St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (6-2, 3-0) vs. Carroll Univ. (5-2, 3-1) Wednesday, December 18, 2013 - 7:30 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert plays its last game in the calendar year 2013 when it hosts Carroll in a key Midwest Conference game at Schuldes Sports Center. The Green Knights lead the Pioneers by one game in the conference loss column.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Carroll 30-19 in an all-time series dating back to the 1982-83 season. The Green Knights have won 11 of the last 13 meetings over the past six seasons.

Last Meeting:

Carroll defeated St. Norbert 60-45 on Feb. 6, 2013 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. The Green Knights led 29-19 at halftime but the Pioneers claimed the second half by a 41-16 margin. Heidi Van Sistine led St. Norbert with 10 points. Nicolette Rini had 15 points to lead Carroll, while Corrine Engels and Malory Christenson had 10 points apiece.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 594-274 in her 37th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 923-470 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 594 wins ranks her 13th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years) and Tennessee's Pat Summitt (38 years) have spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Carroll coach Kris Jacobsen (UW-Platteville, 1989) is 221-145 in her 16th season in Waukesha.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters Saturday's game with a 5-1 overall record and a 2-0 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights picked up their first - MORE -

conference road win of the season this past Saturday when it topped Grinnell 80-57.

The Green Knights are led in scoring by freshman guard Brianna Byrne, who is coming off the bench to average 11.7 points per game. Senior guard Lana Tomashek posted a career-high 17 points against Grinnell to improve her scoring average to 10.3 points per game. Sophomore center Heidi Van Sistine, who is shooting 74.4 percent from the floor this season, registered career highs with 16 points and 11 rebounds against Grinnell. Van Sistine is averaging 10.2 points and 6.0 rebounds per game on the year.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 75.0 points per game, and is shooting 50.6 percent from the floor, 31.4 percent on 3-pointers and 64.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 48.5 points per game while shooting 31.7 percent from the floor, 28.7 percent on 3-pointers and 65.2 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the game with a 5-2 overall record and is 3-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers pulled out a tense 59-57 win over Ripon at home on Saturday. Carroll's lone conference loss came in a 73-48 loss at Cornell on Dec. 7.

The Pioneers are led by senior guard Emily DeNoyer, who is scoring an average of 13.4 points per game. Sophomore forward Malory Christenson is averaging 10.6 points per game, and is shooting 67.9 percent from the floor. Junior guard Corrine Engels is netting 10.4 points per game, while sophomore center Breann Maryanski is averaging 9.9 points and 8.0 rebounds per game.

Carroll is averaging 62.6 points per game while shooting 40.4 percent from the floor, 23.8 percent on 3-pointers and 66.9 percent on free throws. Opponents are scoring 58.9 points per game while shooting 39.9 percent from the floor, 26.5 percent on 3-pointers and 63.4 percent at the free-throw line.

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert has led the Midwest Conference in scoring defense in each of the last six seasons. The Green Knights held opponents to 50.9 points per game last season.

The Green Knights have held their eight opponents to a combined 49.5 points per game this season to again lead the Midwest Conference in the early going. The Green Knights hold a comfortable lead in that area within the Midwest Conference, with Carroll second at 58.9 points per game.

Prior to Monday's game with UW-Oshkosh, the Green Knights were fifth in Division III in the national statistical rankings in scoring defense at 48.3 points per game.

St. Norbert entered its game at Cornell on Dec. 14 with the Rams averaging 80.6 points per game. The Green Knights held Cornell to almost 34 points under its season average in a 64-47 win.

Jump Shots:

- * St. Norbert entered the week ranked fourth in the NCAA Division III in field-goal percentage. The Green Knights, now at 49.0 percent, entered its game Monday at UW-Oshkosh at 49.4 percent. Only Ferrum (52.1 percent), Carthage (51.0 percent) and Juniata (49.8 percent) were higher in marksmanship from the floor than the Green Knights.
- * St. Norbert is 140-4 in its last 144 games when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 318-23 when scoring at least 70 points.
- * St. Norbert owns an impressive 128-33 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in five of the last six seasons, with four years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
