St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (15-3, 12-1) vs. Lawrence Univ. (0-17, 0-13) Saturday, February 4, 2015 - 5:30 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

#### **Game Overview:**

St. Norbert looks to remain unbeaten at Schuldes Sports Center this season when it hosts Lawrence on Wednesday. The Green Knights currently hold a two-game lead on second-place Carroll with five Midwest Conference games remaining.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads Lawrence 67-13 in an all-time series dating back to the 1975-76 season. The Green Knights have won 19 consecutive games in the series. St. Norbert owns more wins over Lawrence than any other opponent.

#### Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Lawrence 88-34 on Jan. 7, 2015 at Alexander Gym in Appleton. The Green Knights jumped out to a 40-10 lead and cruised from there. Regan Carmichael led St. Norbert with 16 points, while Tasha Giese and Heidi Van Sistine had 14 points apiece. Kassidy Rinehart, Elizabeth Arco and Patsy Kealey all had six points for the Vikings.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 624-280 in her 38th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 952-477 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 624 wins ranks 10th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years, 1971-2012) has spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Lawrence coach Ashley Wellman (Alma, 2008) is 3-37 in her second season in Appleton.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the game at 15-3 overall and 12-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights opened up a two-game lead in the Midwest Conference standings following a 75-62 win over Carroll this past Saturday at Schuldes Sports Center. St. Norbert is 9-0 on its home court this season.

Sophomore guard Brianna Byrne leads the Green Knights with an average of 12.6 points per game. Senior center Heidi Van Sistine, who is shooting 63.2 percent from the floor, is registering 10.6 points and 5.9 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Jill Kleiman is averaging 9.9 points per game, while senior forward Tasha Giese is averaging 9.7 points and 6.0 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 68.2 points per game, and is shooting 45.3 percent from the floor, 28.9 percent on 3-pointers and 66.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 51.4 points per game while shooting 34.0 percent from the floor, 27.8 percent on 3-pointers and 71.1 percent at the free-throw line.

#### **About the Vikings:**

Lawrence enters the game 0-17 overall and 0-13 in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings saw their overall losing streak hit 34 games with a 94-80 loss to Knox at home this past Saturday.

Freshman forward Elizabeth Arco leads the Vikings with a scoring average of 9.2 points per game. Freshman forward Danelle Buck is totaling 8.9 points and 5.1 rebounds per game, while junior forward Andrea Wilkinson is averaging 6.4 points and 5.1 rebounds per game. Junior guard Patsy Kealey is scoring an average of 5.0 points per game.

Lawrence is scoring an average of 45.4 points per game, and is shooting 34.4 percent from the floor, 24.0 percent on 3-pointers and 52.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 71.0 points per game while shooting 40.2 percent from the

floor, 31.6 percent on 3-pointers and 67.9 percent at the free-throw line.

#### Tilley Talk:

With a 64-41 win over Lake Forest on Nov. 19, St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley moved into sole possession of 10th place in Division III women's basketball history for career wins with 611.

Tilley, who now has 624 career wins, passed Susan Dunagan for 10th place in career wins. Dunagan, who retired after last season, coached at Roanoke from 1982 to 2014. Johns Hopkins coach Nancy Funk currently has 634 wins to stand in ninth place.

Tilley has wins over 79 different schools, including all nine Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members. Her most wins against a single opponent have come against Lawrence (64), Ripon (57) and Beloit (53).

#### **Jump Shots:**

- \* St. Norbert currently ranks eighth in the NCAA Division III in field-goal percentage at 45.3 percent. Wisconsin Lutheran is the current national leader at 49.4 percent.
- \* St. Norbert sophomore guard Jill Kleiman is currently ranked 14th in the NCAA Division III in steals per game at 3.5 per game. Anna Maria's Trafficia Warburton is the current national leader at 5.17 steals per game.
- \* St. Norbert is 154-4 in its last 158 games when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 328-23 when scoring at least 70 points.
- \* St. Norbert owns an impressive 157-39 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in six of the last seven seasons, with four years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
