St. Norbert participates in its 12th NCAA Division III Tournament when it plays in the West Regional at St. Thomas' Schoenecker Arena. The Green Knights open play with a first-round game Friday against Luther.

## The Series:

Luther leads St. Norbert 1-0 in an all-time series begun in the 1986-87 season. The Norse claimed a 73-62 win over the Green Knights on Dec. 20. 1986 in the St. Olaf Tournament in Northfield, Minn.

UM-Morris leads St. Norbert 1-0 in the all-time series begun in the 1989-90 season, with the Cougars picking up a 53-51 win on Nov. 25, 1989 in St. Paul. Minn

St. Norbert and St. Thomas have never met in women's basketball.

## The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 631-280 in her 38th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 959-477 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 631 wins ranks 10th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years, 1971-2012) has spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Luther coach Amanda Bailey (UW-Stevens Point, 2005) is 52-51 in her fourth season in Decorah.

St. Thomas coach Ruth Sinn (St. Thomas, 1984) is 211-70 in her tenth season in St. Paul.

UM-Morris coach Tim Grove (North Dakota, 1999) is 152-87 in his ninth season in Morris.

## **NCAA Tournament Appearances:**

St. Norbert is making its 12th NCAA Tournament appearance, and is 9-15 all-time in the tournament. The Green Knights placed fourth when they hosted the Final Four in De Pere in 1985, and also advanced to the Sweet 16 - MORE -

in 1986, 1988 and 2003. St. Norbert made its last appearance last season, when it lost 60-51 at Carthage. This year's appearance marks the first time St. Norbert has played a first-round game outside of the state of Wisconsin.

Luther is making its tenth NCAA Tournament appearance, and is 12-9 all-time in the tournament. The Norse, making their first appearance since 2007, finished third in 1992.

St. Thomas is making its 22nd NCAA Tournament appearance, and is 40-21 all-time in the tournament. The Tommies won the national championship in 1991.

UM-Morris is making its fourth NCAA Tournament appearance, and is 2-3 all-time in the tournament.

## **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the tournament at 22-3 overall. The Green Knights won for the 15th time in the last 16 games when they claimed the championship of the Midwest Conference Tournament with a 72-51 win over Cornell this past Saturday.

Sophomore guard Brianna Byrne is averaging 14.1 points per game, and was named second-team All-Midwest Conference. Junior center Heidi Van Sistine is averaging 11.1 points and a team-high 6.7 rebounds per game, and was also a second-team All-MWC honoree. Sophomore guard Jill Kleiman, a first-team All-MWC selection, is netting 9.4 points, 3.6 rebounds, 3.2 steals and 3.1 assists per game. Senior forward Tasha Giese is averaging 9.2 points and 5.7 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 70.1 points per game, and is shooting 45.5 percent from the floor, 31.6 percent on 3-pointers and 67.4 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 50.6 points per game while shooting 33.2 percent from the floor, 26.8 percent on 3-pointers and 71.4 percent at the free-throw line.

## **About the Norse:**

Luther enters the NCAA Tournament 22-5 overall. The Norse finished second in the Iowa Intercollegiate Athletic Conference with a 10-4 record, and won the IIAC Tournament with a 61-53 win over Wartburg this past Saturday.

Junior guard Moran Lonning leads the Norse at 14.4 points per game, while senior guard Meagan Koepnick is averaging 13.0 points per game. Junior guard Kylie Romeo is averaging 11.1 points per game, while sophomore forward Anna Madrigal is netting 10.3 points per game.

Luther is scoring an average of 73.9 points per game, and is shooting 38.3 percent from the floor, 34.8 percent on 3-pointers and 71.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 63.6 points per game while shooting 40.7 percent from the floor, 29.0 percent on 3-pointers and 69.9 percent at the free-throw line.

## **About the Tommies:**

St. Thomas enters the NCAA Tournament unblemished at 27-0 and is ranked No. 2 in the D3hoops.com Top 25. The Tommies won the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference title at 18-0 and then won the MIAC Tournament with a 65-51 win over Bethel this past Saturday.

Senior guard Jenna Dockter leads the Tommies in scoring at 13.9 points per game. Senior center Maggie Weiers is averaging 13.0 points and 8.1 rebounds per game, while senior forward Anna Smith is averaging 8.8 points and 6.7 rebounds per game. Junior guard Katie Stone is netting 8.6 points per game.

St. Thomas is scoring an average of 70.3 points per game, and is shooting 47.0 percent from the floor, 33.9 percent on 3-pointers and 73.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 48.0 points per game while shooting 34.9 percent from the floor, 28.4 percent on 3-pointers and 66.4 percent at the free-throw line.

## **About the Cougars:**

UM-Morris enters the tournament 16-11 overall and shared the Upper Midwest Athletic Conference title with a 12-2 mark. Morris topped Northwestern-St. Paul 63-54 in overtime this past

Senior guard Kendra Wycoff leads the Cougars in scoring at 15.7 points per game. Senior forward Emily Auch is averaging 12.1 points and 7.7 rebounds per game. Sophomore forward Tori Holt is averaging 10.1 points and 7.2 rebounds per game.

Morris is scoring an average of 69.9 points per game, and is shooting 40.9 percent from the floor, 35.2 percent on 3-pointers and 63.2 percent at the freethrow line. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.3 points per game while shooting 37.2 percent from the floor, 26.5 percent on 3-pointers and 70.7 percent at the free-throw line.

## D is for Defense:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Tournament ranked 17th in the NCAA Division III national statistical rankings in scoring defense.

The Green Knights have held first their 25 opponents to a combined 50.6 points per game this season. The Green Knights are comfortably atop in the Midwest Conference in scoring defense, well ahead of Carroll's 61.0 points allowed.

St. Norbert held Lake Forest to 28 points in a 66-28 win on Feb. 10 at Schuldes Sports Center. It was the second time in the last three games the Green Knights have held an opponent to under 30 points this season. St. Norbert held Lawrence to 27 points in a 73-27 win over the Vikings on Feb. 4.

It marked the first time St. Norbert held an opponent below 30 points twice in the same season since 1985-86.

## Tilley Talk:

With a 64-41 win over Lake Forest on Nov. 19, St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley moved into sole possession of 10th place in Division III women's basketball history for career wins with

Tilley, who now has 631 career wins, passed Susan Dunagan for 10th place in career wins. Dunagan, who retired after last season, coached at Roanoke from 1982 to 2014. Johns Hopkins coach Nancy Funk currently has 638 wins to stand in ninth place.

Tilley has wins over 79 different schools, including all nine Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members. Her most wins against a single opponent have come against Midwest Conference foes Lawrence (65), Ripon (57) and Beloit (54).

## **Jump Shots:**

- \* St. Norbert is sixth in Division III in field-goal percentage at 45.6 percent. Wisconsin Lutheran is the national leader at 49.5 percent.
- \* St. Norbert is ranked 14th in Division III in assist-to-turnover ratio (plus-1.15), 18th in assists per game (16.7), 19th in scoring margin (plus 19.5) points per game) and 32nd in fieldgoal percentage defense (33.2 percent).
- \* St. Norbert is 158-4 in its last 162 games when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 331-23 when scoring at least 70 points.
- \* St. Norbert owns an impressive 164-39 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in seven of the last eight seasons, with six years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
