St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview ST. NORBERT COLLEGE TIP-OFF CLASSIC

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert College hosts the eighth edition of its annual Tip-Off Tournament, which is a classic format this season. St. Norbert and Carroll of the Midwest Conference will face UW-Stout and UW-Superior of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. In lieu of admission, fans are asked to donate non-perishable food items at the door.

The Series:

St. Norbert is 12-0 all-time against UW-Stout in a series begun during the 1977-78 season.

St. Norbert is 2-1 against UW-Superior in an all-time series that began in 1976-77. The Green Knights have won the last two meetings.

Last Meetings:

St. Norbert pulled out a 76-71 win over UW-Stout on Nov. 16, 2008 in the title game of the Tip-Off Classic at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. Tournament MVP Denise Heuser had 17 points for St. Norbert, while Morgan Strasser had 19 points. Julia Hirssig had 22 points and 14 rebounds for the Blue Devils, while Danielle DeWitt added 13 points.

St. Norbert topped UW-Superior 77-68 on Nov. 19, 2011 in the title game of the Tip-Off Classic at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere. Tournament MVP Krista Pelky poured in 30 points, while Jamie Kuhl had 16 points and Tasha Giese 15 points for St. Norbert. Connie Urmanski led the Yellowjackets with 19 points, while Sally Linzmeier added 14 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 609-277 in her 38th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 938-474 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 609 wins ranks her 11th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years, 1971-2002) has spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

UW-Stout coach Mark Thomas (UW-Superior, 1983) is 442-275 in his 28th season in Menomonie.

UW-Superior coach Don Mulhern (Winona State, 1987) is 79-125 in his ninth season in Superior. He is 207-230 in 18 seasons of collegiate coaching.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters a new season returning three starters from last season's team that finished 21-5 and advanced to the NCAA Division III Tournament. The Green Knights, picked to win the Midwest Conference title in the pre-season coaches' poll, went 16-2 to share the MWC crown with Cornell last season.

Junior center Heidi Van Sistine was the Green Knights' leading scorer last season at 11.2 points per game, and also had a team-high 6.0 rebounds per game while shooting 74.2 percent from the floor. Senior forward Tasha Giese averaged 7.8 points per game, while sophomore guard Jill Kleiman netted 6.1 points per game. Sophomore guard Brianna Byrne came off the bench last season to average 10.8 points per game.

St. Norbert averaged 69.2 points per game last season while shooting 48.1 percent from the floor, 30.5 percent on 3-pointers and 68.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents scored an average of 51.7 points per game while shooting 35.8 percent from the floor, 24.9 percent on 3-pointers and 68.6 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Blue Devils:

UW-Stout returns three starters from last season's squad which finished 11-15 overall and 7-9 in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The Blue Devils are picked to finish seventh in this year's WIAC pre-season coaches' poll.

Junior guard Kyleigh Hebert is the Blue Devils' top returning scorer at 10.8 points per game. Senior forward Brea Boomer averaged 8.4 points per game last season, while senior guard Katelynne Folkers netted 7.5 points per game.

Stout averaged 65.3 points per game last season while shooting

36.5 percent from the floor, 23.9 percent on 3-pointers and 64.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents averaged 69.8 points per game while shooting 40.4 percent from the floor, 32.9 percent on 3-pointers and 68.2 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Yellowjackets:

UW-Superior returns four starters from a club that went 16-12 last season and finished 7-9 in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The Yellowjackets advanced to the title game of the WIAC Tournament before losing to UW-Oshkosh 75-69.

Senior guard Sally Linzmeier, the reigning WIAC Player of the Year, averaged 18.7 points and 8.8 rebounds last season. She shot 45.4 percent from the floor and was 136-for-162 (84.0 percent) at the free-throw line. Sophomore guard Brynn Liljander averaged 9.6 points per game, while senior guard Deandra Vavra netted 6.5 points per game.

Superior averaged 66.5 points per game last season while shooting 39.1 percent from the floor, 27.1 percent on 3-pointers and 73.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents averaged 62.5 points per game while shooting 39.1 percent from the floor, 33.0 percent on 3-pointers and 70.3 percent at the free-throw line.

Jump Shots:

- * St. Norbert finished last season ranked eighth in the NCAA Division III national statistical rankings in scoring defense.
- * St. Norbert is 147-4 in its last 151 games when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 324-23 when scoring at least 70 points.
- * St. Norbert owns an impressive 143-36 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in six of the last seven seasons, with four years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
