flying Dutch at 14.2 points and 9.6 rebounds per game. Senior guard Megan Kelley is netting 10.5 points per game, while senior guard Brittany Berry is averaging 8.7 points per game. Senior guard Anna Kaufman is averaging 8.6 points per game.

Hope is scoring an average of 83.8 points per game, and is shooting

42.6 percent from the floor, 36.7 percent on 3-pointers and 71.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 56.8 points per game while shooting 36.3 percent from the floor, 25.7 percent on 3-pointers and 69.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Warriors:

Wisconsin Lutheran enters the NCAA Tournament 24-3 overall. The Warriors, regular-season and tournament champions of the Northern Athletics Collegiate Conference, carry a 23-game winning streak into the tournament after topping Alverno 60-57 this past Saturday in the NACC Tournament championship.

Junior center Kristen Schulz leads the Warriors with 17.1 points and 12.4 rebounds per game, and shoots 56.9 percent from the floor. Senior forward Melanie Laete averages 9.7 points and 7.4 rebounds per game, while senior guard Brittany Bahr nets an average of 9.0 points per game.

Wisconsin Lutheran is scoring an average of 70.2 points per game, and is shooting 44.0 percent from the floor, 32.8 percent on 3-pointers and 63.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 53.2 points

per game while shooting 34.8 percent from the floor, 27.7 percent on 3-pointers and 65.1 percent at the free-throw line.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Tournament ranked 12th in the NCAA Division III national statistical rankings in scoring defense.

The Green Knights have held first their 25 opponents to a combined 51.3 points per game this season. The Green Knights are comfortably atop in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense, well ahead of Cornell's 58.5 points allowed.

St. Norbert entered its game at defending Midwest Conference champion Cornell on Dec. 14 with the Rams averaging 80.6 points per game. The Green Knights held Cornell to almost 34 points under its season average in a 64-47 win. St. Norbert also held Illinois College to 30 points under its average in a 66-42 win on Jan. 18.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is ranked third in this week's NCAA Division III national statistics in field-goal percentage at 48.4 percent. Thomas More is the national

leader at 51.6 percent. The Green Knights' opponent, Carthage, is second at 50.3 percent.

* - St. Norbert is 11th in Division III in assist-to-turnover ratio. The Green Knights are carrying a plus-1.11 margin into this week. St. Norbert is 12th in assists per game at 17.5 helpers per contest.

* - St. Norbert is 12th in Division III in scoring margin. The Green Knights are outscoring their opponents by 18.6 points per game. Thomas More is the national leader at 41.2 points per game.

* - St. Norbert is 147-4 in its last 151 games when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 324-23 when scoring at least 70 points.

* - St. Norbert owns an impressive 143-35 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in six of the last seven seasons, with four years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
