St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview

MIDWEST CONFERENCE WOMEN'S BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT

Sat., Feb. 28 - Championship vs. Carroll (16-7) or Cornell (14-9) - 3 p.m.

Tournament Overview:

The winner of the Midwest Conference Tournament will receive the league's automatic qualifier into the NCAA Division III Tournament. This is the 10th time in the last 16 seasons St. Norbert has hosted the tournament.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Illinois College 29-7 in a series begun in the 1984-85 season. The Green Knights have won 24 of the last 26 games in the series.

St. Norbert leads Carroll 35-19 in an all-time series dating back to the 1982-83 season. The Green Knights have won 16 of the last 18 meetings over the past six-plus seasons.

St. Norbert leads Cornell 15-2 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights topped the Rams in the Midwest Conference championship game in 1984, 1986, 1987 and 1988.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 629-280 in her 38th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 957-477 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 629 wins ranks 10th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years, 1971-2012) has spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Illinois College coach Lora Westling (Washburn, 2005) is 26-20 in her second season in Jacksonville.

Carroll coach Kris Jacobsen (UW-Platteville, 1989) is 247-159 in her 17th season in Waukesha.

Cornell coach Brent Brase (Cornell College, 1990) is 114-133 in his tenth season in Mount Vernon.

About the Green Knights:

Midwest Conference title with a 17-1 record. The Green Knights closed out the regular season with a 64-45 home win over Cornell this past Saturday.

Sophomore guard Brianna Byrne is averaging 14.0 points per game. Junior center Heidi Van Sistine is averaging 11.1 points and a team-high 6.8 rebounds per game, and is shooting 61.9 percent from the floor. Sophomore guard Jill Kleiman is netting 9.6 points per game, while senior forward Tasha Giese is averaging 9.5 points and 5.7 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 70.4 points per game, and is shooting 45.6 percent from the floor, 30.4 percent on 3-pointers and 67.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 50.5 points per game while shooting 33.1 percent from the floor, 27.7 percent on 3-pointers and 70.9 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Lady Blues:

Illinois College enters the tournament 14-9 overall. The Lady Blues finished 11-7 in the Midwest Conference to earn the No. 4 seeding. Illinois College lost its most recent game, a 57-53 home setback to Grinnell last Saturday.

Senior center Hannah McGinnis, the 2014 MWC Player of the Year, has put together another banner year for the Lady Blues. McGinnis is averaging 20.1 points and 14.5 rebounds per game this season. Freshman forward Melissa Solorio is averaging 11.8 points per game, while senior guard Maddy Keith is netting 10.4 points per game.

Illinois College is scoring an average of 65.7 points per game, and is shooting 39.2 percent from the floor, 27.1 percent on 3-pointers and 64.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 61.5 points per game while shooting 37.4 percent from the floor, 27.5 percent on 3-pointers and 72.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the tournament 16-7 overall and finished in second place in the Midwest Conference at 13-5. The Pioneers defeated Lake Forest 64-49 at home on Saturday.

Junior guard Malory Christenson is averaging 13.7 points per game. Senior center Breann Maryanski is averaging 12.7 points and 7.5 rebounds per game. Freshman guard Rachel Van Sluys is averaging 10.3 points per game, while senior guard Corrine Engels is totaling 8.9 points per game.

About the Rams:

Cornell enters the tournament 14-9 overall and was 12-6 in the Midwest Conference to be the No. 3 seeding. The Rams dropped their regular-season finale 64-45 at St. Norbert last Saturday.

Senior center Taylor Dicus, who is shooting 63.5 percent from the floor, is averaging 16.8 points and 10.7 rebounds per game. Senior guard Rikki Mulloy is averaging 15.6 points per game. Junior forward Maggie Hogen is averaging 7.8 points and 7.9 rebounds per game, while freshman guard Sarah Hansen is scoring 7.1 points per game.

Cornell is scoring an average of 68.5 points per game, and is shooting 41.2 percent from the floor, 32.7 percent on 3-pointers and 70.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.7 points per game while shooting 34.2 percent from the floor, 26.8 percent on 3-pointers and 68.2 percent at the free-throw line.

D is for Defense:

The top four teams in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense are the four which have qualified for the MWC Tournament.

St. Norbert handily leads the MWC in scoring defense at 50.5 points per game. Cornell is second at 50.7 points per game, while Carroll is third on decimal points rounded to 50.7 points per game. Illinois College is fourth at 61.5 points per game.

Those four teams are also the top four in the league in scoring margin. St. Norbert is first at plus 19.9 points per game, followed by Carroll at plus-10.6, Cornell at plus-7.8 and Illinois College at plus-4.2.

on Nov. 19, St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley moved into sole possession of 10th place in Division III women's basketball history for career wins with 611.

Tilley, who now has 629 career wins, passed Susan Dunagan for 10th place in career wins. Dunagan, who retired after last season, coached at Roanoke from 1982 to 2014. Johns Hopkins coach Nancy Funk currently has 638 wins to stand in ninth place.

Tilley has wins over 79 different schools, including all nine Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members. Her most wins against a sin-

gle opponent have come against Lawrence (65), Ripon (57) and Beloit (54).

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert has qualified for the MWC Tournament 16 times in the last 17 years. In the 32 years since joining the MWC for women's basketball in 1983-84, the Green Knights have qualified for the league's post-season 24 times - a league record.

* - St. Norbert is 157-4 in its last 161 games when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped

in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 330-23 when scoring at least 70 points.

* - St. Norbert owns an impressive 162-39 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in seven of the last eight seasons, with six years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.

* - St. Norbert is fourth in Division III in field-goal percentage at 45.6 percent. Wisconsin Lutheran is the national leader at 49.5 percent.
